CLIPPERS BLANK JUMBO SHRIMP, 8-0

The Columbus Clippers shut out the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp 8-0 on Saturday from VyStar Ballpark. The Clippers jumped out to an early lead when Milan Tolentino hit a two-run home run and Jhonkensy Noel cashed in an RBI single in the second. Tolentino smacked another two-run shot in the third. Columbus added three more runs in the sixth inning on an RBI double from George Valera and a two-run two-bagger from Yordys Valdes. Zach McCambley tossed 3.0 scoreless innings of relief, scattering a pair of hits in the defeat.

JORDAN YEAR

With one more game to go in this series against the Clippers, the Jumbo Shrimp have already claimed a series win, snapping a drought of five consecutive winless sets - the club's longest since going eight sets in a row from May 9-July 3 of the 2023 campaign. Prior to Saturday's defeat, Jacksonville's 64-41 record had pushed the club 23 games over .500 for the first time since their 82-58 mark that closed out the 2009 season. The Jumbo Shrimp have outhit the Clippers by a 41-33 margin, drawn 25 walks compared to only seven for Columbus and outscored them 26-16.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Over the first 63 games of the season, Jacksonville cracked only 52 home runs, tied for the 26th-most in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp have blasted 68 round-trippers over the last 43 games since June 10, the most in Triple-A during this span. Jacksonville has plated at least four runs in 30 of these 43 games, a rate of 69.8 percent. In comparison, the Jumbo Shrimp had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent).

THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 106 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already used 27 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 415.0 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the fourth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.75 starters' ERA ranks third at the level.

IT GFTS LATE FARLY

Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 507.1, or 55.0 percent, of the club's 922.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks the fourth-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best BAA (.213) and second-best ERA (3.69). Over the last 11 games, the club's bullpen has worked 52.1 innings, yielding on1ly 17 runs, 16 earned, on 31 hits (5.3 H/9) for a 2.75 ERA (63 K, 10.8 K/9, 16 BB, 2.8 BB/9).

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 214 this season not only lead the entire level, but they are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

SLUG OF WAR

Jacksonville notched only four hits - all singles - on Saturday in an 8-0 loss to Columbus. Nonetheless, over their last six contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have collected a whopping 24 extra-base hits. The club's 38 runs (6.3 per game) over this span rank as tied for the fifth-most in Triple-A, with their 55 hits (9.2 per game) placing in a tie for seventh.

PARTY LIKE IT'S 1968

Tuesday's series opener between the Jumbo Shrimp and Clippers was the first visit for Columbus to Jacksonville since September 18, 1968, the final game of the 1968 Governors' Cup Finals. The Jacksonville Suns/Mets swept the Columbus Jets by scores of 6-1, 6-4, 2-1 (11 innings) and 3-1, with the final two games played at Wolfson Park. That 1968 title marks the city's lone Triple-A championship.

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 33 games this year. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 58 games, Berry has nearly drawn more walks (27) than strikeouts (29) while going 55-for-181 (.304/.397/.492/.889) at the plate with 14 doubles, one triple, six home runs, 31 RBIs and 29 runs scored.

ABOUT ADAM

-Laskey was originally selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 31st round in the 2016 MLB Draft. He ultimately didn't sign with the Giants and committed to play baseball at Duke. He had scholarship offers from Notre Dame, Wake Forest and Duke. He also drew heavy recruiting interest from Virginia Tech, Boston College, the University of Miami, Stanford, St. Johns and Michigan.

-Didn't garner attention until his summer in the Cape Cod League. Pitched for Falmouth, posted a 1.18 ERA in 30.1 innings and won Whitehouse Outstanding Pitcher Award.

-Pitched three seasons at Duke, had ERAs over five during his first two seasons. His last year, he made only six appearances but was selected in the 19th round by the Chicago Cubs.

-After reaching as high as Double-A Tennessee, Laskey was selected by the Marlins in the minor league phase of the 2023 Rule 5 draft.

2025 SEASON

-Tossed immaculate inning on April 11, 2025 for the Blue Wahoos.

-Made 11 appearances, 10 starts with Double-A Pensacola. Totaled 50 strikeouts in 52.2 innings. Allowed 26 R, 22 ER for a 3.76 ERA, while posting a 2-5 record.

-Posted a 12.0 scoreless innings streak back in April.

2024 SEASON

-Spent his first full season in the Marlins organization. Went 6-2 in 31 appearances, six starts.

-Totaled 81.1 innings, allowing 28 R, 28 ER for a 3.10 ERA. Laskey held opponents to a .217 batting average against (63 hits allowed) and striking out 76 against 20 walks.

2023 SEASON

-Laskey started the season with High-A South Bend. In 33 appearances out of the bullpen, he allowed $22\,\mathrm{runs}$, $17\,\mathrm{earned}$ runs for a $3.14\,\mathrm{ERA}$. He posted a 4-1 record and held opponents to a $.242\,\mathrm{batting}$ average against.
