### ROUGHRIDERS ROLL TO HOME OPENER WIN OVER MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders topped the Midland RockHounds 9-1 in the home opener at Riders Field Tuesday night to become the only remaining undefeated team in the Texas League South. After a quick first two innings, Frisco found the game's first run and turned it into a rally in the third. Midland's starter, Kenya Huggins, walked four straight batters with one out, including **John Taylor**, who picked up an RBI for a 1-0 Riders lead. After **Orlando Martinez** singled in **Dylan Dreiling**, **Marcus Lee Sang** and **Tucker Mitchell** both tallied two-run singles to balloon the lead to 6-0. From there, Frisco starter **Josh Trentadue** ran through four strong innings with four strikeouts before giving way to **Wiliam Bormie** and the RoughRiders bullpen. Frisco added runs on sacrifice flies from Taylor and **Franyer Chavez**, but the big swing came from **Ian Moller**. With one out in the fifth inning, Moller demolished a 3-2 pitch over the home run terrace down the left field line – his first home run of the season and the first for Frisco at Riders Field in 2026. The Riders' relievers combined to face the minimum over the final five innings of the game to seal the deal. Bormie (1-0) got the win, handing Huggins (0-1) the loss.

### YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through three games the RoughRiders are tied for first in Double-A with 44 hits and third in all of Double-A, High-A and Low-A. Among teams with at least four games played, they are third in Double-A in batting average (.297) and 11th in runs (25). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Their 44 hits are the second-most in the first four games in recorded franchise history (since 2005), trailing just 2017's 45 hits. Their 25 runs scored are also the fourth-most in franchise history (since 2005) through the first four games of a season. **Tucker Mitchell** and **Keyber Rodriguez** have both tied the franchise record for most hits through the first four games of a season with eight, a mark which is also tied for the Double-A lead. The franchise record for most hits through five games is 10 (**Josh Hatcher** in 2025 and **Liam Hicks** in 2024).

### QUITE THE START:

Frisco starter **Leandro Lopez** poured in 4.2 no-hit innings on Thursday night, **Dylan MacLean** followed with 5.0 innings, allowing one run in his Double-A debut on Friday, **David Davailillo** tossed 5.1 innings of shutout baseball on Saturday and **Josh Trentadue** continued the trend with 4.0 innings of one-run ball. Frisco's overall 0.75 ERA through four games is the best in Minor League Baseball, while they are third in hits allowed (18) and first in WHIP (0.86) in the minors. They are also the only team in the minors to not allow an extra-base hit through four games. Since 2005, their 0.75 ERA is the best in the Texas League through four games, the fourth-best in Double-A and it is the best in franchise history. Among starting pitching staffs with at least 15.0 innings through four games, they lead all of MiLB with a 0.95 ERA (19.0 IP/2 ER) and their bullpen ERA of 0.54 (17.0 IP/0 ER) is the best in MiLB (min. 10 IP).

### READY AT THE STARTING LINE:

The Riders swept Corpus Christi over the opening weekend and won on Tuesday to start 4-0 for the first time since 2016 and the third time in franchise history (2026, 2016 and 2008). The longest winning streak to start a season in franchise history is five games, in both 2016 and 2008. The sweep was Frisco's first brooming since they swept a six-game series against Amarillo from June 11th-16th, 2024.

### MONSTER INNING:

On Friday at Corpus, the Riders scored 10 runs in the fifth inning, tying the second-biggest output in a single inning in franchise history. It was the second time the Riders had scored 10 in an inning at Corpus Christi (May 8th, 2008) and came up one run shy of the franchise record of 11 at Amarillo on September 2nd, 2022. In the inning, **Dylan Dreiling** became the third player in franchise history to knock in four runs in a frame without a grand slam, belting a three-run home run and an RBI single. He joined **Trevor Hauver** (solo HR, three-run triple) in 2023 and **Casey Benjamin** (two-run double, two-run single) in 2007. When you add the six-run inning on Tuesday, 16 of the Riders' 25 runs (64 percent) have been scored in two half innings.

### SOUTHERN SUCCESS:

Since 2021, the Riders have been very good against their South Division opponents, going 254-185 (.578) against their division teams. The only problem is that they have gone just 56-53 against Midland while they went a combined 197-132 (.599) against Corpus Christi, Amarillo and San Antonio.

### CLASS OF THE LEAGUE:

Since 2021, the RoughRiders have been the best team in the Texas League. Over the last six seasons, Frisco has a 363-308 (.541) record. Their .541 winning percentage is the top mark in the Texas League and the fifth-best in Double-A during that span. Somerset (Yankees affiliate) has the best record in Double-A, going 388-281 (.580) in that stretch. On the opposite end, Corpus Christi has had the worst winning percentage in the Texas League over the last six years, going 287-383 (.428), the third-worst in Double-A.

### FAMILIAR AND NEW FACES IN FRISCO:

The RoughRiders welcome 16 returning players in 2026, but will have just three players on the roster (infielder **John Taylor**, outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** and RHP **Dylan MacLean**) made their Double-A debut in the season-opening series. Of the 28, 10 players made their Rangers organization debut with the RoughRiders in Corpus Christi.

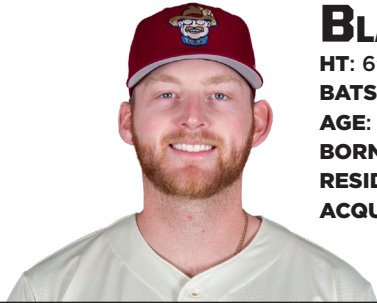

### ABOUT BLAKE

-Australian native pitched for Team Australia in both the 2023 and 2026 World Baseball Classics. In 2023, he threw 1.0 scoreless inning before tossing two scoreless outings (2.1 innings) in 2026, including inducing a lineup to right field from Shohei Ohtani.

-Before the WBC, he was a member of the Australian National Team at the U-15 baseball World Cup in Iwaki, Japan in 2016.

-Pitched for the U-18 Australian Team against extended Spring Training Major League teams in 2018, leading to his signing by the Mariners on June 19th, 2018.

-After seven years with the Mariners, he was released in August of 2024 and signed by the Pirates, where he pitched for 2025 as well after resigning in the offseason.

-He elected free agency following 2025 and signed with the Rangers on January 23rd, 2026.

### 2026 SEASON

-Enters the season in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

### 2025 SEASON

-Among MiLB pitchers who threw at least 90.0 innings, he was 4th in the minors with a 1.76 ERA.

-Had just a 0.97 ERA through his first 25 games (six starts), allowing earned runs in just six of those outings.

-In his last 9G/6GS, went 1-2 with a 3.62 ERA.

### 2024 SEASON

-Pitched between Seattle and Pittsburgh organizations.

-2.35 ERA on the season over 38.1 IP was 84th in all of MiLB among relievers (0 starts) with at least 30.0 IP.

-All 35 games were in relief in 2023 for Low-A Modesto, finishing fifth on the team in appearances.

## CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

### PITCHING COACH



## THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

### HITTING COACH



## JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

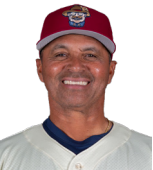
Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

### BENCH COACH



## JORGE HERNANDEZ

Pronounced "George"

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

## JAY SULLENGER

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

## KILEY BROWN

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).

## BRETT PLATTS

Platts is back with the RoughRiders for his third season and his fourth in the Rangers organization in 2026.

In his first year, he was the strength and conditioning coach for the Low-A Down East Wood Ducks before spending a season with the Cubs, working in the Dominican Summer League. The Canadian completed his strength and conditioning internship with the University of Iowa athletic department in 2022 and spent four years with the Okotoks Dawgs Baseball Academy from 2019 through 2022.
