

LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox dropped their Thursday night contest with the Richmond Flying Squirrels by a 5-1 final. Left-hander Jon Means looked sharp in his first Major League Rehab appearance back from Tommy John Surgery, retiring six of seven batters faced and not allowing a run. However, Richmond took the lead on an RBI single from Carter Aldrete off right-hander Kyle Brnovich in the bottom of the fourth. Offensively, it was a quiet night for Bowie, who tallied five hits - three of which were from John Rhodes, including a game-tying RBI double in the fifth. The game escaped Bowie in the sixth, where Richmond plated four against Brnovich, including a solo home run from Will Wilson, an RBI fielder's choice from Victor Bericoto and a two-run double from Andy Thomas. The loss is the third for the Baysox in their last four games.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter tonight with a record of 54-51 on the season. Their 21-15 mark in the second half has them leading the Southwest division standings and sitting three games above Bowie. The Baysox are 9-12 against the Flying Squirrels this season, securing a series split in Richmond back in early July. Richmond's 3.78 staff ERA on the campaign is second-best in the Eastern League, However, their starters own the sixth ERA in the league (4.16) with the fewest innings (385.1). The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, The Flying Squirrels active roster includes four of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, including RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 10 SF), OF Vaun Brown (No. 13 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15 SF), and RHP Carson Seymour (No. 23 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Hayden Birdsong is tonight's projected starter for Richmond. The No. 10 prospect in the Giants' system, per MLB Pipeline, Birdsong made his Double-A debut last week, taking the loss this past Saturday in Altoona, allowing four runs on six hits and three walks, while striking out five through 3.1 innings. That was the same number of runs allowed by Birdsong as he had through the entire month of July (five starts/24 IP) with High-A Eugene. This is the third level Birdsong has pitched at this season, posting a 2.16 ERA through 41.2 innings with Single-A San Jose before tossing a 3.25 ERA in 36 innings at Eugene. A sixth-round pick of the Giants in 2022 out of Eastern Illinois, Birdsong features a mid-low-90s fastball with riding and running action, high-70s curveball, a slider, and a low-80s changeup.

COMEBACK KIDS

Recently, the Baysox have made it a habit of coming from behind in games. Bowie has conceded the first run in 16 of its last 18 games. In that stretch the Baysox have gone 8-10 overall. This season, Bowie is 17-35 in total when allowing the first run. Nine of the last 11 Baysox victories have come after failing to score first.

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Top prospect Jackson Holliday has had a stellar start at the Double-A level. Despite Wednesday and Thursday marking just the fifth ocassion this season where he's failed to record a hit in consecutive games, Holliday has still recored hits in 12 of his first 16 Double-A games with seven multi-hit efforts, while reaching base in 14 of 16 games at the level. This season, across three different levels, Holliday ranks top five in the Orioles' organization in batting average (3rd - .333), on-base percentage (1st - .457), slugging percentage (5th - .528), OPS (1st - .985), triples (1st - 6), and walks (1st - 72). Holliday's on-base percentage also leads all of Minor League Baseball. He is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday and the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has continued his surge in the Eastern League throughout the summer months, as his .291 average since June 1 is fourth-highest in the league amongst players with at least 200 plate appearances. The newly-named No. 28 prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline, has also brought the pop, with his 24 extra-base hits in that span sitting at third-most in the league. Cook currently leads active Baysox players in home runs (17), RBI (62 - third-most in the Eastern League), on-base percentage (.319), slugging (.465), OPS (.784), and stolen bases (23).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers joins Bowie from High-A Aberdeen after one of the best performances across Minor League Baseball in the month of July. The No. 9 prospect in the O's system, per MLB Pipeline, hit .397 last month - second-highest in Minor League Baseball among players with at least 60 plate appearances, while his 1.185 OPS was fourth-best and led the Orioles' minor league system. Beavers also led the Baltimore farm with his .494 on-base percentage in the month of July. He's opened his time in Double-A with hits in five of seven games, including three multi-hit contests, and a 9-for-28 (.321) start overall.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second sea-son as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor leaguebest 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State. Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title Aberteen clinich al inst-nail of/sision tuie and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann neart two screames are a clicking acade spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Hermann also served as a pitching strat-egist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Funda-2023 for a second season as Hunda-mentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019.
