SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

BEST IN CLASS: Baseball-America released their Double-A Best Tools and Prospects Awards on Tuesday, as voted on by league managers... The Shuckers took home several Southern League honors, including; OF Jackson Chourio - Best Batting Prospect and Most Exciting Player, INF Tyler Black - Best Strike-Zone Judgment and RHP Jacob Misiorowski -Best Fastball.

OH, HOW SWEEP IT IS: The Shuckers swept the Tennessee Smokies on Sunday with a 7-3 win, their second sweep of 2023 and their first against the Smokies since 2019... Over the six-game sweep, the Shuckers outscored the Smokies 37-17, including three games decided by two runs or less.

ACING HISTORY CLASS: OF Jackson Chourio enters today with 21 home runs and 37 stolen bases, three away from becoming the first player in Double-A since 2005 to record a 20/40 season and the 12th player in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat since 2005.

📚 Chourio enters today with a 14-game hit streak, the longest active streak in the Southern League... Over that span, the Brewers' top prospect is hitting .306 (19-62) with two doubles four home runs and a .870 OPS.

OUT OF THE ARM BARN: Over the Shuckers' seven-game win streak, the bullpen has a 1.64 ERA, the fifth-best mark in Double-A... The bullpen has thrown 22.0 innings during the seven-game stretch and has allowed four runs on 19 hits.

SPEEDING INTO HISTORY: The Shuckers stole their 200th base of 2023 on Saturday night, becoming the ninth Southern League team since 1980 to reach 200 in a season... Since 1980, the eight other teams to reach 200 are the Montgomery Biscuits in 2022 (203) and 2019 (213), the Birmingham Barons in 2002 (220) and 1989 (264), the 2000 Carolina Mudcats (209), the 1994 Knoxville Smokies (203), the 1983 Savannah Braves (203) and the 1981 Nashville Sounds (205).

WELCOME TO HISTORY, KID: With a two-run home run on Thursday, OF Jackson Chourio became the first teenager with at least 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season between Double-A and/or Triple-A since OF Delmon Young in 2005 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB)... Chourio also set a new career-high with his 21st home run of the year on Friday.

Shourio also became the third teenager in Double-A/Triple-A to reach 20 home runs in a year since 2005, joining OF Delmon Young (2005, MTG) and 1B Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (2018, NH/BUF)... He's one of five players in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to hit at least 20 in a season.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: If the season ended today, the Biloxi Shuckers would miss the 2023 Southern League Playoffs... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs for the first time since 2019; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division.

📚 The Shuckers are a half-game behind the Montgomery Biscuits for the division lead with 12 games remaining... The two teams will face each other for the final six games of the year at MGM Park... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TJ SHOOK (5-4, 5.00): RHP TJ Shook makes his 10th start of the season and first against the Barons... Previously, Shook threw four shutout innings in relief against the Barons on July 28 at MGM Park... In his last start, Shook worked around a season-high five walks to go 5.2 innings, his second-longest start of the year... Shook has worked into the fifth inning in each of his last three starts.
