HOMERS SEND RIDERS TO WIN IN SERIES FINALE OVER MISSIONS:

The Frisco RoughRiders used late home runs to drop by the San Antonio Missions 4-2 on Sunday night from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. Frisco (21-12, 65-37) starter **Emiliano Teodo** returned the hill for the first time in two weeks and was his dominant self, allowing just a solo home run from Missions (14-18, 45-55) first baseman **Robbie Tenerowicz** over 3.1 innings with six strikeouts and just one walk. Trailing 1-0 in the top of the sixth, **Alejandro Osuna** led off the frame with a double before **Keyber Rodriguez** blasted a two-run, go-ahead home run off of the foul pole to give Frisco a 2-1 lead. After the Missions tied the game with a bases-loaded walk in the bottom of the eighth, **Jackson Kelley** (1-0) struck out **Connor Hollis** to get out of the jam. In the top of the ninth, both **Josh Hatcher** and **Luis Mieses** then hammered solo home runs against **Carter Loewen** (1-2) to give the Riders a 4-2 lead. In relief, **Andy Rodriguez** threw three scoreless innings and **Cody Freeman** collected two hits for Frisco.

START ME UP:

RoughRiders starting pitchers have been dominant over their last six games, owning a 0.92 ERA (3ER/29.1IP). Overall, Frisco has allowed just 11 earned runs in their last six games for a 1.83 ERA (54.0IP).

CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL:

The RoughRiders have hit 14 home runs over their last 12 games, tied for the second most in the Texas League over the last two weeks. During that span, the Riders lead the Texas League with a .777 OPS and are fourth with 4.5 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .167 (18-for-108) with runners in scoring position.

READY TO ROCK(ER):

RoughRiders starting pitcher **Kumar Rocker** has been fantastic in his two starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the two starts, he has pitched seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and one walk with eight strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 11.4 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-15 at Riders Field this season. Their 35 wins and .700 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +74 run differential, a 3.73 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .761 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 30-22 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +27 run differential while averaging 4.1 runs per game and owning a .643 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** is slashing .339/.398/.594/.992 at home this season with nine of his 13 home runs. His .339 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 26 games, he is hitting .300 (30-for-100)/.398/.530/.928 with 10 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 17 RBIs. Over his last 23 games, he is batting .310 (27-for-87)/.419/.552/.971 with eight doubles, two triples, three home runs and 17 RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen is the second-best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.06 ERA, which is also the third-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.48), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .227 BAA is on pace to be the best in the franchise's history (.228 in 2021).

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.
