Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second in a six-game series against the Cedar Rapids Kernels, High-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins, the second leg in the Lugnuts' 12-game, 14-day road trip to the Hawkeye State. The Nuts split a six-game series at Quad Cities to open the road trip, winning the last two games over the weekend before dropping a slugfest last night in the opener. Cedar Rapids is 5-2 against the Nuts this year, winning four of six games in Lansing earlier this season.

Last Night: Kernels 12, Lugnuts 9. Cedar Rapids jumped on Lansing starter Jake Garland for eight runs in 1 2/3 innings, including a two-run triple from Ben Ross and a two-run homer from Jorel Ortega, holding off the Lugnuts to win the opening game in the six-game series. In the loss, the Nuts received home runs from Colby Thomas and Junior Pérez and two RBI doubles from Brennan Milone.

On the Air: Calvin Christoforo calls the action on Bally Live and MiLB TV, with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler delivering an audio-only call via StreamGuys.

On Deck: The Nuts wrap things up with the Kernels on Sunday before returning to Jackson Field for a two-week homestand against the Fort Wayne TinCaps and the Great Lakes Loons, running from August 8-20 at Jackson Field.

Congratulations! 1B/OF Danny Bautista, Jr., who enters today on a 13-game on-base streak, was honored as the Midwest League's Player of the Week for the week of July 25-30, collecting 11 hits in 24 at-bats (458 avg.) with three doubles, one home run and four RBIs in six games. Bautista, Jr. increased the level of his performance as the week went on, collecting a single in each of the first two games, a single and a double in each of the next three games, and finishing with two singles and a two-run homer on Sunday. His closest competition for the weekly honor was teammate Colby Thomas, who slashed .462/.481/.654 with 12 hits in 26 at-bats, two doubles, one triple, one walk and one stolen base. The two Lugnuts topped all Midwest Leaguers in batting average for the week.

Welcome Aboard: SS Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall selection in the 2023 draft from Grand Canyon University, debuted yesterday with a double, an HBP and a walk in his first three Midwest League plate appearances. The 21-year-old Wilson had played three games in the Arizona Complex League to open his professional career, going 5-for-11 with two doubles and an HBP. A three-year All-WAC 1st Team honoree, Wilson was named the Western Athletic Conference's 2023 Defensive Player of the Year while hitting .411 with only five strikeouts in 49 games. His father, Jack, played in the Major Leagues from 2001-2012 and coached him at Thousand Oaks High School and GCU.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: Miguel Rodriguez recorded the save in last night's Kernels win, following a familiar pattern: 16 of the last 18 games that the Lugnuts have played have featured a save. By month: 7 saves in 20 games in April (35%), 9 in 27 in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and now one in one game in August.

Turnaround: Outfielder Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is him, 264 (61-67-231). His slash line by month: April .089.1921.089, .281 (195, May - .2381.295/438, .733 OPS, June - .2561.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .2621.3611.393, .754 OPS; August - 1-for-4, home run, walk, .2501.400/1.000. He has reached base 13 times in the string through the stranks to eight hits and five walks.

What a Month: Lansing finished July with a 3.65 ERA, best in the Midwest League. Meanwhile the Nuts' offense batted .276 as a team in July, the 2nd highest average in the league this month, led by Daniel Susac (.360) and Danny Bautista, Jr. (.354). After only four double-digit hit games apiece in April and May and eight double-digit hit games in June, the Lugnuts collected at least 10 hits in 11 games in July.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 22-year-old Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom. 21-year-old Jacob Wilson was selected 6th overall from Grand Canyon this past July and joins his former high school teammate, 2021 first-rounder Max Muncy, as the top two shortstops in the system.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: The Bowling Green Hot Rods scored six runs in the bottom of the 8th inning to seize a 9-7 lead, and then closer Alex Koronis retired the first two batters in the ninth. With two strikes, Brad Glenn homered. With two strikes, A.J. Jimenez singled. And then Kevin Ahrens homered as well, catapulting the Lugnuts to an unexpected 10-9 victory at Bowling Green Ballpark. Sean Ochinko finished the game 4-for-5 with a three-run HR and five total RBIs. By the way: It was a sweltering day, 94 degrees at first pitch.

2022: Denzel Clarke beat out an inside-the-park home run to left field and Cooper Bowman homered in his first Lugnuts game, but the Nuts were outslugged by West Michigan, 15-8, at Jackson Field. Earlier in the day, 20-year-old Tyler Soderstrom was promoted to Double-A Midland. In 89 games with the Nuts, Soderstrom hit .260/.323/.513 with 19 doubles, three triples, 20 homers and 71 RBIs, departing as the MWL leader in RBIs and tied for first in homers.

In a Nutshell: The last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers this year was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in 2016, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016, spent last season with the Cincinnati Reds, and is currently in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch myers9.

International Respect: Mitch is ranked No. 3 in the world in the video game Super Monkey Ball.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... in last start, once again proved quality against the Quad Cities River Bandits.
