#### The Final Stretch

Reading continues its final home series, and penultimate series, of 2023 with a visit from the Portland Sea Dogs. Reading leads the season-series 10-7 over Portland after taking two-of-three from the Sea Dogs in July and four-of-six in Portland at the end of June. Tonight the teams will resume last night's game in the bottom of the third and play to a nine-inning completion, then play a second seven-inning game 30 minutes after.

#### Looking Back

Reading won its second-straight game over Portland 3-2 Wednesday night behind six-dominant innings from Mick Abel. Abel allowed no ruins and just one hit, with seven strikeouts. Marcus Lee Sang hit a two-run home run and Ethan Wilson knocked in the go-ahead run with a double in the eighth. Dominic Pipkin earned the win after a scoreless eighth and Tristan Garnett his first save after a scoreless ninth inning. Reading was held to just three hits last night, which matched a season low. Reading was outhit last night, and they were previously 6-41 when being outhit this season.

#### Abel's Strong Run

Mick Abel stayed hot with six-shutout innings Wednesday night. Over his last three starts (dating back to Aug. 23) Abel is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA, with just five hits allowed and 15 strikeouts. He owns a WHIP of 0.72 and opponents are hitting just .091 against Abel. After last night, Abel qualifies for a variety of Eastern League leaderboard ranks: ERA (10th), Strikeouts (T9th), BAA (1st) and WHIP (4th).

#### He Dunn Gets On Base

Oliver Dunn matched a season-high Wednesday night with three walks. He now has 80 walks on the season, which puts him in sole possesion of first place in the Eastern League in walks. Dunn also has the following Eastern League ranks is various other categories: AVG (5th), HR (T5th), RBI (T1st), OBP (1st), SLG (1st), OPS (1st), Hits (T5th), 2B (2nd), 3B (T4th), XBH (1st), TB (2nd) and Runs (T6th).

#### Closer On Lock

Orion Kerkering picked up his fifth Double-A save Tuesday night, as he threw a 1-2-3 ninth inning with two strikeouts. Kerkering has now converted on his last five save oppurtunities and hasn't allowed a run in his last five outings and 12 of his last 13. Dating back to July 26 (13 apppearneces) Kerkering is 5/5 in saves, with a 1.38 ERA and 18 strikeouts.

#### Around the Organization

The Phillies open a weekend series with Marlins tonight at 7:05. Lehigh Valley beat Buffalo 10-2 as Rafael Marchan hit a grand slam. The IronPigs are now tied for first place with Durhan with 15 games to play. Jersey Shore defeated Hudson Valley 6-1 as Erick Brito had three hits. Jersey Shore is now tied with Brookyln for first place with three games to play, and hold the tiebreaker. Clearwater beat Palm Beach 11-5 last night as Raylin Heredia had three hits. The Threshers are 78-49 overall and begin postseason play next week after winning the first half.

#### Welcoming the Dogs

Portland enters tonight with a 28-31 record in the second half, which is third in the Northeast Division and five-games back of Binghamton. Overall, the SeaDogs are 68-60 after narrowly missing out on the first half title. Last week, Portland won two-of-six against Somerset and close the regular season against Hartford at home next week. Portland has the following Red Sox top prospects on its team: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (4), Nick Yorke (6), Wikelman Gonzalez (9), Blaze Jordan (12), Nathan Hickey (15), Angel Bastardo (16) and Chase Meidroth (20).

#### Dog on the Bump

Wikelman Gonzalez will start the second game tonight for Portland. Gonzalez started against Reading on July 16 and went six innings and allowed no runs on four hits, with nine strikeouts. Overall, Gonzalez is 3-1 with a 2.45 ERA across eight starts (40.1 IP, 20 H, 22 BB, 52 SO). Last Saturday he warned the win, pitching six-shutout innings against Somerset and allowed just one hit, with five strikeouts. He was called up from High-A Greenville on July 14 after going 6-3 with a 5.14 ERA to start this season. Boston signed him as an International Free Agent in 2018 out of VNZ.
