ABOUT LAST NIGHT...: The Vancouver Canadians led 3-0 on a pair of home runs before the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) rallied for five runs over three innings to hand the C's a 5-3 loss Friday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

Davis Schneider continued his recent hot stretch at the dish with his second home run in as many games. The Voorhees, NJ native blasted his sixth big fly of the year to break a scoreless tie in the third and out the C's up 1-0.

Zac Cook made it a three-run lead in the fifth. With Schneider aboard after a lead-off walk, Cook launched his second High-A home run to right field to make it 3-0 Vancouver.

From there, it was all Hops. They tied the game with three runs in the sixth – including a game-tying two out, two-run homer from Blaze Alexander – before they took the lead with a run on two hits in the seventh and a solo homer in the eighth. Hillsboro's bullpen retired the last 15 of 17 batters after the Cook home run to keep the C's at bay.

Paxton Schultz was solid in five and a third innings of work. The right-hander scattered four hits, walked one and K'd five in his third start of the year against Hillsboro

BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO: Vancouver and Hillsboro go head-to-head this week in their third of five series this season. It's the first time the C's have been the home team; they're 6-6 in 12 games against the Hops at Ron Tonkin Field in 2021. The Canadians took four of six in their first meeting May 18-23 before the Diamondbacks affiliate did the same July 13-18. These two teams are evenly matched; the Hops have outscored the C's 67-66 so far.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY: August 9, 2009 – The C's poured it on early and survived a late scare in a 9-6 win over Yakima (Diamondbacks) at The Nat. After going up 3-0 in the first three innings, a four-run fourth was highlighted by Mike Gilmartin's two-run homer. In the ninth, the Bears scored four runs and brought the tying run to the plate before Paul Smyth came on to strike out the final batter. Rashun Dixon led the offense with four hits

TIGHTENING THE BELT: After averaging 5 walks a game in the series against Spokane last week, the Canadians pitching staff has averaged 2.75 free passes a night so far this series.

SATURDAZE: The C's are 4-9 on Saturdays this year, their worst record on any given day.

COOKIE MONSTER: Zac Cook has been finding his stroke of late. He has a hit in three of his last five games and his two-run home run yesterday was his second in his last four starts.

ON THE SCHNEID: Davis Schneider continues to excel despite limited starting opportunities. His homer last night was his third in the last four games he's played in and fourth in his last nine. In 11 July games, the Voorhees, NJ native hit .359 (14-39), got on base 41% of the time and slugged .564 while raising his average from .121 to .253.

ON THE HILL: Nick Fraze gets the ball for Vancouver looking to build on his recent successes after returning from an injury. He last worked on August 1 in Spokane when he was perfect through a scheduled four innings and punched out four Indians along the way. Fraze, 23, has been working his way back to full strength after spending over a month on the Injured List that kept him sidelined from June 16 to July 15. Before that, the right-hander made one start against Hillsboro on May 21; he earned his second of three consecutive quality starts with six innings in which he gave up one run on three hits with two walks and six strikeouts. Opposing hitters are batting just .168 against him this year.

Brandon Pfaadt (pronounced "fought") gets another start against the C's after turning in the finest outing by any High-A West pitcher when he faced them on July 14. That night, the right-hander threw a complete game shutout – the only one in the league so far this year – while allowing four hits. He waked one and K'd five. Pfaadt, 22, began the season with Low-A Visalia, where he went 2-2 with a 3.12 ERA in 40.1 innings pitched across seven starts. The first-year pro was Arizona's fifth round pick (149th overall) in the 2020 draft.
