**THIS IS IT:** After sweeping Carolina in the North Divisional series, the FredNats won game one of the Championship Series and return home to Virginia Credit Union Stadium tonight to try and wrap up the title at home against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers in game two of the title series. After yesterday's rainout, the two teams will play a doubleheader today if necessary. If FXBG wins game one, they win the title and the second game won't be played. LHP Alex Clemmey starts game two tonight and makes his second start of the playoffs after also starting the playoff opener one week ago. Clemmey cruised through the first three innings, but ran across some trouble in the 4th, ultimately allowing six runs, five of them with two outs. Travis Stehle will likely back Clemmey up out of the bullpen tonight as he did in the playoff opener. The FredNats face Kannapolis righty Tanner McDougal, who did not face Fredericksburg in the regular season. He was scheduled to start the Sunday series finale when the Freddie's were in Kannapolis earlier this month, but that game got rained out.

**GAME ONE RECAP:** The FredNats scored first for the third straight playoff game and led wire-to-wire in a 6-4 game one victory in front of a raucous crowd at Atrium Health Ballpark. Caleb Lomavita opened the scoring with an RBI double in the 2nd inning, and he was brought home on Nate Ochoa's RBI single. Kevin Bazzell's sacrifice fly in the 3rd inning made it 3-0, but the Ballers bounced back with two runs in the third, and Cristhian Vaquero's outfield assist kept the lead for the FredNats. Seaver King's two-run single with two outs in the 5th widened the lead to 5-2, but the Ballers bounced back with two runs of their own in the 6th to get closer, 5-4. A wild pitch in the 7th scored the sixth run, and then Robert Cranz and Anthony Arguelles closed it out for a 6-4 FredNat victory.

**SEASON SERIES RECAP:** Fredericksburg and Kannapolis played two series in the regular season, and the Ballers won both. Kannapolis' first half champion team beat up on FXBG at VACU Stadium in June, winning five out of six games. The FredNats returned to Kannapolis in the last road week of the regular season and won two out of the five games that were played. The Sunday game was rained out. A lot of run scoring was the theme of the season series, with Kannapolis outscoring FXBG 68-57, and both teams had team ERAs over 4.75.

**HE'S SOMETHING ELSE:** Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. In August alone, Sykora made six starts, going 4-0 with an 0.88 ERA. In 30.2 innings pitched, he struck out 49 hitters (11 more than the second-best pitcher) and walked just three the entire month. He was named Washington's FredNat Pitcher of the Month for August (duh), and today was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for August by MiLB. Not only did he dominate in August, but among MiLB pitchers with at least 80 innings pitched this year at any level, Sykora leads all of MiLB in strikeout percentage (39.9%), WHIP (0.83) and is second in strikeout-to-walk percentage (32.3%), and FIP (1.78).

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 216-177 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, is in his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh is also in his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**A LASTING LEGACY:** The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Alex Clemmey makes his eighth start as a FredNat tonight, and second of the playoffs, in game two of the Championship series against Kannapolis. It's the lefty's 27th start overall, having made his first 19 starts with Lynchburg.

Alex was acquired as a key piece in the Nationals' return for Lane Thomas from Cleveland. Coincidentally, the trade was made right before the FredNats and Hillcats were scheduled to start a series, so Clemmey simply had to switch dugouts.

**WELCOME TO PRO BALL:** Clemmey faced a rude introduction to the Carolina league, as the southpaw struggled mightily in his first month playing professionally. Alex sported a 12.60 ERA over five starts (15.0 IP), as opponents hit .306 against him. But from May through June, Clemmey posted a 2.48 ERA in 54.1 innings.

**AS A FREDNAT:** Clemmey has been solid for FXBG since the trade, working to a 4.30 ERA in 23.0 regular season innings. The big lefty has struck out 26 men and walked 16 in his six starts.

**AGAINST KANNAPOLIS:** Clemmey has seen the Ballers three times this year, once with the FredNats. All together, he's posted a 8.18 ERA over 11.0 innings against Kannapolis. Most recently, he gave up four earned over 4.2 innings with seven strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Alex started strong with three scoreless against the Mudcats, but wound up allowing six earned runs in a no-decision.
