NOTES AND NUGGETS

STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM, NOW WE'RE HERE

After an 0-4 start to the season, the Storm Chasers have won 12 of their last 20 games.

- Last season, the Storm Chasers won just 6 of 27 series played ... Omaha has won 3 consecutive series over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis.
- Last week's series win was the Storm Chasers' 3rd straight ... Omaha never won back-to-back series last year ... the last time the Chasers won 3 series in a row was a stretch from April 23 to June 2, 2024 with 6 straight series wins.

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

The Storm Chasers are tied for the 5th-best fielding percentage in the International League at .982, committing just 15 errors in 24 games (1st: Rochester, .989) ... Omaha is tied 17th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams in fielding %.

- The clean play extends throughout the roster - of Omaha's 13 qualified fielders (min. 50.0 inn), 7 have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, led by **Kevin Newman** (157.0 innings) in the infield and **Kameron Misner** (173.1 innings) in the outfield.
- 27 double plays turned by the Storm Chasers are tied 1st in the International League and tied 2nd in the Minors... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10+ double plays, led by 15 from **Abraham Toro**.

DON'T GET CAUGHT

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by one of the International League's best baserunners.

- Omaha's 88.9% stolen base rate (32-for-36) leads the IL, is tied 1st at the Triple-A level and ranks tied 9th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- John Rave** leads Omaha and is tied 5th in the International League in steals (10) while **Gavin Cross** is 2nd on Omaha with 7 stolen bases ... Rave and Cross are 2 of 5 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught.

CHALLENGING THE SYSTEM

The Omaha Storm Chasers have one of the better Triple-A teams at converting ABS challenges in their favor in 2026.

- Omaha's 61% win rate on challenges ranks tied 3rd at the Triple-A level ... 69 total challenges and 42 successful challenges both rank 3rd-most in Triple-A.
- Part of the Chasers' success comes from how aggressive the catchers have been ... **Elias Diaz**, **Eli Marrero**, **Luke Maile** and **Luca Tresh** have challenged at a 3.3% rate, the highest in Triple-A, and have won 27 of 43 defensive challenges (63%), with a level-leading 7 strikeout flips while ranking tied 2nd with 5 walk flips.
- At the plate, Omaha hitters have converted 15 of 26 challenges (58%) ranking tied 4th in Triple-A in success rate... 8 strikeouts flips from the hitters are 1st in Triple-A.

MISNER ON A MISSION

Outfielder **Kameron Misner** has been the heart of Omaha's offense to open 2026.

- Misner has reached base safely in 20 of 22 games this season, with hits in 18 of 22 ... he has also driven in a run in 15 of 22 games, with 23 RBI this season ranking 3rd in the International League and tied 6th in the Minors.
- Early in the season, he produced a league-best 11-game hitting streak from March 28 to April 10, going 13-for-37 (.351) with 3 doubles, 2 homers and 14 RBI.

WHAT A RELIEF

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the team's strengths this season, with a handful of arms standing out.

- Eric Cerantola** has been Omaha's most reliable relief arm to open the year, with 10.0 scoreless innings over 9 games and a Minor League-leading 5 saves ... 10.0 scoreless innings are tied for the 3rd-most scoreless innings in the International League ... factoring in last year, Cerantola last not allowed a run since August 21, 2025, a 22.1 inning scoreless stretch that spans his last 19 outings with Omaha.
- Chazz Martinez** has begun his year with 7.0 scoreless innings in 6 outings (since April 7), while **Jose Cuas** has worked 7.0 straight shutout frames (since April 4).

HOLY TOLEDO

Since the Chasers joined the International League in 2021, they have won 8 of 15 series with the Mud Hens, but won just 2 of 6 series played in Toledo.

- The Storm Chasers have won 4 of their last 6 series with Toledo across the last 2 years ... since 2024, Omaha is 22-18 (.550) against the Mud Hens.
- On the other side this week is former Storm Chasers outfielder **Tyler Gentry**, who signed a Minor League contract with the Tigers on April 11 ... Gentry's 364 games with Omaha between 2023 and 2025 rank 4th-most in the club's Storm Chasers era (since 2011) ... since 2011, he ranks 3rd for Omaha in walks (162), 5th in plate appearances (1393), 6th in doubles (69), 6th in homers (41), 7th in RBI (164).

TODAY'S START

- Mitch Spence is making his **2nd start** with the Storm Chasers this year, his **2nd Triple-A start** and his **3rd overall appearance** this season.
- Playing his **7th professional season** this year ... the Royals are his 3rd Major League organization, after being drafted by the Yankees and spending the last two years with the Athletics.

A NEW SPENCE OF PURPOSE

- MAKING SOME SPENCE:** This is just Spence's 3rd game this season ... his first outing of the year came in Omaha's 8th game, working 5.0 innings with just 1 unearned run allowed, *Omaha's only 5-inning start this year* ... he was recalled by the Royals on April 9, but did not get in a game for over a week, pitching in a long relief/mop-up role on April 18 ... was optioned back to Omaha on Sunday, April 19.
- START ME UP:** Spence bounced between the rotation and bullpen in the A's organization the last two years ... he almost exclusively started with the Yankees in the Minors between 2021 and 2023 ... his first month and a half of 2024 with the Athletics came as a reliever before moving to the rotation in June ... he again opened 2025 in the A's bullpen before moving to the rotation in June ... he remained a starting pitcher after he was optioned to Triple-A last year, but 2 of 3 MLB outings in September were in relief.

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, APRIL 18 @ NEW YORK (AL)

- Made his first (and only) Major League appearance with the Royals, 9 days after being recalled by Kansas City ... after starter Noah Cameron pitched 4.0 innings, took over on the mound in the 5th and worked 4.0 innings of relief ... pitched a 1-2-3 inning in the 5th, before surrendering 3 runs in the 6th, including a 2-run homer to Cody Bellinger ... allowed an RBI triple in the 7th, then a sac fly in the 8th.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Was designated for assignment by the Athletics on February 10 and traded to Kansas City on February 12 in exchange for RHP A.J. Causey.
- Appeared in 3 Cactus League games for the Royals, pitching to a 10.29 ERA (8 ER in 7.0 IP) with 11 hits allowed and 2 strikeouts ... optioned to Omaha on March 18.

CAREER NOTES

- Spent much of the year in the Major Leagues with the Athletics, splitting time as a starter and reliever ... made the A's Opening Day roster for the second straight year and opened the season as a reliever, making 22 relief appearances with a 4.38 ERA (19 ER in 39.0 IP) and 37 strikeouts before June 2.
- Made his first start of the year June 5 and worked a 1.20 ERA (2 ER in 15.0 IP) in his first three games as a starter ... optioned to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 10 and pitched in 8 games (7 starts) before the Athletics recalled him on September 10 for the remainder of the season.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Was the 1st overall pick by the Athletics in the Rule 5 Draft on December 6, 2023 ... spent all of 2024 in the Major Leagues with Oakland and posted a 4.58 ERA (77 ER in 151.1 IP) with an 8-10 record and 126 strikeouts to 44 walks (2.86 K/BB) across 35 games (24 starts).
- Pitched part of 2022 and all 2023 in with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (AAA) in the Yankees organization, producing an all-time 10-11 record with a 4.33 ERA (103 ER in 214.1 IP) and 201 strikeouts to 69 walks (2.91 K/BB) across 39 Triple-A starts.
- In 2023, led the minors with 163.0 innings ... also ranked 3rd in MiLB in pitches (2,564) and tied for 3rd in starts (29) ... led the International League in innings and starts and ranked 2nd in strikeouts (153).
- Opened 2022 with the Somerset Patriots (AA) and pitched in 17 games (15 starts) before his promotion to Triple-A on August 2 ... spent all of 2021 with the Hudson Valley Renegades (A+) and put up a 3.94 ERA (46 ER in 105.0 IP) with 118 strikeouts to 37 walks (3.19 K/BB) in 23 games (20 starts) at High-A.
- Made his professional debut in 2019 with the Pulaski Yankees (R) after New York drafted him in the 10th round of the 2019 MLB Draft ... pitched exclusively out of the bullpen and earned 4 saves.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Pitched 3 seasons (2017-19) for the University of South Carolina-Aiken (Peach Belt Conference, D2) ... worked a career 17-10 record with a 3.83 ERA (86 ER in 202.0 IP) and 243 strikeouts (10.8 K/9) for the Pacers ... in 2018, struck out 117 batters in 92.0 innings (11.4 K/9) with a 3.03 ERA (31 ER in 92.0 IP).
- Is the all-time saves and career ERA leader at Green Hope High School (NC).
