**Sunday:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies held off the Richmond Flying Squirrels 6-5 on Sunday afternoon at The Diamond, to split the six-game series. Binghamton got off to a quick start as Wyatt Young hit the first pitch of the game for a leadoff double. Rowdey Jordan drove him home with an RBI single to put the Ponies up 1-0. Later in the frame, Carlos Cortes added a sacrifice groundout to make it 2-0. The Ponies added a pair of runs in the fifth, as Nic Gaddis hit a solo home run to make it 3-0. It's Gaddis first home run of his Double-A career. Then with Matt Winaker on second and two out, Ronny Mauricio lined an RBI single to extend the lead to 4-0. Carlos Cortes's home run made it 6-2 in the eighth but Richmond did not go away quietly as they cut the lead to 6-4. Grant Hartwig gave up a run in the ninth but is now 12 for 12 in save opportunities across three levels this year.

**Two Ponies Alums Make MLB Debuts:** Ponies alum Nate Fisher made his MLB debut on Sunday in Philadelphia and excelled throwing three scoreless innings giving up a hit and two walks while striking out three. He is the 339th Binghamton player to reach the big leagues, 171st to do it with the Mets, 69th to do it in the same year after playing with Binghamton and the third to reach the majors in as many weeks. Jose Butto also made his MLB debut on Sunday while Connor Grey was brought up to the big league club from AAA Syracuse.

**Vargas Named MiLB Pitcher of the Week:** Ponies pitcher Jesus Vargas has not allowed a run in four appearances this month, issuing only one walk and striking out 14 over 13.2 innings pitched. Making the start this past Sunday at Richmond, Vargas allowed just one hit over four innings with one walk and five strikeouts in a 6-5 Rumble Ponies win. In the series opener at Richmond, Vargas pitched three innings of relief with no walks and five strikeouts in an 8-2 Binghamton victory. On August 3rd against Somerset, Vargas allowed just one hit over six innings of relief earning the win.

**Finding a Way:** Wyatt Young extended his on-base streak to 27-straight games after Sunday's game. During the month of August, Young's OBP is .459. The sure-handed second baseman also rode a 15-game hit streak from July 13th-August 7th batting .344 during that time with 22 hits, two homers and 12 RBI with an OPS of .955.

**Reid Brignac - Manager - 1st season with Binghamton - 3rd year in the Mets organization.** Brignac comes to Binghamton after serving as the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021. He appeared in parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

**Jerome Williams - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton -** Williams also held the same position on Brignac's staff with St. Lucie and is entering his fourth season in the Mets organization following a 20-year playing career. He pitched for 11 years in the major leagues with the Giants, Angels, Cubs, Cardinals, Rangers, Phillies, Nationals and Astros compiling a 52-66 record with a 4.59 ERA in 236 career games.

**Tommy Joseph - Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization.** Joseph joins Brignac and Williams in being promoted from the same position in St. Lucie to Double-A Binghamton. He is entering his second season with the Mets organization after retiring from his playing career following the 2020 season. He spent two seasons in the major leagues with the Phillies in 2016-17 hitting .247 with 43 home runs and 116 RBI in 249 major league games.

**Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 1st season with Binghamton -** arrives in the Southern Tier after serving as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2020. He is entering his fourth year in the Mets organization. The former infielder played 12 major league seasons with the Dodgers, Reds, Phillies, Yankees, and Blue Jays.
