LAST OUTING: McKendry entered in the fourth inning on June 8 vs. Louisville with the Sounds trailing 1-0. He worked four scoreless innings, striking out six and allowing just three singles. Leaving in a tied 1-1 game, the Sounds would fall 4-2.

AGAINST OPPONENT: He has faced Gwinnett four times in his career - three of those were with Durham. He made his Triple-A debut in relief of Tyler Glasnow on Sept. 13, 2022 (5.2 IP, 8 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 4 K) and again on Sept. 18, 2022 (4.0 IP, 5 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 4 K). After allowing just one run in 4.2 innings on May 25 last season, McKendry was named IL Pitcher of the Week after his performance on August 23 (6.0 IP, 1 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 6 K). Overall, he is 1-0 with a 2.66 ERA.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Started season with Triple-A Durham in Tampa Bay organization...was invited to Rays MLB Spring Training as a non-roster invitee
- After tough April (6.75 ERA in 6 G), went 3-0 with a 0.31 ERA (29.1 IP/1 ER) in five May games (4 starts)... included was six scoreless innings against Nashville on May 18 (2 H, 2 BB, 8 K)...was named International League Pitcher of the Month after leading minor leagues in ERA and ranking second in opponent average (.111)
- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for May 8-14 after holding Charlotte to two hits over 7.0 shutout innings on May 12 (2 BB, 6 K)... earned honor again for May 29-June 4 after seven-inning complete game shutout of Jacksonville in first game of May 31 twin bill (2 H, 6 K)
- After losing team debut against his former team on August 3, earned first win with Nashville in game two of August 10 twin bill at Indianapolis... allowed one earned run in 6.0 innings
- Named IL Pitcher of the Week for third time this season after one-hit start on August 23 at Gwinnett
- Set career high with 7.1 innings of work on Sept. 6 vs. Memphis (W, 2 H, 1 ER)...also the longest outing by a Sounds pitcher this season
