LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox fell 3-2 on Saturday night in Akron. After falling behind 1-0 in the third, **Anthony Servideo** doubled and scored on a throwing error to tie the game in the seventh, before **Doug Hodo** scored on a **Noelberth Romero** single later in the frame to give Bowie a 2-1 edge. Despite two shutout frames of relief from **Dan Hammer**, Akron took the lead when two runs came home on a single and error by Romero at third base in the eighth inning. The win clinched a playoff spot for Akron and eliminated the Baysox.

EASTERN LEAGUE HONOR ROLL

Baysox players have claimed back-to-back Eastern League Player of the Week awards. Former C/IB **Samuel Basallo** took home the award this past week after a successful homestand against the Erie SeaWolves. The prior week, OF **Dylan Beavers** was named Player of the Week following Bowie's road trip in Altoona. Beavers and Basallo are the third pair of Eastern League teammates to win Player of the Week in consecutive weeks this season.

THE FIRST (AND SECOND) NOEL

On Sunday, August 10, IF **Noelberth Romero** walked off both games of a doubleheader with the Harrisburg Senators. Romero hit a walk-off, two-run home run in game one before notching a walk-off, two-run double in game two. Romero became the first player across MLB or MiLB to hit multiple walk-offs on the same day since former Orioles' farmhand Andrew Daschbach walked off both legs of a doubleheader for High-A Aberdeen on August 12, 2021.

KEEP THE BROOMS IN THE CLOSET

The Baysox enter Sunday trying to avoid being swept in a six-game series for the first time since the Minor League Baseball series format changed in 2021. Bowie has never lost the first five games of a series in this format and has only lost five games in a series six times since 2021. The last sweep of any kind suffered by the Baysox was at the hands of Akron, in the Double-A Northeast League Championship Series in 2021.

THE DOG DAYS ARE OVER

The Baysox end the month of August with the most walks drawn (112), along with the second-best on-base percentage (.335) and second-most steals (44) in the Eastern League. On the mound, the Baysox ended August with the league's second-best ERA (3.13) and the second-best opposing average (.205).

SECOND HALF SILAS

After starting the season hitting .187 with a .281 OBP, C **Silas Ardoin** is hitting .275 since the return from the All-Star Break (July 19) with a .393 on-base percentage. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best catchers in MiLB - his 64.4 SB% against him is best among Double-A backstops with at least 50 games behind the plate this season.

THE NEED FOR SPEED

The Baysox stole 44 bases in the month of August - the most in a month by Bowie this season and second-most among Eastern League sides. Since August 13, Bowie has stolen 34 bases, which ranks for third-most at the Double-A level during that stretch.

DUCKS ON THE POND

The Akron RubberDucks have won nine consecutive games against the Bowie Baysox. Akron took four of six from Bowie at Canal Park last month, and have won 12 of 17 in the season series after winning the first five games this week. Akron's roster currently includes five of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com), including 1B/OF C.J. Kayfus (No. 7), C Cooper Ingle (No. 15), LHP Parker Messick (No. 20), OF Petey Halpin (No. 28), IF Kahlil Watson (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Trenton Denholm gets the ball in the series finale for Akron. Denholm was Tuesday's winning pitcher for Akron, going seven innings and allowing just one run on a solo home run to **Frederick Bencosme**. Denholm has allowed just two runs in his last 20 innings. The right-hander was a 14th round pick of the Guardians in 2021 out of UC Irvine, where he pitched with Baysox right-hander **Peter Van Loon**. Denholm features a fastball, slider, curveball and changeup.

Manager
