### SALT LAKE BEES (11-17) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (12-16)

### RHP DAKOTA HUDSON (1-0, 4.50) vs. RHP ANTHONY MOLINA (0-3, 12.10)

TODAY'S GAME: Albuquergue holds a 1-0 series lead after last night's 3-2 walk-off win over the Bees, ending the club's fourgame losing streak ... Anthony Molina is expected to take the hill for the Isotopes while Dakota Hudson is slated to start for Salt Lake.

NOW WALK IT OFF: Yesterday's walk-off win is the Isotopes' third of the season (last: April 20 vs. El Paso, Game 1, Trevor Boone sac fly) and second against the Bees (also: April 4, Braxton Fulford two-run homer, 5-4).

WALK-OFF VS. BEES: It's Albuquerque's 10th all-time walk-off victory against Salt Lake. Additionally, it's the second time the Isotopes have recorded two walk-off wins over the Bees in the same season (also: April 28 and May 1, 2014).

WALK-OFF HIT: The RBI walk-off double last night by Sam Hilliard was his first walk-off hit with the Isotopes in 300 career games with the club.

ONE-RUN GAMES: Albuquerque improved to 4-5 in one-run games on the year and 3-2 at home. The win also ended the club's two-game losing streak in one-run games.

ESCAPING THE JAM: The Isotopes pitching staff stranded 12 runners on-base last night, the third-most left on-base in 2025 (most: 14, twice: April 20, Game 1, vs. El Paso and April 8 at Sugar Land).

THREE OR FEWER: Last night was Albuquerque's second win on the year scoring three runs or fewer (also: March 30 at Sacramento, 2-1).

TOPES STARTER: Tanner Gordon spun 5.1 frames of one-run ball and allowed just five hits and two walks with three punchouts yesterday. It's the third time an Isotopes starter has tossed 5.0lus innings and relented one run or fewer (last: April 10 at Sugar Land, Carson Palmquist, 5.0 IP, 1 R).

OPPOSING HURLER: Salt Lake's starter Caden Dana tossed 6.0 innings and surrendered two runs on four hits and three walks with five punchouts last night. It's the third time in the last week an opposing starter completed 6.0 innings (also: Reno's Tommy Henry twice; April 22 and April 27).

BEHIND THE DISH: Albuquerque catchers (Braxton Fulford, Austin Nola and Ronaiker Palma) have combined to slash .376/.422/.624 with seven doubles, six homers and 14 RBI on the year, which leads the PCL in all of the above categories except RBI.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard walked and doubled last night to extend his on-base streak to 19 games, every game he's played in 2025. It's tied for the longest on-base streak in the PCL this season (also: El Paso's Yonathan Perlaza) and tied for the fourth-longest in Triple-A ... Dating back to 2024, has a 27-game on-base streak in Triple-A (June 11-19, 2024).

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Hilliard has 227 RBI with Albuquerque, which ranks third among career leaders in team history. Jordan Patterson (2016-18) is second with 229 RBI.

**WARMIN' UP:** Warming Bernabel singled yesterday to extend his hit streak to seven games, tied for the fourth-longest active hit streak in the PCL. During stretch, is slashing .414/.406/.586 with five doubles and 11 RBI. Over last 14 games, has .370/.403/.603 elab line with cited doubles the homest and 12 RBI. slash line with eight doubles, two homers and 17 RBI.

HOME RUN LEADERBOARD: Yanguiel Fernandez has seven homers on the year, tied for the fourth-most in all of MiLB.

BRAX: Braxton Fulford singled last night to extend his hitting streak to nine contests, the third-longest active hit streak in the PCL. During the streak he is slashing .455/.514/.970 with two doubles, five homers and 11 RBI.

JC: Julio Carreras also singled yesterday to extend his hitting streak to six games. Is slashing .478/.538/.609 with one double, one triple and three RBI during the stretch.

VEEN: Zac Veen swatted two singles yesterday for his sixth multi-hit game in 12 contests with the Isotopes and third in his last four games. Has a hit in the four games since being sent back down to Triple-A (7x19). ... Has a hit in 10 of 12 games with the Isotopes in 2025.

YF: Yanquiel Fernandez registered two singles last night for his seventh multi-hit game of 2025, ending a two-game hitless skid.

BOONIE: Trevor Boone delivered an RBI triple in the second inning Sunday, his fifth extra-base hit in the last four contests. Has 13 RBI across just 28 at-bats for Albuquerque in eight games.

**THE VET**: Austin Nola singled Saturday and has a hit in four-straight (9-for-17) with two doubles and one RBI during streak.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Warming Bernabel is T-7th in RBI (22), 9th in doubles (9) and T-10th in slugging (.560) ... Ryan Ritter is T-2nd in walks (22) ... Yanquiel Fernandez is T-1st in homers (7) ... Sam Hilliard is 1st in triples (3).

guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona-the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
