**THE OFFENSE GETS IT DONE:** The Delmarva Shorebirds evened the series with the Down East Wood Ducks on Wednesday night with a 9-7 victory. After falling behind early on a solo home run by **Gleider Figuereo,** Delmarva took the lead in the bottom of the third on a two-run triple by **Carter Young** followed by an RBI double by **Isaac Bellony** gave the Shorebirds a 3-1 edge. Down East would tie the game in the fourth on a two-run single by Figuereo, but **Elio Prado** put the 'Birds right back on top with a solo home run. Delmarva would add to their lead with two runs in the sixth, followed by three more in the seventh on an RBI single by **Stiven Acevedo** and two-run single by **Anderson De Los Santos** to make it 9-3. **Cam Cauley** made the final stretch interesting with a grand slam in the eighth, by Yaqui Rivera successfully recorded the final four out to secure a 9-7 victory.

**TODAY'S OPPONENT: Wyatt Cheney** takes the ball for the Shorebirds on Thursday following his best outing of the season last time out on Friday in Fredericksburg. He'll face **Joseph Montalvo** for the Wood Ducks who's put together a strong season in Down East. He will be making his fifth start and ninth appearance on Thursday and has a 4-0 record, winning his last two starts. This will be the second time the Shorebirds face the former 20th round pick from 2021 as he started against Delmarva on May 10 and went four shutout innings, allowing just two hits with four walks and five strikeouts. He was originally committed to Eastern Florida state before signing.

**FEELIN' YOUNG: Carter Young** has become an incredibly consistent hitter for the Shorebirds as of late. Since May 16, Young is batting .348 which is good for the second best average in the league in that 17-game sample size, behind **Jacob Burke** of Kannapolis (.375). He has scored 16 runs in that time frame which is tied for the most in the Carolina League, and has an OPS of .916.

**MOVING UP THE LADDER: Samuel Basallo's** strong first season in affiliated baseball has elevated him to inside the Top 100 overall prospects for Baseball America as he comes in at No. 81 on the mid-season list. Basallo is now ranked the No. 7 prospect in a deep, Oriole's farm system and he is one of eight Baltimore prospects currently in the top 100.

**PRADO AT THE TOP: Elio Prado** has had a strong run going at the plate since moving into the leadoff spot in the order as he is slashing .293/.361/.493 over his last 18 games, striking out only 8 times in that time frame. Prado has scored 18 runs during that time, which is tied for most in the league with fellow teammate **Carter Young**.

**PRESS THE RESET BUTTON**: The Shorebirds will look to regain their early season form offensively after a tough month of May. In the second month of the season, Delmarva batted .215 with an average of 4 runs per game. The strikeout rate very much increased in May as the offense struck out 288 times for an average of 11 time per game (35.5% K-Rate) which was second-worst in the Carolina League.

**EXTRA BELLONY: Isaac Bellony** has made an instant impact for the Shorebirds since joining their roster on May 30. In nine games for the Shorebirds, Bellony is batting .314 (11/35) and has three doubles, three triples, and has driven in eight runs. He's collected two RBI in three of those games and is already the team-leader in three-baggers after picking up his third on Tuesday night versus Down East.

**SILENCE IS GOLDEN:** Quietly, the hottest pitcher on the Delmarva staff is **Alfred Vega** who earned a win in his second straight out by tossing 2.1 scoreless out of the bullpen. Vega has not allowed a run in his last four appearances and has a scoreless streak of 14.1 innings.

**THE WOODIES ARE IN TOWN:** The 'Birds play host to one of the hottest teams in the league, the Down East Wood Ducks. These two teams last played in Kinston from May 9-14 where they split their six game series, but Delmarva was held to a .184 team batting average in the series with 65 strikeouts (10.8/game)

**TODAY'S STARTER:** Wyatt Cheney gets the call on Thursday night as the right-hander looks to give the Shorebirds the series edge coming off the best outing of his young career on Friday in Fredericksburg.

**LAST OUTING (6/2 vs FBG):** Cheney appeared in the fourth inning in relief during his last outing on Friday and he picked up some big innings for Delmarva, tossing the best outing of his career by going five innings, allowing no runs on one hit. He'd earn the victory in a 7-3, come-from-behind victory against the Fred Nats.

vs. DOWN EAST: Cheney will be facing the Down East Wood Ducks for the second time this season, last appearing against the Texas Rangers' affiliate in Kinston on May 10 where he dealt four innings of relief, striking out a then career-best six batters. The Wood Ducks broke a scoreless tie against him in the eighth inning with two outs on a two-run double by Miguel Villarroel, which was the difference in a 2-0 defeat for Cheney and the Shorebirds.

**2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:** The right-hander appeared in just two games for the Shorebirds after being drafted out of McClennan Community College in Texas. His first outing was a full inning against the Pirates in the FCL where he dealt a full inning with two strikeouts as he retired the side in order. He faced just two batters in his only Delmarva appearance where he faced two batters, allowing a hit and a walk. Appeared in 16 games at McClennan in 2022, making 15 starts where he struck out 122 in 81.2 innings to earn a 10-3 record and an ERA of 3.20. Struck out 11 batters or more in three starts including a career-high 13 versus Hill College on March 19.
