ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones suffered one of the toughest gut-punch losses of the season, losing 11-7 after holding a 6-1 lead through five innings. C **Jose Mena** and 3B **William Lugo** hit back-to-back home runs in Brooklyn's five-run first inning. However, Wilmington stormed back and took the lead with a six-run eighth inning capped by 1B **Leandro Emiliani's** grand slam off of RHP **Dylan Hall**. Mets No. 28 prospect RHP **Christian Scott** struck out six over four innings, allowing one run on six hits with no walks. 1B **JT Schwartz** tallied three hits and OF **Matt Rudick** doubled and drove in a run.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 10 games remaining and two series: four more games vs. Wilmington, and six games at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting in first place by a half game over the New York Yankees affiliate the Hudson Valley Renegades.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .908 over his past 42 games with a 29-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 40 of the past 42 games, hitting .329 with a .418 OBP.

JT JOLTING: Since returning from injury on August 17, 1B **JT Schwartz** is hitting .353 with a .914 OPS, going 18-51 with five doubles, a home run in 12 games. Coincidentally, Schwartz's first game back from injury was also the day he fell from the No. 19 spot in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Mets list to being out of the ranking.

LUGO LAUNCHING: Over his past four games, 3B **William Lugo** has a double, two home runs, and seven RBIs, hitting .438 (7-16). Lugo has blasted four home runs with Brooklyn and has a career-high 14 overall after 10 long balls with Low-A St. Lucie.

vs. WILMINGTON: The Washington Nationals affiliate comes back to Coney Island for the final meeting of 2022. The Blue Rocks, from Wilmington, DE are 12-10 against the Cyclones in 2022. Wilmington hosts three of Washington's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: No. 10 OF Jeremy De La Rosa, No. 27 LHP Mitchell Parker, and MLB rehabber No. 29 LHP Evan Lee. The Blue Rocks enter Thursday's game seven games behind first place.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league and the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball, having allowed 489 runs in 122 games (4.0 runs/game).

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 506 runs in 122 games (4.1 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and tied for ninth-worst in MiLB in fewest runs.

SHERVYEN FOR PRESIDENT: INF **Shervyen Newton** won the South Atlantic League's Offensive Player of the Week Award for his week in New Jersey against the Phillies High-A farm club, going 9-for-23 (.391) with three doubles, three home runs, 10 RBIs, and eight runs scored in the six-game sweep.

TOP 30 UPDATE: *MLB Pipeline's* new rankings that were released earlier this month: OF **Alex Ramirez** at No. 4, RHP **Mike Vasil** at No. 11, RHP **Dominic Hamel** at No. 12, RHP **Junior Santos** at No. 16, OF **Stanley Consuegra** at No. 23, RHP **Christian Scott** at No. 28 and LHP **Keyshawn Askew** at No. 30.

BREAKING THROUGH IN YEAR TWO: OF **Alex Ramirez** leads all Mets minor leaguers with 126 hits, sitting 11 hits ahead of 3B **Brett Baty** who has stopped accumulating minor league hits, now playing third base for the New York Mets. Ramirez also leads the organization with seven triples.

QUALITY TIME: Moreno tossed six innings of two-run ball last week in a victory over Jersey Shore. Moreno compiled his first quality start since July 27.

AGAINST WIL: Moreno has had two outings against Wilmington and has posted a 7.36 ERA, allowing nine runs (six earned) in 7.1 IP with six strikeouts and five walks.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Luis Moreno won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the week for his performance at Hudson Valley between July 25-31.

MORE-K-NO: Moreno struck out a career-high nine batters at Hudson Valley on July 2 in his first appearance against the Yankees affiliate.

WELCOME: Moreno earned the promotion on June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

BIG YEAR: The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as "quality starts."

2022: With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

ELIMINATING HOMERS: Moreno's 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

JUMP IN: Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
