### History vs. Beloit

The Nuts are 78-72 all-time vs. the Sky Carp, 36-39 in Lansing and 42-33 in Wisconsin. The Lugnuts did not play Beloit in either 2021 or 2023, going 2-10 vs. the Sky Carp in 2022.

In 2003, the Lugnuts met up with Beloit in the Midwest League Championship Series, sweeping the series in three games. It's the Nuts' most recent of their two titles.

**Tonight:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the opener in a six-game series with the Beloit Sky Carp, High-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins. These are the only meetings between the two teams this season. Lansing is coming off losing four of six games at home against Cedar Rapids, while Beloit is coming off winning three of five games at Quad Cities. The first three games of this series will conclude the first half of the 2024 Midwest League season.

**Last Game, Sunday: Kernels 9, Lugnuts 8.** Henry Bolte homered off the video board and Luke Mann and Euriel Ángeles added home runs of their own, but the Cedar Rapids Kernels hung on to clinch the series victory in front of 5,812 on Father's Day, completing a three-game span in which Jackson Field drew 20,877 fans.

**On the Air:** Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jakska on the call.

**On Deck:** The Nuts play the Sky Carp through Sunday before returning home for a nine straight days at Jackson Field vs. West Michigan and Fort Wayne.

### LUG•NOTES

**Half and Half:** In an ideal world, the Lugnuts would spend the first half and the second half playing a balanced number of home games and road games as well as a balanced number of games against the West Division and East Division. But in the world we live in, the Lugnuts play 36 home games and 30 road games in the first half | 30 home games, 36 road games in the second half; and 21 games against the West in the first half (9-9 thus far) | 9 games against the West in the second half.

**Team Effort:** The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.262), runs scored (345), base hits (553), total bases (864), doubles (114), triples (28), RBIs (317), slugging percentage (.409) and OPS (.762), and is tied for 1st in on-base percentage (.353). The Lugnuts' base hits, total bases and triples also all rank 1st in all of the High-A level.

**No June Swoon:** The Lugnuts are batting .286 in June, 32 points higher than the next best team and 72 points higher than Beloit. Lansing is averaging 5.9 runs/game on 9.6 hits/game, posting a team OPS of .818.

**Prospecting:** Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10), first baseman Will Simpson (No. 24), southpaw Will Johnston (No. 27) and outfielder Brayán Buelvas (No. 29).

**Big League Nuts:** The Lugnuts have had three former players reach the Majors this season in southpaw Brady Basso and position players Max Schuemann and Brett Harris, giving the Nuts 187 Major League alumni all-time.

**History:** Jake Garland (5 innings), Grant Judkins (2 2/3 innings) and Colton Johnson (1 1/3 innings) tossed the 4th no-hitter in franchise history on Thursday, June 13, blanking Cedar Rapids, 8-0, the first no-hitter in Lansing since April 21, 2003, a 15-0 rout of Dayton in which Donnie Hood hit for the cycle, the first time ever a team had thrown a no-hitter and hit for the cycle.

**Nothing but Goose Eggs:** 2022-23 Lugnuts pitcher Grant Holman has pitched 25 1/3 scoreless innings between Double-A and Triple-A this season, 19 1/3 with Midland and 6 innings with Las Vegas, the most scoreless innings for any MiLB pitcher.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2002:** The Lugnuts hosted their third Midwest League All-Star Game, setting a new league record with a crowd of 10,334. The East defeated the West, 6-3. The game includes future Major League stars Joe Mauer and Edwin Encarnacion.

**2013:** CF Dalton Pompey's two-out RBI single in the bottom of the ninth lifted the Eastern Division All-Stars to a 6-5 walk-off win over the West in the MWL All-Star Game in Dayton. If Pompey had not come through, the game would have ended in a tie. The West had scored three runs in the top of the ninth to tie the game at 5-5.

**2017:** Happy Father's Day! Vladimir Guerrero, Sr., made a surprise appearance to throw out the first pitch to Vladdy Jr – and then West Michigan won, 10-1, to finish off the first half. Bo Bichette went 0-for-2 before leaving the game, giving him a .396 average in the first half. Guerrero was 0-for-4 with a strikeout, dropping his average to .321.

**In a Nutshell:** Excelled in his Lugnuts debut on May 2 vs. South Bend, becoming the club's 11th different starting pitcher this year and the 939th all-time player to put on the Lansing uniform... replaced the demoted Eduardo Rivera and tossed five scoreless two-hit innings, striking out six Cubs... followed up with eight strikeouts in three hitless innings with his mother in attendance at Great Lakes, May 8... grew up idolizing Max Scherzer... enjoys the great outdoors... notable splits:

- Home: 3.71 ERA, 17 IP, 1.29 WHIP, .258 avg. | Road: 4.50 ERA, 12 IP, 1.17 WHIP, .233 avg.

**Prospecting:** Rated the A's No. 27 prospect and No. 12 pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline... grades: fastball 50, slider 45, change-up 55, control 50, overall 40... they write, "With low expectations, Johnston began his first full season of pro ball at age 23 with Single-A Stockton, but he threw so well out of the gate he earned a quick promotion up to High-A Lansing at the end of April... Johnston has shown a better feel for his three-pitch arsenal than some expected given his college numbers. He adds and subtracts from his fastball, throwing it typically in the 89-94 mph range, though he's shown in the past the ability to reach back for a 95 or 96-mph heater on occasion. The pitch has played up a bit because he can pitch north and south with it. His best pitch is now his split-changeup, which flashes plus and can be a true out pitch at times. His low-80s breaking ball can be on the slurve side, but it can be effective."

**Stockton Sensation:** Opened 2024 with the Class A Ports... made two relief appearances and two starts, facing 46 batters and whiffing 26 of them ... debuted with 4 2/3 hitless innings with eight strikeouts on April 6... followed up with three perfect innings with 7 K on 4/12.

**Gig 'Em:** Majored in finance at Texas A&M... pitched primarily out of Aggies' bullpen; career stats: 6-4, 5.77 ERA, 66 G, 8 GS, 8 SV, 98 1/3 IP, 57 BB, 132 K... finest year at College Station was in 2022: 3.25 ERA, 23 G, 2 GS, 4 SV, 36 IP, 2 HR, 18 BB, 49 K... struggled in 2023 to 5.89 ERA due to 9 HR and 31 BB in 47 1/3 IP, though he struck out 70 batters... drafted following his fourth season at A&M... joined fellow Aggies Micah Dallas (8th round, 2022) and Nathan Dettmer (5th round, 2023) as Aggies drafted by the A's, and one of seven Aggies drafted overall in 2023... signed for \$150,000... notable Aggies in the pros include Chuck Knoblauch, Davey Johnson, Wally Moon, Michael Wacha, Ross Stripling and A.J. Minter.

**Back Home:** Batted .413 with seven homers during senior year at Keller High School; ascended from closer as a sophomore (posting 11-0 record with 11 saves) to ace as senior; compiled three-year record of 21-2... Keller High School also produced Shea Langeliers and Max Muncy 1.0.
