The Rivalry comes to Bridgewater: The Portland Sea Dogs (Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox) are in town this week for a six-game series. Somerset took four-of-six against the Sea Dogs in Maine in late June. Portland enters this series 1.5 games behind the Patriots for first place in the Northeast Division and one of the two Double-A Northeast playoff spots.

On Assignment: RHP Clarke Schmidt is scheduled to make his second rehab appearance for the Patriots tonight. The No. 2 prospect in the Yankees' system allowed one run on two hits with four strikeouts over 2.2 innings of work in his first start with Somerset on 8/5. Schmidt is one of six Major Leaguer to rehab with the Patriots this year (Zack Britton, Luke Voit, Wandy Peralta, Luis Severino, and Chris Gittens being the others).

On the Move: On Tuesday, RHP Ron Marinaccio and INF Max Burt were transferred to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Additionally, the Patriots added RHP Kevin Gadea and OF Thomas Milone from SWB and INF Oliver Dunn, INF Chad Bell and RHP Nick Ernst from High-A Hudson Valley. Milone returns to the team in the midst of a 28-game on-base streak, which is tied for the longest such streak on the team this year. Gadea and Dunn have both previously played with the team this year as well. Bell and Ernst will be making their respective debuts at the Double-A level.

Well Regarded: The Patriots have eight players on their active roster ranked in the Top 30 prospects in the Yankees' system: Clarke Schmidt (No. 2), Oswald Peraza (No. 4), Luis Medina (No. 8), Josh Breaux (No. 14), Brandon Lockridge (No. 15), Ken Waldichuk (No. 21), Oswaldo Cabrera (No. 23), and Hayden Wesneski (No. 24).

History in Bridgewater: On Sunday, RHPs Luis Severino, Shawn Semple, and Ron Marinaccio combined to throw the first no-hitter in Somerset Patriots history. The team, now in it's 23rd season of operation, had two no-hitters thrown against them, but never for them. Severino and Semple each tossed five perfect innings with five strikeouts a piece before Marinaccio came in and got the final three outs. The team had carried a perfect game through one out in the ninth.

Arms Race: Somerset's pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.25) and BAA (.206), most shutout wins (14), second-most strikeouts (931), and third-lowest WHIP (1.15) across all MiLB levels.

Where's OsWaldo: Infielder Oswaldo Cabrera improved his on-base streak to 28 games with an RBI single Sunday night. Over the streak, Cabrera has reached base at a .315 clip. It's the longest such streak for Cabrera this season and is now tied with Thomas Milone for the team's longest on-base streak of the season.

Going Streaking: Brandon Lockridge has reached base safely in 10-straight games. He leads the team with six three-hit games despite playing in only 23 games this year. He has nine multi-hit games and is batting .333 with a .406 OBP over seven games in August. Additionally, Jesus Bastidas is enjoying a 12-game on-base streak to begin his Double-A tenure and Isiah Gilliam is in the midst of an 11-game on-base streak. Oswald Peraza has reached base safely in eight-straight games, including five multi-hit contests and a .417 OBP dating back to July 31st.
