Joey Oakie is coming off a Carolina League Pitcher of the Week nod after going 5 no hit innings and striking out 11. He could be in line to win the award in consecutive weeks after again striking out 11 through 4.2 shutout frames on Thursday.

The playoff picture has been fully set, in the South Myrtle Beach and Columbia will square off. In the North the Hillcats will stand toe to toe with Fredericksburg. This season Lynchburg has handled the Nationals quite easily with a 13-8 record.



HILLCATS MANAGER JORDAN SMITH



Jordan Smith will enter his third year as the head skipper of the 'Cats. In 2024, he led the team to a 67-62 record, finishing second in the first half and fourth overall in the Carolina League North Division. In 2023, he finished 67-64, third in the division.

A native of Wilmar, Minnesota, Smith's coaching experience began following the conclusion of his playing career, of which he spent its entirety in the Cleveland Guardians organization. He began his coaching career in 2019 as the bench coach of the Lake County Captains, where he returned to the same role in 2021. His first managerial position was with the 'Cats and he has stuck around in the Hill City ever since.
