SYKORA DAY: After getting back in the win column last night by erasing a six-run deficit in the 5th inning, the FredNats send Travis Sykora to the mound tonight to face the Carolina Mudcats in game three of this final series of the regular season between the two teams. Carolina has already locked up the first half title and a playoff spot, and Fredericksburg hopes to join them by winning the second half. There is exactly one month left in the regular season as of today. Sykora, one of the hottest pitchers in the league right now, faces Carolina lefty Anthony Flores, who makes just his second start of the year with the Mudcats. Sykora's recent dominance is noted below.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Mudcats got off to a great start offensively for the second night in a row, ballooning their lead to six runs in the 5th inning before the FredNat offense exploded for seven runs in the 5th to take the lead back. FXBG got it up to 9-7 in the 7th, but Carolina scored two runs off Bryan Sanchez to get the game tied again heading to the 8th. The FredNats had four straight men reach to open the 8th, and Elijah Green's tie-breaking two-run single in that 8th inning ended up being the winning runs. FXBG scored four in the 8th and held Carolina off the board in the 9th to win a 13-9 marathon game.

WIN 200: Last night's win was the 200th for FredNat Manager Jake Lowery since he took over Managerial duties in 2022 in Fredericksburg. Lowery won 76 games in 2022, 65 games in 2023, and his 59th victory of this season last night gave him 200. Lowery led the FredNats to a second half title in 2022, a feat the Freddies hope to replicate this year.

HE'S SOMETHING ELSE: Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Washington organization since he joined the FredNats for his professional debut on May 1. He's tied for 8th in all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts per nine innings (13.50), 11th in hits per nine (5.18), and tied for 11th in opponent average (.165). In his last five starts covering 22 innings, Sykora is 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA, the opponents are hitting just .110 against him, and he has 39 strikeouts against just nine walks.

PITCHING HARDWARE: For his efforts last week, Travis Sykora was named the Carolina League's Pitcher of the Week, which was the first time this year a FredNat hurler earned a weekly award. Then, his former rotation mate Marc Davis was announced as the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for July after posting an 0.45 ERA in 20 innings across four July starts. Davis was promoted to High-A Wilmington on July 26 for his efforts.

DON'T LET HIM GET HOT: Elijah Green homered twice last week in Lynchburg, and had an extra-base hit in four out of five games last week as well. Since July 1, Green is slashing .253/.371/.467/.837 and has posted a wRC+ of 145 (100 is league average), and a wOBA of .397 (.313 is league average). He also cut his strikeout rate by 9% from June, and his walk rate in July was 14%.

LEADOFF BRENNER: Friday night, Brenner Cox crushed the first pitch of the baseball game over the right field wall to get the FredNats off and running. It was Cox's sixth home run of the year, and the third time this season the FredNats have led off a road game with a home run. In last night's game, Cox had an RBI double, a single and two walks and he leads the team with a .742 OPS, and he's third on the team with 34 RBIs depsite missing a month with a thumb injury. Cox is also second on the team in outfield assists with 11.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 200-165 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

TONIGHT'S START: Travis Sykora is making his 15th professional start this evening for Fredericksburg, against the Carolina Mudcats.

He was taken in the third round by Washington in the 2023, who gave him double-slot money to sign him away from a commitment to pitch at the University of Texas. That, along with some command issues that popped up during his senior year at Round Rock HS, caused him to fall from a first-round projection into the third.

QUICK CLIMBER: Sykora was promoted to the FredNats during the late April series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, but did not pitch. He also did not pitch last year after being drafted, but Washington felt he was ready to jump to full-season ball and will bypass the Florida Complex League entirely.

Sykora's calling card is a big fastball that reached 101 MPH on the prep circuit, and will sit in the mid to upper 90's. He pairs the heater with a splitter and a tight slider, both in the mid 80's.

A BIG MENTOR: Sykora has been open about how much he looks up to fellow Texan Nolan Ryan. Travis sees similarities in their two deliveries, between a high leg kick and "elbows and knees flying everywhere," Sykora said in a MLB.com interview. He was able to meet Ryan this offseason.

LAST TIME OUT: Travis fired five no-hit innings against the Hillcats last week, allowing a lone baserunner on a walk while fanning eight men to earn his second win of the year.
