CORNWELL, YEAGER DRIVE CARDS' 6-3 WIN OVER SURGE: Alex Corn-

well allowed just 2 runs over 6.1 IP and the Cardinals scored 3 runs in the top of the 9th inning as Springfield defeated the Wichita Wind Surge 6.3 on Thursday night at Riverfront Stadium. RJ Yeager went 2-for-4 and tied a season high with 4 RBIs and Noah Mendlinger went 3-for-4 for the Cardinals. Springfield also tallied 4 stolen bases. Andrew Marrero retired all 5 batters he faced after coming on for Cornwell in the 7th inning. The Cardinals have won 2 of the first 3 games of the series this week in Wichita.



DPPDSING STARTER: Right-hander **Marco Raya** makes his 22nd start of the season for Wichita...Took the loss in his last start at Midland last Friday, August 23 allowing 3 ER on 5 H with 3 K over 4.0 IP...Has pitched well in the month of August, compiling a 3.38 ERA over 5 starts, his best mark since putting together a 2.38 mark over 4 April starts...Had not thrown more than 4.0 innings any any start until July 26... Has starts of 5.0 IP and 6.0 IP since then...In 3 starts against the Cardinals this season is 0-1 with an 8.64 ERA...Springfield is batting .359 against him...In his last start against the Cardinals allowed 4 ER on 7 H in 4.1 IP and surrendered HR to Nathan Church and Jimmy Crooks...Split the 2023 campaign between High-A Cedar Rapids and Wichita and combined to go 0-4 with a 4.02 ERA in just 62.2 IP...Limited to 65.0 IP in 2022 with Low-A Fort Myers and went 3-2 with a 3.05 ERA over 19 appearances (17 starts)... Did not pitch in 2021 due to a shoulder injury...Selected by the Twins in the 4th round of the 2020 draft out of United South HS in Laredo, TX...Spurned a commitment to Texas Tech to sign with Minnesota for \$410,000...21 years old

CARDS WRAP UP SEASON SERIES WITH WIND SURGE IN SIX-GAME SERIES: With just 3 weeks left in the regular season, the Springfield Cardinals head to the Sunflower State for a six-game series against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins) at Riverfront Stadium. The Cardinals won 5 of 6 in Wichita in their first series in Kansas from May 28-June 2.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals! **ON PACE...**: With 16 games remaining in the 2024 regular season, the Cardinals are on pace for several team and individual franchise records:

- » Springfield is on pace to win 81 games this season, which would eclipse the franchise record of 77 (2012 & 2017).
- The Cardinals have tied the franchise record for road wins in a season with #38 on Thursday night, matching the 2008 club.
- » The current strikeout pace for the Cardinals pitching staff is 1,272, which would surpass the 2019 franchise record of 1,263.
- » With an average of .333, Bryan Torres is 12 points ahead of the Springfield record held by Tyler Minges who hit .324 in 2005
- » With 24 saves, Matt Svanson is within 3 of the franchise record of 27 (Mark Worrell, 2006 & Chris Perez, 2007)

DNE-SIDED SERIES: The season series between Springfield and Wichita has been controlled by the Cardinals in 2024. Springfield has outscored the Wind Surge 129-79 and despite being outhomered 25-16 in the series has a batting average 69 points higher (.297 to .228). The Cards have a 3.55 ERA against the Wind Surge, their best mark against any other North Division team. The Birds have a team ERA of 3.00 against San Antonio.

LONG, HOT SUMMER: The Cardinals are 33-15 since July 1, the best record in the Texas League during that time and 2nd-best in Double-A behind the Tennessee Smokies (CHC) who are 34-14. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 5-1-2 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .276. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.77, which is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a 4.75 ERA.

RDAD WARRIORS: For the duration of the 2024 season to this point, the Cardinals have been the best road team in Double-A. Springfield is 38-21 (.644) away from Hammons Field this season, a half-game better than the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) who are 37-21 (.638). The Cards have the best road mark in the Texas League by a wide margin; Frisco is 2nd-best with a record of 35-26 away from Riders Field (.573).

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 15 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 8 of their last 15 games, Springfield is 12-3 during that time. The Cards outscored their opponents 33-10 in the 8th inning or later.

STAFF AGING LIKE FINE WINE: The later into the 2024 season, the better numbers the Cardinal pitching staff has put up. August has been the best month for Springfield hurlers to date, as the Cards are 3rd in the Texas League with a 3.29 ERA.

FOR STARTERS: Springfield's starters since August 1 have the 2nd-best ERA in the Texas League at 2.50, trailing only Midland (2.45). . Since the beginning of their series against the Drillers last Tuesday the Cardinals' rotation leads Double-A with a 1.88 ERA over their last 9 games.

SIANI REHABBING: St. Louis Cardinals rookie OF **Michael Siani** continues his rehab stint with Springfield this weekend. In 101 games with St. Louis this season **Siani** is batting .256 with 2 HR and 18 RBIs while ranking top-10 among CF in MLB with 9 Defensive Runs Saved. He was placed on the 10-day injured list on August 4 with a right oblique strain.

TORRES ON ANOTHER PLANET: Among qualified hitters in the Texas League, nobody has been swinging a hotter bat in the month of August than Cardinals INF/OF **Bryan Torres**. Despite an taking an 0-for-4 on Thursday night, **Torres** is batting .432 through 22 games in the month with 8 2B, a home run and 12 RBI while compiling a .500 OBP and 1.157 OPS. He has recorded multiple hits in 11 of his last 15 games and is a scorching-hot .492 (32-for-65) since August 10. The Texas League Player of the Week for August 12-18, **Torres** leads the league in hitting (.333), OBP (.419), hits (135) and runs (73).

SLAM THE DODR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 24-for-24 and his 46 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 24.2 IP (0.36 ERA) and is 14-for-14 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has allowed just one unearned run over his last 19 appearances, allowing just 14 H with 19 K over 23.2 IP. The Cardinals are 51-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


