YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Fisher Cats, 3-2, in 11 innings. Brandon Martorano hit a two-run homer, his first with the Flying Squirrels this year, to open a lead in the fifth inning. In the sixth, Devonte Brown brought the Fisher Cats back within a run with an RBI single. New Hampshire tied the game with a sac fly by Miguel Hiraldo in the bottom of the seventh. After a scoreless 10th inning, Andy Thomas brought home the winning run with a fielder's choice groundout in the top of the 11th. Tyler Myrick worked three scoreless innings to pick up his first win of the year. John Michael Bertrand started for the Flying Squirrels and threw five scoreless innings despite a career-high five walks. It was his seventh scoreless start this year, all at least five innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays, in the finale of a six-game series on the first leg of a 12-game road trip to New England. With a win, the Flying Squirrels will take their first series win since taking five-of-six in back-to-back series against Reading and Bowie from May 14-26 before dropping four-of-six at home against Erie and Altoona the last two weeks. This series is the only meeting between the Flying Squirrels and Fisher Cats this year. This is also the first series for the Flying Squirrels in Manchester since August 2-7, 2022, a six-game split. This series marks the second of three road sets this year for Richmond against teams from the Northeast Division. They opened the season going 1-2 in a three-game set at Somerset from April 5-7. Next week, they will play their final road series against the Northeast Division with six games at Portland.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a five-game losing streak with their win on Wednesday night and have now won three-of-four. They had gone 3-9 in their previous 12 from since May 29 through Tuesday. In their previous 13 games from May 15-28, they went 11-2. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They had won five-of-six in two straight series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9.

THE FISHER CATS are in fifth place in the Northeast Division. This year, the Fisher Cats have the second-most hits (504) in the Eastern League. New Hampshire's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Blue Jays prospects, including OF Alan Roden (No. 7), LHP Adam Macko (No. 9), SS/3B Josh Kasevich (No. 11), RHP CJ Van Eyk (No. 17) and 3B/SS Alex De Jesus (No. 23). Baseball America's top-30 Blue Jays prospects list includes three New Hampshire players, including Kasevich (No. 7), Roden (No. 8) and Macko (No. 11). Baseball America also lists Kasevich as the best defensive infielder, Macko as the best curveball, Roden as the best hitter for average and Garrett Spain as the best outfield arm.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Carson Ragsdale makes 13th start of the season and his second of the series against the Fisher Cats. In the opener on Tuesday, he picked up a loss despite allowing one run over five innings. In the Eastern League this season, Ragsdale has the second-highest K/9 (11.78) and second-high strikeout percentage (32.1%) among qualified pitchers. In his three starts against teams from the Northeast Division, he is 1-1 with a 1.93 ERA (3 ER/14.0 IP). Last season, he made seven starts for High-A Eugene, going 0-1 with a 2.93 ERA. His season ended in May with an oblique injury. At the time of the injury, he was leading the Northwest League in strikeouts (42) and ranked third in innings pitched (27.2). In 2022, he made five appearances in the Arizona Complex League but missed most of the year after having Thoracic Outlet Syndrome surgery in the spring. Ragsdale was selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida. Before making his professional debut, he was traded to the San Francisco Giants on January 9, 2021 for pitcher Sam Coonrod. For more on Ragsdale, see page two.

FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE: Right-hander Michael Dominguez makes his 13th start of the year and second against Richmond this week. On Tuesday against the Flying Squirrels, he allowed one hit over five scoreless innings but issued five walks. It was his second scoreless start in his last three outings, also throwing six hitless innings on May 30 at Akron before allowing six runs over 1.2 innings at Erie on June 5. On the year, Dominguez has the second-highest walk percentage (13.1%) and second-highest BB/9 (4.98) in the Eastern League. A native of Newport News, Va., Dominguez was selected in the 15th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Blue Jays out of Jefferson High School in Tampa. He first joined the Fisher Cats last August and went 1-1 with a 4.29 ERA over eight starts in the Eastern League to close the year.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked fourth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,008).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas is batting .337 (28-for-83) over his last 25 games since May 15 with two homers, seven doubles, a triple and 18 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .263. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. Last Wednesday night, Thomas came off the bench and hit an RBI triple in the eighth inning for an insurance run, the second triple of his professional career. Last Thursday, he hit his second homer of the season. He added two hits on Friday and an RBI double on Saturday. On Wednesday at New Hampshire, he went 3-for-3 with a walk and caught a shutout.

OPEN THE GATES: This season, **Evan Gates** has posted a 1.27 ERA (5 ER/35.1 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League (min. 30 IP). Gates posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) over his first 12 appearances of the season through May 18. After allowing four runs (three earned) in his two outings May 23 and 26 against the Baysox, he pitched 31 scoreless innings on May 31 against the SeaWolves, the longest outing of his career, and struck out four batters. In that appearance, he issued a walk to the first batter he faced before retiring the next 10 batters in order to finish his night. Gates followed with a six-out save against the Curve in a combined shutout on June 4. He has not allowed a run in his last five outings since May 31, spanning 10.1 innings. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in 2022, Gates has pitched 68 Double-A games, combining for a 3.16 ERA (35 ER/99.2 IP).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last nine games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .333 (13-for-39) with two homers, three doubles, two walks and seven RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on Friday night. In his last 19 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .296 (21-for-71) with five homers, four doubles, nine walks and 16 RBIs.

HELLO, JAIRO: In this week's series in Manchester, **Jairo Pomares** is batting .471 (8-for-17) with two homers, two doubles and seven RBIs. He went 1-for-4 on Tuesday before picking up a pair of hits, including a double, on Wednesday night, driving in a season-high three runs. He matched the three RBIs on Thursday night with a double and a homer. Pomares homered for the second straight game on Friday night, one of his two hits in the game. His eight hits over the last four starts are the most in a four-game span for him this year.

MARTY PARTY: Brandon Martorano hit his first Double-A homer of the year on Saturday night, a two-run shot in the Flying Squirrels' 3-2 win over the Fisher Cats. In his three games with Richmond, Martorano is batting .333 (4-for-12) with the homer and a walk. In parts of four seasons with the Flying Squirrels, Martorano has played 201 games. His 23 career homers are tied for ninth in Flying Squirrels franchise history, even with Tyler Fitzgerald, Dylan Davis and Hunter Cole and two behind the next spot on the list, with is 25 by Frankie Tostado in eighth.

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26) and LHP José Cruz (No. 28), On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes five Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23), OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26) and RHP Carson Ragsdale (No. 30).
