YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Rumble Ponies, 7-2, behind a pair of homers and a three-hit day by Hayden Cantrelle. He opened the scoring in the third inning with a solo homer. In the fourth, Riley Mahan hit a two-run triple and Cantrelle followed with a two-run homer to open a 5-0 lead for Richmond. Binghamton scored its only run against starter Ryan Murphy in the fourth with a two-out, RBI single by Hayden Senger. In the fifth, Carter Aldrete brought in a run with a sac fly to extend the lead to 6-1. Matt Rudick closed the gap to four runs with a solo homer in the bottom of the seventh. Cantrelle picked up his third hit and his fourth RBI with a single in the top of the eighth, extending the lead to 7-2. Richmond reliever Wil Jensen struck out seven batters and allowed one run over 3.1 innings. Matt Frisbee threw two scoreless frames to finish the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels third the first of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' first set in Binghamton since 2019. That year, Richmond swept a three-game set at NYSEG Stadium from June 21-23. Since 2017, the Flying Squirrels are 8-3 in Binghamton. They have won three consecutive road series in Binghamton, going 2-1 in 2017, 2-1 in 2018 and 3-0 in 2019. The last series loss for Richmond in Binghamton was a three-game sweep from June 24-26, 2016. The Flying Squirrels were supposed to play a six-game series in Binghamton from August 31-September 5, 2021, but it was canceled. This year, Richmond is 4-1 against opponents from the Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are tied for first in the Southwest Division, even with Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 12-of-their-last-19. Richmond has won three-of-four dating back to Saturday. The Richmond pitching staff has a 3.67 ERA, which is second in the Eastern League. Richmond starter have thrown 141.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 200.1 innings this year, the second-most in Double-A behind Erie. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 2.88 ERA, which is the lowest of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball.

THE RUMBLE PONIES have alternated wins and losses over each of their last eight games and split last week's series in New Hampshire. After starting the season 11-10, the Rumble Ponies have gone 7-12 in their last 19 games. Binghamton's .220 team batting average is the second-lowest in the Eastern League. Their 4.96 team ERA is ninth in the league and their 5.63 bullpen ERA is second-highest. Binghamton's roster includes three of Baseball America's top-30 Mets prospects, including RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 11), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 12), RHP Junior Santos (No. 20) and RHP Luis Moreno (No. 24). Jose Peroza is rated as the organization's best defensive infielder. MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects list includes RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 7), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 9) and RHP Junior Santos (No. 17).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Landen Roupp makes his fourth start of the season. He last pitched on Friday in Richmond against the RubberDucks and threw two perfect innings with two strikeouts. He made his Double-A debut against the Rumble Ponies on August 21, 2022 at The Diamond and allowed four runs over four innings with six strikeouts in his only Double-A loss to date. In his first full professional season in 2022, Roupp climbed three levels in the Giants system. He began the year working primarily as a reliever with Low-A San Jose, going 5-2 with a 2.59 ERA in 14 outings. Roupp moved to High-A Eugene in late-June for seven starts, going 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA. He was promoted to Richmond on August 18 for the remainder of the season and went 2-1 with a 3.76 ERA in five starts. Roupp made one start against the SeaWolves last year, allowing two runs over five innings in his final outing of the year on September 15 at The Diamond. Roupp was selected by the Giants in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UNC Wilmington, where he was the 2021 CAA Pitcher of the Year. For more on Roupp, see page two.

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Jose Chacin makes his sixth Double-A start and eighth Double-A appearance of the year. He pitched on Friday at New Hampshire and allowed two runs over four innings in a loss. Chacin was originally signed by the Dodgers in 2015 out of Venezuela. He pitched in that organization until he was released in 2021 and signed as a free agent with the Mets a month later. Chacin began the 2022 season with High-A Brooklyn before a promotion to Double-A on May 2. In 23 outings (20 starts) with Binghamton, he went 4-8 with a 5.67 ERA. After opening 2023 with Triple-A Syracuse for one outing, he returned to Binghamton on April 11.

HEY HAYDEN: On Wednesday night, **Hayden Cantrelle** homered twice for the second time in his career. He finished the night with three hits and four RBIs. He has reached base 11 times in his last four games dating back to Saturday, hitting .500 (4-for-8) with two homers, five walks, one HBP and five RBIs. For the year, Cantrelle is ranked fourth in the Eastern League in on-base percentage (.419).

ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE: Carter Aldrete homered three times over a five-game stretch from May 17-21. He has driven in eight runs over his last seven games since May 17. In his last 15 games since May 6, he is batting .310 (18-for-58) with four homers, four doubles and 10 RBIs. For the season, Aldrete is ranked tied for sixth in the Eastern League with 24 RBIs.

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder **Vaun Brown** was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. In the nine games on his rehab assignment, Brown hit .351 (13-for-37). Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com. Baseball America also lists Brown as the Giants' best athlete and best hitter for average. He picked up his first Double-A hit last Thursday night and added his first Double-A homer on Saturday night, a three-run shot to center.

WELCOME, WADE: The Flying Squirrels activated Wade Meckler on May 17 and he made his Double-A debut that night, picking up three hits and scoring two runs. This year, Meckler leads the minors in batting average (.427) and ranks tied for 10th in OBP (.474). He began the season with High-A Eugene and hit .456 in 20 games. He is rated by Baseball America as having the "best strike-zone discipline" in the Giants system. Meckler was selected by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oregon State. He played 23 regular-season games last year after the draft, including 11 games to close the season with Low-A San Jose, where he hit .439 in 11 games.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: Richmond relievers have posted a 2.88 ERA this season, which is the lowest of all 120 teams in the minors. Of Eastern League pitchers who have worked at least 15 innings and have not made a start this year, four Flying Squirrels relievers are ranked in the top-12 in ERA. **Raymond Burgos** has the lowest ERA (0.96), **Nick Swiney**, who is now in Triple-A, is ranked second in ERA (1.15). **Blake Rivera** (1.72 ERA) is eighth and **Wil Jensen** (2.00 ERA) is 12th. Out of all Eastern League pitchers, starters and relievers, who have thrown at least 25.0 innings this year, Jensen has the third-lowest ERA.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked seventh in batting average (.304) and 10th in OBP (.398). Ismael Munguia is eighth in batting average (.300) and tied for ninth in hits (39). Carter Aldrete is tied for sixth in RBIs (24). Riley Mahan is tied for sixth in RBIs (24). Hayden Cantrelle is fourth in OBP (.419). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for first in triples (3). Kai-Wei Teng is sixth in strikeouts (46), ninth in BAA (.209) and eighth in WHIP (1.14). Evan Gates is tied for seventh in saves (4).

WHERE THE RUMBLE PONIES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Matt Rudick is second in batting average (.328), fifth in RBIs (25), first in OBP (.468), fourth in SLG (.582), second in OPS (1.050), tied for seventh in hits (.40), tied for fifth in doubles (10), tied for fifth in walks (.28), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (.17), seventh in total bases (.71) and tied for third in runs scored (.30). Jose Peroza is eighth in SLG (.520) and 10th in OPS (.905). Wyatt Young is tied for seventh in walks (.27). Nate Lavender is tied for seventh in saves (.41).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
