**TODAY'S GAME:** The Memphis Redbirds continue a six-game series homestand against the Gwinnett Stripers (Triple-A, Atlanta Braves) on Thursday night at AutoZone Park. Left-handed pitcher Nick Raquet is scheduled to start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Huascar Ynoa for Gwinnett.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Memphis Redbirds continued a six-game homestand with a 2-1 walk-off win over the Gwinnett Stripers (Triple-A, Atlanta Braves) on Wednesday night at AutoZone Park. After third baseman Cesar Prieto tied the game with a two-out single in the bottom of the ninth inning, second baseman Thomas Saggese laced a single to left-center field to win the game. The walk-off hit was the second walk-off win in as many nights to start the series against Gwinnett and the second of the season for Saggese. Center fielder Mike Antico, who scored the tying run, went 2-for-4 at the plate. Saggese also went 2-for-4 and added the game-winning RBI. Starting pitcher Michael McGreevy dazzled again in his 21st start of the season at Triple-A. The right-handed pitcher allowed one run on 10 hits, walked none and struck out five in 7.0 innings. Since the start of June, McGreevy has allowed three runs or fewer in nine of ten starts. MLB Rehabbing reliever Riley O'Brien allowed one hit and struck out one in an inning of scoreless relief. Nick Robertson (1-2) pitched a scoreless ninth thanks to a groundball double play.

**BAKING THE STRIPERS:** Memphis Redbirds first baseman smacked two home runs, including a three-run walk-off home run in the bottom of the ninth inning in last night's win over Gwinnett. The right-handed slugger has owned the Stripers this season. Baker has hit 10 of his 30 home runs against Stripers pitching this season. On the season, three of his four two-homer games have come against the Stripers. On June 26, Baker posted a two-homer game at Gwinnett. His first home run tied the Memphis Redbirds franchise record in career home runs. His solo shot in the ninth broke the record. Baker is batting .269/.338/.761/1.099 with 10 home runs and 21 RBIs against the Stripers in 17 games this season. With two outs and the tying run at third base on Wednesday night, Baker was intentionally walked representing the winning run. Two batters later, the Redbirds won the game.

**HAPPY 25th, AZP:** To commemorate the 25th anniversary season of Redbirds baseball at AutoZone Park, the Redbirds will host a plethora of promotions and theme nights to celebrate. Since the opening of the downtown ballpark in 2000, many credit the stadium with the revitalization of downtown Memphis. The support of the Redbirds at AutoZone Park caught the attention of Michael Heisley, who then brought the Grizzlies to the city. “(AutoZone Park) was a catalyst for a lot of the things that downtown is today,” Memphis Redbirds President and General Manager Craig Unger said. “So, I think even to this day today, you still see development going on around here. The Commonwealth building a few years ago, you know, Stewart and the group there that, that did that building talked about AutoZone Park. This entire block around Madison is still the catalyst for growth there. Sports is that catalyst.”

**BASEBALL AMERICA OUTLOOK:** The St. Louis Cardinals entered the 2024 season with the No. 20 Minor League system in all of baseball according to BaseballAmerica. St. Louis began the campaign with five players ranked in the Top-100 (No. 39 Masyn Winn, MLB, No. 75 Tekoah Roby, AA, No. 83 Victor Scott II, MLB, No. 84 Tink Hence, AA, No. 85 Thomas Saggese, AAA). BaseballAmerica’s preview on the Cardinals system states “Jordan Walker’s successful graduation to the majors has dropped the Cardinals’ farm system back, though exciting up-the-middle hitters like Masyn Winn and Victor Scott II are ready to follow Walker to St. Louis. Getting the most out of arms like Tekoah Roby and Tink Hence is going to be crucial. The Cardinals pulled off the neat trick of adding two Top 100 Prospects when they dealt Jordan Montgomery to the Rangers for Roby and Thomas Saggese in July.”

## MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

**Ben Johnson** enters his sixth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his sixth year in the Cardinals organization.

### COACHING CAREER

- 274 - 293 managerial record entering 2024 season
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

### PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

## PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero, 43, is beginning his 12th season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis.

### COACHING CAREER

- As of 2023, Ten current members of the St. Louis Cardinals 40-man roster have come through Springfield since Marrero’s tenure began in 2017. Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

### PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

## HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his second season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis

### COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

- Spent last season with Charleston in the Atlantic League after an injury abruptly finished his 2023 season with Memphis
