CROWING A NEW STRIKEOUT KING: RHP Tobias Myers set the Shuckers' new single-season strikeout record with a fourthinning strikeout of **C Edgar Quero** on Saturday, giving him 158 strikeouts on the year... He broke the previous record of 157, set by RHP Alec Bettinger in 2019... With nine strikeouts on Saturday, Myers is the first Southern League pitcher in 2023 to reach 160 strikeouts in the season.

A STRONG SEPTEMBER: INF Zavier Warren has tallied a hit in six of his first seven September games, including five multi-hit performances... In September, Warren is hitting .444 (12-27) with two double, two home runs and four walks... Entering today, Warren is among the September Double-A leaders in average (T-3rd, .444), OPS (6th, 1.241) and on-base percentage (10th, .500).

SMASHING INTO THE LEAD: C/1B Wes Clarke hit his 24th home run of the year on Friday, putting himself atop the Southern League home run leader board... Clarke's 24 home runs are the most he's hit in any season of his college and professional career.

🐉 If the season ended today, Clarke's 24 home runs would be the second-most by a Shuckers' player in franchise history (since 2015)... The single-season franchise record is 27, set by **OF Corey Ray** in 2018.

LEADING THE LEAGUE: OF Carlos Rodriguez has recorded multiple hits in three straight games, including tying his careerhigh with four on Friday... Entering today, Rodriguez leads the Southern League with a .299 average.

📚 If the season ended today, Rodriguez would own the third-highest single-season average in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015)... He would also become the first player in franchise history to win the batting title.

SAVING THE DAY: RHP Cam Robinson picked up his 15th save of the year on Saturday, the most out of any pitcher in the Southern League... Since the start of August, Robinson has picked up eight saves and has allowed one earned run in 16.1 innings of work, a 0.55 ERA... During this current road trip, Robinson has thrown 5.2 scoreless innings with four saves.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: If the season ended today, the Biloxi Shuckers would miss the 2023 Southern League Playoffs... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs for the first time since 2019; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify. The Shuckers are 1.5 games behind the Montgomery Biscuits for the division lead with seven games remaining...

The two teams will face each other for the final six games of the year at MGM Park... As it stands today, the Shuckers would need to win four of six against the Biscuits to make the playoffs.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TJ SHOOK (9-5, 5.27): RHP TJ Shook makes his 11th start of the year and his second of the week after he threw six shutout innings on 58 pitches during Tuesday's series opener... In two appearances against the Barons, Shook has allowed two hits over 10 shutout innings of work... Shook has worked into the sixth inning each of his last two starts, including tying his season-high with six innings last time out.
