The reigning NL Player of the Week, Patrick Wisdom, hit a solo home run in the 18-game streak, Davis is hitting .306 (22-for-72) with 11 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, 13 walks wisdom, hit a solo home run in and 6 stolen bases. It's the 3rd-longest active streak in the International League.

**LAST OUTING:** The last time Ethan Small pitched was his Major League debut with Milwaukee on May 30 at Chicago-NL. He went 2.2 innings and allowed two runs on four hits and four walks. Small struck out four batters and threw 38 of his 69 pitches for strikes in Milwaukee's 7-6 win.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Small is facing Norfolk for the second time this season and in his career. In a start on May 6 at First Horizon Park, Small allowed a season-high five runs in his only loss of the season (4.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 2 BB, 6 K). Small threw 53 of his 94 pitches for strikes.
