Tonight's Game: The Brewskis play the Tides in game four of the six-game series tonight. Norfolk has taken the first three games of the series with ease outscoring the Sounds 28-14. Nashville will send right-hander Chad Patrick to the bump and go against right-hander Chayce McDermott for Norfolk.

Chad Patrick: The 25-year-old will make his fifth start for the Sounds this season. He is 1-0, with a 4.91 ERA (18.1 IP/10 ER) and 15 strikeouts. Nashville is 4-0 in games that Patrick starts. His last time out at Louisville, he went 5.1 innings, eight hits, five earned runs, three walks, six strikeouts and picked up the win. It was his first win at the Triple-A level in 10 career appearances (nine starts). It was Patrick's first win since July 30 at Midland, 11 appearances ago. The Sounds' offense has averaged 7.50 runs per start which is top among Sounds starters with more than one appearance. His 94 pitches in the outing were his season-high and the most in a game for him since August 18, 2023 at Reno while pitching for Triple-A Las Vegas.

Chayce McDermott: The 25-year-old righty will make his seventh appearance (sixth start) for Norfolk this season. He is 0-1, with a 3.80 ERA (21.1 IP/9 ER), 23 walks and 30 strikeouts. In his last outing versus Gwinnett, McDermott only retired two batters, allowing one hit, one earned run, three walks and two strikeouts on 36 pitches. He has walked at least two batters in each start this season including five in each of his first three starts. Last season, he split time between Double-A Bowie and Triple-A Norfolk. He went 8-8 with a 3.10 ERA (119.0/41 ER), 68 walks and struck out 152. In back-to-back weeks (7/30/23 and 8/6/23) he was named the International League Pitcher of the Week by posting consecutive scoreless outings (11.0 IP, 3 H, 4 BB, 14 K). McDermott was drafted in the 4th round from Ball State in the 2021 draft by the Houston Astros. He was traded to the Orioles on August 1, 2022. In 66 career minor league appearances (49 starts, he has a 4.10 ERA (265.1/121 ER) with 166 walks and 382 strikeouts. His brother, Sean McDermott played basketball for Butler University and in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies.

We are Young: Chavez Young launched his second home run of the season and his first hitting left-handed. His first home run came against Omaha on April 21 off the batter's eye. Not known for his power, Young only has 38 career home runs in 2094 minor league at-bats. In nine games since April 21, he is 7-for-32 with six runs scored, five RBI, and four walks.

Miller High Life: Owen Miller returned to hit city with two hits of his own. Miller has reached base in all 14 games he has played for Nashville this season and is riding a 10-game hitting streak. Both are team-highs for the Sounds this season. He is hitting .370 (20-for-54) with seven walks, eight strikeouts and a .935 OPS. In his time with Milwaukee from April 16 to April 28, Miller appeared in seven games and was 1-for-12 at the plate. He logged innings at first base, second, base, third base, and pitched an inning in relief.

Yonny being Yonny: Yonny Hernández had his second consecutive two-hit game last night. He is tied for the team lead in multi-hit games with Tyler Black and Brewer Hicklen with nine. Since April 23, he is batting .324 (11-for-34) with six RBI and five runs scored. Among qualified hitters on the Sounds, Hernández has the second-lowest strikeout percentage (.156) and the second-highest BB/K ratio (.824).

Triple the Fun: The Sounds had two triples last night in the third inning (Owen Miller and Noah Campbell). It was the first time with two triples in the same inning since June 22, 2021 vs. Charlotte (Tim Lopes and Mitch Longo). With 13 total on the season, the Sounds lead the International League and trail only Albuquerque (16) in triples. It was Campbell's first career Triple-A triple and his first since May 27, 2023 versus Montgomery. He is riding a 21-game on-base streak between Biloxi and Nashville.

Open the Gate: Nashville scored six runs in the first inning of last night's contest. It was the third time this season that the Sounds have at least six runs in an inning (7, April 9 at Memphis, 8, April 7 vs. St. Paul). The last time that the Sounds scored over six runs in the first inning was when they had eight versus Jacksonville on July 21, 2023 in a 17-3 victory. That game included two eight-run innings with the other coming in the sixth led by a five-hit performance by Abraham Toro.

4K TV: Jared Koenig also made his return to Nashville, working a scoreless fourth inning with two punchouts. In five appearances out of the pen for Milwaukee, Koenig posted a 1.04 ERA (8.2 IP/1 ER) with four strikeouts. In five appearances with Nashville, he has a 1.59 ERA (5.2 IP/1 ER) with ten strikeouts.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 696-600 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,288-2,120 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

LAST OUTING: Patrick picked up the win at Louisville on April 26. He went 5.1 innings, allowing eight hits, five earned runs, three walks and striking out six. In the start, Patrick set season-highs in strikeouts, hits, earned runs, pitches thrown and strikes thrown.
