PAPILLION, NEBRASKA - The Omaha Storm Chasers could not complete a weekend sweep Sunday, dropping the series finale at Werner Park to the Iowa Cubs, 2-0.

- ❑ The I-Cubs worked onto the board almost immediately, as a walk and home run put Omaha down two batters into the game ... from there, starting pitcher **Andrew Hoffmann** settled into a groove, limiting the Cubs to four singles through the fifth inning, with five strikeouts ... the right-hander retired his final seven hitters of the game but received little in the way of run support.
- ❑ Behind Hoffmann, the Storm Chasers bullpen continued to have a strong weekend as the arms of **Walter Pennington**, **Dan Altavilla**, **Steven Cruz** and **Will Klein** combined for 4.0 scoreless frames ... Pennington and Klein each struck out three, for 11 total strikeouts as a staff, the third straight game with 10+ strikeouts as a team.
- ❑ Omaha struggled offensively, held to five to three singles through the first five innings and five singles across the first eight ... the closest the team came to getting on the scoreboard was the sixth inning, when a **Nick Pratto** single was sandwiched by walks from **Nate Eaton** and **Tyler Gentry**, but the tying run was left in scoring position as a double play ended the inning.
- ❑ Pratto's single increased his season-opening hitting streak to three, while **CJ Alexander** and **Logan Porter** each contributed two-hit games, while **Nate Eaton**.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

WALK-OFF WINNERS

- ❑ Last weekend against Iowa, Omaha won the first two games of the season in walk-off fashion to start the season 2-0
- ❑ On Opening Night (March 29) **Cam Devanney** scored from third on a passed ball with two outs in the bottom of the 11th inning ... the next day, on March 30, **Mike Brosseau** brought **Devin Mann** home from third on a sacrifice fly in the 10th.
- ❑ Prior to last weekend, the Storm Chasers had not won consecutive games in walk-off fashion since *July 17 & 18, 2019 vs. New Orleans* ... on July 17, **Jacksson Flores** brought home **Brett Phillips** on a sacrifice fly, for an 11-10 win in 9 innings ... on July 18, **Erick Mejia** scored **Chase d'Arnaud** on a sac fly as well, for a 10-9 win in 10 innings.
- ❑ In 2023, Omaha only walked off as winners four times, with the first walk-off win not coming until June 2 vs. Memphis ... the 2022 Chasers walked off 7 times, while the 2021 team had 6 walk-off wins and the 2019 Omaha club had 7 walk-off wins ... last year, the Storm Chasers suffered 12 walk-off losses (1/3 of the team's road losses).

EXTRAS, EXTRAS, READ ALL ABOUT IT

- ❑ The Storm Chasers played extra-inning games in each of the first two games this season, the first time the club has played back-to-back extra-inning games since 2019
- ❑ Omaha played back-to-back extra-inning games July 2 and 3 @ Round Rock, both games they lost ... the Express beat the Storm Chasers 7-6 in 10 innings on July 2 and Omaha lost 9-8 in 10 innings on July 3.
- ❑ Twice in 2017, Omaha played back-to-back extra inning games but lost both games, both times ... the last time the Storm Chasers won back-to-back extra inning games was July 6, 2016, when Omaha won both games of a day/night doubleheader in Iowa against the Cubs ... the Chasers won the first game, 4-3 in 8 innings, then won the second game, 7-5 in 9 innings.

RELIEF AID

- ❑ Omaha's bullpen was one of the best in Triple-A during the season's first weekend, as the relievers combined for a 2.65 ERA over the first three games.
- ❑ A 2.65 ERA (4 ER in 17.0 IP) ranks 3rd out of the 20-team International League and 6th among the 30 Triple-A teams ... 17.0 innings pitched by the bullpen ranks sixth among Triple-A teams over the first weekend.
- ❑ 13 of 15 individual relief appearances by Storm Chaser bullpen arms have been scoreless over the first three games of the season ... 4 of the 5 runs allowed by Omaha relievers came from one pitcher, when **John McMillon** allowed 4 earned runs in 0.1 innings on March 30 vs. Iowa.
- ❑ 8 of those 15 appearances have been both hitless and scoreless, with 4 perfect outings so far from Omaha relievers.

CLIPPING COLUMBUS

- ❑ Today marks the first of 18 games against the Clippers in 2024 for Omaha, the first of 12 games the Storm Chasers will play at Huntington Park.
- ❑ In 2023, Omaha went 13-5 against the Clippers, including 7-5 on the road at Columbus ... the Chasers' 3.98 ERA (70 ER in 158.1 IP) against the Clippers was the best of any team in the International League.
- ❑ Last year, few in the league put up better numbers against Columbus than **John Rave** ... among the 16 players that had at least 60 plate appearances against the Clippers in 2023, Rave's .311 average (19-for-61) ranked 4th, while his .960 OPS ranked 6th, both marks that led Omaha against Columbus.
- ❑ The best arm in the league last year against Columbus was **Walter Pennington** ... he worked a league-best 0.90 ERA (1 ER in 10.0 IP) with 10 strikeouts ... he ranked 1st among IL pitchers (min. 10 IP) in ERA and WHIP (0.70) against the Clippers, with 2 H.

Making his first start of the 2024 season ... made his final big league Spring Training appearance on February 28, pitching in MiLB camp after.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 2 Cactus League games (0 starts) and went 2-0 with a 5.40 ERA (2 ER in 3.1 IP), with 2 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023 After opening the year at NW Arkansas (AA), Bowlan earned a promotion to Omaha on June 20 and made 14 appearances (12 starts) for the Storm Chasers, before earning his first big league call-up on September 19.
Having not pitched into the 6th inning in over two years, did so in five of his final seven outings with Omaha ... three of his last four starts with the Chasers were quality starts - 8/30 vs. LOU (6.0 IP, 1 ER), 9/5 @ IOW (6.0 IP, 2 ER) & 9/16 vs. IND (6.0 IP, 2 ER).
669 days after being added to the 40-man roster (on 11/19/21), was called up by the Royals for the first time on September 19 and made his Major League debut 8 days later on September 27 at DET as KC's opener, his first of two MLB outings ... struck out Parker Meadows to begin the game and allowed a solo home run to Miguel Cabrera in the 2nd inning, Miggy's final MLB homer.
2022 After undergoing Tommy John Surgery in 2021, returned to the mound June 17 in the Arizona Complex League and made seven starts with the ACL Royals (R), one start with Quad Cities (A+) and finished the year with NW Arkansas (AA) for his final nine starts.
Was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 22 to 28, after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings on August 28 vs. Springfield (STL) and allowing just two hits with two strikeouts to earn his first win of 2022 with the Naturals.
After allowing two home runs in each of his first two starts, allowed three homers over his last seven starts ... 10 of 33 runs (30%) allowed with NWA came on home runs.
2021 Began the season with NW Arkansas (AA) and started four games for the Naturals, going 2-0 with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER in 17.0 IP).
Left his start May 23 @ Springfield (STL) after striking out two and throwing 10 pitches ... missed the rest of the season after undergoing Tommy John surgery on June 1.
2019 Split the year between Lexington (A) and Wilmington (A+), combining to go 11-5 with a 3.14 ERA (51 ER in 146.0 IP) with 150 strikeouts (9.24 K/9), compared to just 23 walks (1.42 BB/9).
Among Royals farmhands, ranked tied second in wins, third in strikeouts, fifth in innings, eighth in starts (23) ... among pitchers who threw at least 80.0 innings, ranked first in strikeouts/walk ratio (6.52), second in WHIP (0.99) and eighth in ERA (3.14).
Threw the second no-hitter in Wilmington (A+) history on July 15 vs. Carolina (MIL), with 9 strikeouts and 0 walks on 98 pitches (63 strikes) ... the lone base runner reached on an error in the second inning ... earned Carolina League Pitcher of the Week honors on July 21.
2019 Made nine starts for Idaho Falls (R) during his first pro season ... pitched to a 2.25 ERA (4 ER in 16.0 IP) in his first 4 starts, culminating in his first victory on July 7 @ Orem (LAA), allowing 1 run on 2 hits over 5.0 innings, with a season-high 6 strikeouts.
COLLEGE (2017-2019) Pitched collegiately at the University of Memphis for three seasons, where he posted a 3.71 ERA (35 ER in 85.0 IP) with 104 strikeouts in 2018 as a junior for the Tigers.
Notched double-digit strikeouts three times in 2018 and fanned a school record (and 2018 Division I-best) 18 hitters in a complete game win over South Florida on April 28.
MISCELLANEOUS 2015: Graduated from Bartlett High School (Tennessee) where he was named Male Athlete of the Year as a senior ... played the first three years of high school baseball at Arlington High School, helped them to a state championship in 2012 as a freshman.
His father, Mark, threw the lone perfect game in the history of the University of Memphis program (1987 - 1989) and pitched two seasons (44 games) in the St. Louis Cardinals' organization (1989 & 1991).
