Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Yorman Gomez** to the mound today, making his Triple-A debut (101st career game, 83rd start). Iowa will counter with RHP **Jaxon Wiggins**. Columbus is 1-1 (.500) versus right handers this year. Wiggins has never pitched against Columbus in his career, having made his Triple-A debut in September of last season (3GS in the IL).

vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 12-13 opposing the I-Cubs (27-20 in the last 47 matchups). In Des Moines, the Clippers have lost four of six. Individually, **Nolan Jones** has hit .311 (28x90) with 8HR and 24RBI in 25G against Iowa in his career (.385, 4HR and 16RBI in 14G at Principal Park), while **Milan Tolentino** has hit .304 (14x46) with 4HR and 9RBI in 14G.

Windy City

The Clipper lineup opened the season with 17K (tied for most since 23K in 18-inning game at Louisville on 5/19/17) and, after 11 more yesterday, find themselves with the 3rd most in the IL (three behind Omaha for most). Columbus has also gone heavy in the walk department (14), placing 2nd in the IL (-4 on Rochester) and the 2HR yesterday produces a three true outcome rate of 52% (2nd).

Second Look

Columbus challenged five pitches last night, defeating the umps four times, to make nine successful challenges through the first 2G (.750). Last year, the Clippers had the worst challenge rate in the IL through most of the season, before going 28-23 (.549) over the last 23G to finish in 19th (.431). Columbus had at least four winners in 5G last season (145G total), but has done it twice through 2G this year.

RISP Averse

The Clippers were 1x10 with RISP yesterday and have gone 3x26 (.115, 16th in the IL) in the series (one hit was an infield single that did not plate any runs). They have left double digits in runners on the bases in each of the first 2G of the season, with the 25LOB total ranking as the most in the IL. Additionally, the Clippers have had three runners take themselves off the bases (3CS, most in the IL).

Top Bazzana

Travis Bazzana enters the season ranked as the #1 prospect in the Cleveland organization for the second year in a row. Last year he became only the second player drafted 1st overall to suit up for the Clippers (**Darryl Strawberry**, taken in 1980, played for the Clippers from 1995-97 and '99). Bazzana drew a walk in 24% of his PA with Columbus last year (29BB from debut to injury, 8/12-9/11, led the IL).

Brito Ball

Juan Brito's double yesterday gives him 50 in his Columbus career, tied for 9th most in the IL since his debut on 9/19/23 (all other nine players with at least 50 doubles have played over 200G in that time, Brito has 175G). Exactly 80% of Brito's doubles came in 2024, when he became the third Clipper ever to reach 40 in a season (still 11 doubles from cracking the career top 25, 45 from #1).

Big Dog

Nolan Jones has hit safely in 10 straight games with the Clippers, dating to 9/21/22, hitting .316 (12x38) with 4HR (.737SLG) and 8RBI over the stretch. Including his time in Albuquerque, he is slashing .326/.444/.663 with 19HR and 65RBI over his last 69G in Triple-A, having reached base in 63 of them (has 20 hitless games). He has also scored 63 times and gone perfect in steal attempts (5).

On the Upswing

After a slow start to his Triple-A career (.183/.299/.402 with 5HR and 11RBI in 25G), **Kahlil Watson** has hit safely in 18 of his last 20G, since 8/28/25 (.338, 25x74) while reaching base in each of his last 25G (.427OBP since 8/19/25). He has been active on the basepaths in that time, collecting 10SB (2CS) and scoring 18 runs. In his Triple-A career, he owns a .468SLG (combined .421 at lower levels).

That's a First

Milan Tolentino collected 3SB in the last 4G of 2025 (had 3SB in previous 44G) to establish the first 20-20 season in Clipper history (hit 20th HR, a grand slam, with 9G left). Tolentino was the only player in the IL to hit more than 20HR last season and not have a single one come off LHP (last: 7/3/24 with Akron; 4HR, .284SLG in 377AB vs. LHP in his career; 42HR, .415SLG in 1,385AB vs. RHP).

This Date in Clipper History

3/29/2025

In the first ever game played on March 29th (the 2024 contest was postponed due to snow in St. Paul), the Clippers used a 7-run 3rd inning to topple the Mud Hens 7-6 in Toledo. **Dom Nunez** kicked things off with a 3-run homer, **Kyle Datres** plated a pair with a single and **Angel Martinez** capped the scoring with a 2-run double.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top, with 2.96 being hit per game in Columbus (108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,404 to 1,346).

Challenging Times

The Clippers were 132-174 (.431, 2nd worst in the IL) in pitch reviews last season, with batters going 79-117 (.403) and pitchers/catchers going 53-57 (.482). They ran out of challenges in 57G and did not challenge in 13G.

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus was 5-5 in extra innings last season, following a 9-loss campaign in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-33 when playing past regulation (.602, best in the IL; no other team above .580), including 26-16 at home (.619, have won 17 of last 27). Of the 83G to require extra play, 66 have needed only one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Return of the Defense

The Clippers were 1st in the IL in defense (.985), a season after turning in their worst fielding percentage (.978) since 2009. They had only two series with more than 5E (8/26-8/31 at Louisville, 9/17-9/21 vs. Omaha), topping out at 3E in a game twice and playing flawlessly 86 times on the year (44-42, .512; 16G errorless streak from 6/20-7/8, longest in the IL over the last 20 years). Behind the plate, Clipper catchers did not have a passed ball from 9/22/24-5/28/25 (53G; 3,949 pitches with men on base between).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Christian Cairo moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 9/16/25 vs. Omaha and those men came around to score in the win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 83-21 (.798) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 14-6 (.700) mark last season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 387-407 (.487), 357-361 with Columbus (.497).
