- The Hammerheads used an early lead to take the series opener from Dunedin 9-6 on Tuesday night at TD Ballpark.
- Jupiter scored four runs on five hits in the second, and then grew the lead to 5-0 with a run in the top of the third.
- The Blue Jays got on the comeback trail in the bottom of the third, as Jean Joseph belted a solo homer. Manuel Beltre and Cristian Feliz followed with two-out RBI singles.
- Dunedin trimmed the lead down to 5-4 on a Joseph RBI single in the fourth. Jupiter got the run back on a Colby Shade homer in the fifth, before Feliz picked up an RBI single in the bottom half to make it 6-5.
- Jupiter scored three in the sixth, thanks in part to four consecutive walks and two wild pitches issued by Kai Peterson.
- Maykel Minoso doubled in Feliz in the seventh, but Dunedin couldn't muster another run.

### YOU'VE GOT OUR NUMBER

With last night's win, Jupiter moved to 7-0 this season against Dunedin. The Jays were swept by the Hammerheads in a six game series in Jupiter, April 23-28. The sweep marked the first time ever Dunedin was swept in a six game series. Jupiter's pitchers only allowed 5 ER in those six games (55 IP). The Blue Jays matched those 5 ER last night.

### STAYING UP LATE

Dunedin continued its trend of scoring late runs last night with a seventh inning tally. The Blue Jays have scored in the seventh inning or later in 11 of their last 12 games. The Blue Jays hold a +9 run differential in the final three innings this season (58 runs scored, 49 runs allowed).

### FANTASTIC MR. FELIZ

Blue Jays slugger Cristian Feliz collected three hits last night - marking his first three-hit outing of the season. The big night extends a hot start to May, as Feliz is batting .268 with a .909 OPS. The 6-foot, 4-inch first baseman has ripped six homers this season, good for the team lead and second in the Florida State League.

### SINGLES IN OUR AREA

Of the 25 combined hits in last night's game, 19 were singles. Each team tallied three extra base hits. Jupiter's 13 hits were the second most allowed by the Blue Jays in a single game this season.

### STRONG FIRST IMPRESSION

Blue Jays outfielder Jean Joseph is off to a strong start in Single-A, having reached in all 14 games he's played with Dunedin. The on-base streak is Dunedin's longest active streak and one of five active on base streaks 14 games or longer in the league. Joseph has batted leadoff in each of the last five games.

### GETTING OUR STEPS IN

The Jays are tied for third in the FSL in walks drawn with 155 (behind Tampa and Lakeland, tied with Clearwater). However, Dunedin's pitching staff has walked the most batters in the league at 175.

### TRACK MEET

The Hammerheads stole seven bases in last night's game - the most allowed by Dunedin in a single game this season. In seven games against the Blue Jays, Jupiter has stolen 29 bases on 39 tries (74%). On the other side of the scorebook, Dunedin didn't steal a base last night.

### ROCKY RELIEF

The Blue Jays bullpen has struggled across the last eight games. In 42.1 innings, Dunedin relievers have allowed 35 earned runs (7.44 ERA). In the prior five games, the 'pen pitched to a 2.11 ERA (5 ER in 21.1 IP).

### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

23 of the Blue Jays 34 games this season have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 8-15 record in those games, including last night's loss.

### ABOUT JUARON

- Selected by the Blue Jays in the 3rd round of the 2023 draft out of Oklahoma State... Did not make pro debut in 2023.
- Grew up in Hanford, CA; located west of Visalia and south of San Jose. Same hometown as 1996 National League MVP Ken Caminiti.
- Throws a four pitch mix that features a low-90s fastball, slider, curve and changeup. Mid-80s slider has been considered his best pitch by scouts
- Was a three-sport star at Hanford High School... was the school's starting varsity quarterback and also played basketball.
- Was originally committed to Texas Tech out of high school, but Red Raiders pulled offer after a football injury suffered his senior year.

- Opponents batting .326 against fastball... but sub-.200 against slider, changeup
- Turned in season-high 6 innings on 5/8 at Fort Myers... allowed 4 runs, just two earned.
- Struck out seven but allowed 4 ER in 4.2 innings on 5/1 vs Tampa... threw season-high 85 pitches.
- Posted a then-season-high six strikeouts on 4/24 at Jupiter - allowed 1 ER on a solo homer.
- Took the loss on 4/17 vs Clearwater... Allowed 1 run in first four innings; allowed three runs to score in 5th.

### COLLEGE

- Played two seasons of college baseball - the last of which at Oklahoma State in 2023. Pitched to a 5.03 ERA in 17 appearances and 15 starts, totaling to 82.1 innings. Struck out 124 batters (13.6 K/9) to lead the Big 12.
- Started collegiate career at Long Beach State in his home state of California... missed 2021 season with a shoulder injury (sustained playing football in high school), but broke out in his redshirt freshman year in 2022. Earned Freshman All-American honors, firing a 3.68 ERA in 15 appearances, 12 of them starts. Struck out 111 hitters in 73.1 innings (13.6 K/9).
- Threw a 9-inning, 11 strikeout no-hitter for Long Beach State on Mother's Day 2022, with his mom in attendance.
- Played in the prestigious Cape Cod league in the summer of 2022 and posted a 3.71 ERA in 34 innings for Falmouth.
