TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST GAME'S RESULT - The St. Paul Saints gave up a grand slam in the first and six runs over the first three innings, losing 6-4 on Saturday night at CHS Field. Down 6-0, the Saints got home runs from Mark Contreras, his eighth, and Jake Cave, his 10th, to help with a comeback, but it wasn't enough. Mario Sanchez tossed 4.0 shutout innings of relief giving up one hit while striking out five.

JET LAGGED: All 20 teams in the International League will play on Monday, July 4, the first time that will happen this season. JUST ANOTHER MANIC MONDAY: For the first time as a Triple-A affiliate, the St. Paul Saints will play a game on a Monday when they take on the Louisville Bats on July 4. The Saints play three Monday games this season. The other two are September 19 @ Indianapolis and September 26 vs. Omaha.

S-CAVE-NGING FOR BASES: Jake Cave was hit by a pitch in his third at bat on Sunday extending his streak of reaching base safely to 47 consecutive games. It's the first time he's extended the streak with a HBP. During the streak, which began on May 3, he has a hit in 37 of the 47 games. In the 10 games he has failed to collect a hit, he has drawn at least one walk nine times and has been hit by a pitch once. It's the longest streak in franchise history, topping the 20 consecutive by Jimmy Kerrigan last season. It's the second longest streak in Minor League Baseball this season. The longest streak is 51 consecutive games by Luke Berryhill of Corpus Christi from April 14-June 21. The last time Cave didn't reach base was a five inning game on April 30 against the Nashville Sounds when he went 0-2

FIRST INNING FLOP: The St. Paul Saints have allowed at least one run in the first inning in 34 of 77 games (44.2%) the Saints have allowed at least a run in the first inning. They have allowed 72 runs in the first, most in the International League and third most in all of Minor League Baseball: Albuquerque (85) & Stockton (73).

EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT: The St. Paul Saints have played 77 games this season and have an extra base hit in all, but one game. They have an extra base hit in 69 consecutive games, the second longest streak in all of Minor League Baseball. The only team with a longer streak is El Paso's 78 game streak, which is also active. The lone game they didn't collect an extra base hit was the game they were no-hit on April 13 vs. Indianapolis. They have just one extra base hit in only 10 games.

TRIPLE J: Jake Cave continues to fly around the bases. He collected his league leading seventh triple on June 30 vs. Omaha. The seven triples are by far a franchise record, with no one collecting more than two last season. No player in the International League has collected more than eight triples in a season since 2015 when Ben Gamel of Scranton/Wilkes-Barre had 14 and Allen Hanson of Indianapolis had 12.

AND THEN THERE WERE SIX: The St. Paul Saints are a part of the final six, but not a final six they care to be included in. The Saints have yet to throw a shutout in 2022. They are one of only six Minor League teams that have yet to throw a shutout. They are joined by the Charlotte Knights in the International League, the Chattanooga Lookouts in the Southern League, Columbia Fireflies and Delmarva Shorebirds in the Carolina League, and the Visalia Rawhide in the California League. The Saints 5.30 ERA in the second lowest of the six teams. Chattanooga's ERA in 5.20.

QUALITY OVER QUANTITY: Mario Sanchez pitched an outstanding game on June 25 at Buffalo throwing 6.0 innings allowing just two runs. It was the third quality start by Sanchez this season and just the fourth by a Saints pitcher this season. Sanchez had back-to-back quality starts on May 26 vs. Indianapolis and June 2 @ Iowa. Chi Chi González tossed a quality start on May 11 @ Columbus. The Saints, however, are just 2-2 when a starter throws a quality start.

TWINS UPDATE - The Minnesota Twins dropped the finale of their series to the Baltimore Orioles 3-1 on Sunday afternoon at Target Field. The lone run came on a Jorge Polanco RBI single. Devin Smeltzer went 6.0 innings and allowed three solo homers. Juna Minaya pitched 2.0 shutout innings and struck out three while Jovani Moran tossed a hitless, shutout inning and struck out two.

LAST START: 6/28 @ CLE...tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing four hits while walking one and striking out one...received the win in a 6-0 Twins victory.

START PRIOR: 6/22 @ BUF...pitched 4.0 innings allowing one run on one hit, giving up one home run, while walking two and striking out three...did not receive a decision in a 3-2 Bisons victory.

METEORIC RISE: Prior to the 2021 season, Winder was the #19 rated prospect in the Twins organization. Just a year later he is now the #6 rated prospect in the organization.

EMBRACE THE SUCK: Winder spent three years at Virginia Military Institute. He took some of that mentality into his civilian life which is evident on days he pitches. On the mornings of the days he pitches, he cleans his room. He wants to make sure everything is in order and it helps clear his mind.

LEADING MAN ON OPENING NIGHT: The Wichita Wind Surge built a brand new ballpark and were originally supposed to be the Triple-A affiliate for the Miami Marlins in 2020. The pandemic, and the reshuffling of the Minor League system, scrapped that plan and instead they became the Twins Double-A affiliate in 2021. On Opening Night of the franchise, May 4, 2021, Winder got the start at Springfield (St. Louis Cardinals). He tossed 4.2 scoreless innings allowing five hits while walking one and striking out six in a 2-0 Wind Surge victory.

SHOULD HAVE TAKEN THAT LEFT TURN AT ALBUQUERQUE: There was never a thought that Winder was going to Virginia Military Institute, but he wound up on their campus during a travel ball tournament. As he was driving away following the tournament he never thought he would return. The coaches at VMI saw him at a baseball camp, got him on campus and sold him on all the benefits, good attributes, and traits you acquire, almost by default (see previous note), by being around that kind of environment

AMONG THE TREES: At 6'5 Winder is among that tallest players on the team. He joins Jordan Balazovic and Jhoan Duran at the 77 inch mark. The only two players on the team taller than those three are Ryan Mason (6'6) and Trevor Megill (6'8).

PAN SEARED: A 14-strikeout performance is impressive no matter the level, but for Winder on March 24, 2017 it wasn't enough. During his senior season at VMI he fanned 14 Citadel Bulldogs allong just two earned runs in a complete game. Unfortunately, current #26 New York Yankees prospect, J.P. Sears, fanned 20 Keydets that day becoming the fourth pitcher in SoCon history to strike out at least 20.

TOUGH TO BEAT: Those that dive into the analytics will tell you pitchers wins aren't as an important of a stat as many fans think. Don't tell that to Winder who has never been below .500 at any point in his career. He's only lost three games coming into the 2022 season: August 19, 2018 vs. Johnson City (St. Louis Cardinals), May 6, 2019 @ South Bend Cubs (Chicago Cubs) & July 12, 2019 @ Great Lakes Loons (Los Angeles Dodgers).

POUNDING THE ZONE: If you like pitchers that work quickly and hit their spots, then Winder is your guy. Throughout his career he throws strikes on 68% of his pitches. To put that into perspective only five Major League pitchers had a strike percentage of better than 68% (Julio Urias 69.9%, Tyler Anderson 69.3%, Nathan Eovaldi 69.0%, Brandon Woodruff 68.3%, and Kevin Gausman 68.1%).

WHIPPING THE OPPOSITION: Don't expect to get too many hits or free passes off Winder. Across 236.1 innings pitched, Winder has a WHIP (walks/hits per innings pitched) of under 1.00 at 0.99. The Major League average in 2021 was 1.297. Anything below 1.00 is considered excellent and probably puts you in the running for a Cy Young.
