RIDERS WIN BEHIND FOURTH-INNING HOMERS:

With a four-run eighth-inning rally, the Frisco RoughRiders flipped the score and beat the Tulsa Drillers 6-4 Sunday at Riders Field, taking the series and season series in the process. In just his third game back from offseason internal brace surgery, **Sebastian Walcott** laced a solo home run in the first inning to supply Frisco (12-9, 51-38) with a 1-0 lead against Tulsa (12-9, 58-32) starter Myles Caba. Immediately in the second inning, the Drillers responded with three runs to take the lead against **Blake Townsend**, including a home run from Hayden Gilliland. Down 4-2 into the eighth inning, Frisco loaded the bases with no outs against Christian Ruebeck (0-1) after hits from Walcott and **Dylan Dreiling**. Then, **Arturo Disla** slapped a game-tying single into right field and Keith Jones II capped off the rally with a two-run base hit to take the lead 6-4. In the ninth inning, **Eric Loomis** picked up two strikeouts and his second save.

HUNGRY LIKE THE WOLFF:

Frisco has owned the Missions at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium since 2021, going 43-18 (.705) in San Antonio. During this stretch, Frisco has a 2.52 ERA as a team in the ballpark and has outscored the Missions by an average score of 4.9-2.8 (299-169). In 2024, the Riders went 12-1 at The Wolff.

DOWN BY WAY OF THE K:

The Riders are 2nd in the Texas League in pitcher strikeouts this season. Frisco has the 4th-most strikeouts in Minor League Baseball with 170 (11.3 per game) in their last 14 games.

WALCOTT'S RETURN:

Rangers No. 1 prospect **Sebastian Walcott** returned to the lineup on Friday after undergoing internal brace surgery on his right elbow in February. In 2025, as a 19-year-old, the No. 10 prospect in baseball hit .255/.355/.386/.741 with 13 home runs, 59 RBIs and 32 stolen bases. He became the 1st Texas League teenager to have double-digit homers, 30+ SB since **Roberto Alomar** in 1987 with Wichita. In his first 3 games this year, he is 4-for-11 with a home run, 2 walks, 1 stolen base and 3 runs scored.

RAFE AT HOME:

Riders infielder **Rafe Perich** has an incredibly clutch for the RoughRiders, homering 10 times in his first 39 games with the RoughRiders. All of but 4 of his 10 home runs have either tied the game or gave the RoughRiders the lead, including his go-ahead, 2-run home run in the 8th on Tuesday in Corpus. The Riders are 9-0 when he homers. His 21 home runs this year are tied for the most in the Rangers organization. With 5 3-hit games in July already, he is batting .404 (21-for-52)/.475/.642/1.057 in the month. For the first time in his career, he had 3 hits or more in 3 games in a row. Since May 31st, he is 3rd in the Texas League in average (.336), 77th in RBIs (30), 5th in OBP (.431), 1st in SLG (.664), 2nd in OPS (1.095), 3rd in hits (48), 1st in doubles (15), 1st in extra-base hits (26), 1st in total bases (95) and 1st in runs (41).

RIDERS ARE POSTSEASON BOUND:

The Riders clinched a playoff spot with a win on June 18th, capturing the Texas League South Division 1st Half. The Riders have now made the playoffs 11 times, their first berth since 2024, with two championships in 2004 and 2022. The Riders have now won the first half 9 times, their first since 2024. Frisco finished the first half 39-29 (.567).

BIG POWER STRETCH:

In their last 21 games, Frisco is 1st in the Texas League with 40 long balls and 3rd in all of Minor League Baseball. Their 123 home runs through 89 games are the most in franchise history, as are their 6.2 runs per game (the 4th-highest mark in Double-A since 2005) with Tulsa, this week's opponent, owning the best mark since 2005.

OH, YOU THINK THE DARKNESS IS YOUR ALLY:

The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (192 runs). In the 8th inning, over the last 9 games, the RoughRiders scored 20 runs, the most in the minors.

LOTS OF RUNS IN THE FIRST INNING:

Frisco's 59 runs in the 1st inning this year are 3rd in the Texas League. They have scored in the 1st inning in 30 games and have scored multiple runs in the 1st inning in 14 games this season. The Riders are 10-11 when trailing after one inning this year, including winning 4 games last week in Corpus Christi in which they allowed runs in the 1st inning. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 24-36 (including a combined 9-11 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 27-2 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 22-20 in 1 or 2-run games.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 89 games the RoughRiders are 1st in Double-A with 813 hits. They are 1st in the league in batting average (.269) and 2nd in runs (546, 6.2 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 42 percent of their games (37-of-89). The Riders are 2nd in the Texas League in homers (123), 1st in doubles (161), 1st in SLG (.453) and 1st in OPS (.813).

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2025 SEASON

-In his first outing of the 2025 season, worked out of the bullpen in long relief, allowing four runs over 3.2 innings to Corpus Christi.

-Finished May with a 3-0 record and 1.37 ERA over 5G/4GS, 26.1 IP, 21 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 12 BB, 11 K. His 1.37 ERA was second among Texas League starters with at least four games started.

2024 SEASON

-Began 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

2021 SEASON

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging 10.0 strikeouts per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.

2019 SEASON

-Saw minimal pro action after being drafted. Posted a 9.9 SO/9 figure over 7 G for Spokane (A) and AZL Rangers (Rk.).

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with RoughRiders: 9

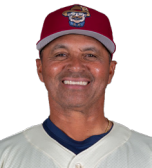
Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).
