YOUNG DRIVES IN THREE IN LOSS: Chris Bec and Jordan Groshans both homered, but the Yard Goats jumped out to an early lead and held on to beat New Hampshire for the second straight night. Reilly Hovis surrendered three home runs in three innings of work before being relieved by Jon Harris. A total of six New Hampshire pitchers worked in the game. Sunday's game was canceled due to Hurricane Henri.

BINGO: Binghamton has dominated New Hampshire over the course of this season, losing just two games and winning nine of the eleven played between the two sides this year. In fact, the last two series' that New Hampshire lost were both at the hands of the Rumble Ponies. Every game in the last series was decided by four runs or fewer.

YOUNG AND WILD AND FREE: Chavez Young saw his nine-game hitting streak snapped on Saturday, but that did not stop him from becoming the Double-A Northeast Player of the Week. Against Hartford, Young hit .476 with three home runs and three doubles, driving in nine runs with an OPS of 1.524. Young becomes the third Fisher Cat to win weekly honors this year after Vinny Capra and Gabriel Moreno.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: August 24, 2011—The Fisher Cats blew out the Trenton Thunder 16-3 at Delta Dental Stadium. New Hampshire received a strong start from Drew Hutchison, who pitched five scoreless with seven strikeouts in his Double-A debut. Eight of the nine starters for the Fisher Cats had at least two hits. Travis d'Arnaud hit his 19th homer and Danny Peralta his third.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays hosted the White Sox in the first game of a four game series. Vlad dromed in a run as Breyvic Valera scored on a wild pitch in the eighth to give the 'Jays a 2-1 win. Jordan Romano earned the save in the ninth. This week, Dunedin visits Lakeland, Vancouver plays at Hillsboro, and Buffalo hosts Worcester. Brock Lundquist homered as the FCL Jays no-hit the Tigers.

UP NEXT: Binghamton and Portland visit Delta Dental Stadium over the course of this 13-game homestand, before New Hampshire visits Reading in the final road series of the year.

STARTERS:

Strikeout merchant Luis Quiñones will look to continue his excellent run of form in the series opener. In his last 18.2 innings of work, he has fanned 32 while allowing just ten hits and two earned runs. He picked up his first Double-A win last week against Hartford, going five innings without allowing a run, giving up one hit and striking out nine.

Connor Grey will make his first start against the Fisher Cats tonight. Grey was initially part of the Diamondbacks organization, but was signed by the Mets in late June. Grey has taken three straight losing decisions, and last time out gave up eight hits and six runs to Portland. In July, he took a no-hitter into the ninth inning with Brooklyn.
