TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Tonight, your Quakes host the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in the third game of a six-game series. Tonight is Thirsty Thursday, as fans will enjoy \$3 Pepsi products and \$5 domestic 16-ounce drafts, thanks to Tam's Burgers. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the 15th of 24 head-to-head games and the 12th of 15 here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 11-3 against the Storm with the Quakes owning a 9-2 record here at home. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 at home.

LAST GAME: The Storm battled back from two runs down over their final three innings, sinking Rancho on Wednesday night at LoanMart Field by a final of 4-2. One night after the Rancho bullpen posted eight innings of scoreless relief, they struggled over three innings, after starter Aidan Foeller fired a career-best six scoreless frames. The Storm tied the game with two in the seventh against Michael Vilchez, then took the lead for good with two against Ryan Brown (2-4) in the ninth. Storm center fielder Ryan Wideman had three hits and two RBIs in his debut, also making a leaping catch at the center-field wall to end the game on a ball hit by Joendry Vargas. Storm closer Adam Conrad benefited from the catch, earning his third save. Vargas hit a solo homer in the fourth, his third of the year. **ELKINS TAKES OVER RBI LEAD:** One day after RBI-leader Samuel Munoz was promoted to High-A, Jaron El-

kins moved into a tie for the team lead with 65 RBIs, driving in a run in Tuesday's 6-1 win over the Storm. Last night, Elkins took over the top spot all to himself with another RBI hit, giving him 66 on the year. That number is tied with Inland Empire's Raudi Rodriguez for second in the league, trailing only San Jose's Dakota Jordan (82). Elkins also leads the team and the California League, with 60 stolen bases in just 65 attempts.

WELCOME BACK TO JOENDRY VARGAS: 19-year-old infielder Joendry Vargas has spent a significant amount of time on the Injured List this year, with two different stints. Vargas homered last night, giving him his first hit since being activated from his latest injury stint. Vargas is hitting .248 in 25 total games, with three homers, 20 RBIs and 17 steals in 19 attempts. He's ranked by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 11th-best prospect overall.

DEFENSIVE HICCUPS: Sunday was a step forward, as the team played error-free, but the Quakes had another tough series defensively, as they committed a total of nine errors over the first five games of the Fresno series. In this series against Lake Elsinore, they've committed two errors in each of the first two games, giving them a league-worst 139 errors in 104 games and a league-low fielding percentage of .963.

STERLING PATICK: 20-year-old Sterling Patick makes his 16th start and 20th appearance, his third start against the Storm. In two starts against Lake Elsinore, Patick is 0-0 with a 1.00 ERA, allowing just one run on eight hits over nine innings. In his last start overall, Patick allowed two runs on three hits over four innings in a no-decision at Fresno on August 1. Patick was a 2023 18th-round selection for the Dodgers out of South Hills High School in West Covina.

KANNON KEMP: 20-year-old righty Kannon Kemp makes his ninth appearance and third start for the Storm, his second start and third appearance against the Quakes. In his two outings against Rancho, he's 1-1 with a 2.70 ERA, allowing three runs on 12 hits over ten innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed seven runs on five hits over two innings in a no-decision vs Inland Empire on August 2. Kemp was drafted by San Diego in the eighth round of the 2023 out of Weatherford High School in Weatherford, Texas, but didn't make his pro-debut until May 3rd of 2025 because of a right shoulder injury.
