**Today:** It's Page Fence Giants Night, with the Lugnuts wearing the uniforms of the dominant Black pro baseball team of 1895-1898, in the fourth game of a six-game series against the Fort Wayne TinCaps, High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. The Nuts have won two of the first three games in a stretch of 12 home games in 13 days. Today will also see a tribute to the life and legacy of Jackie Robinson, since the Lugnuts were on the road on April 15, Jackie Robinson Day across baseball.

**Last Night: Lugnuts 7, TinCaps 3.** The Nuts scored in each of the first four innings, **T.J. Schofield-Sam** went 5-for-5 with a double and two triples (tying the single game franchise record for most triples), and **Kyle Robinson** tossed six innings of one-run ball for his first pro quality start, leading the Nuts to a second straight victory.

**On Deck:** Tomorrow is White Claws & Paws, with \$5 White Claws and dogs welcome to the ballpark! Sunday closes out this series with Fort Wayne with a Capital City Market Kids Day featuring Kids Run the Bases. Both games over the weekend will begin at 1:05 p.m.

### LUG•NOTES

**The Hits Keep Coming:** Base hits for the Lugnuts this week against Fort Wayne: 17 on Tuesday, 11 on Wednesday, 13 last night, totaling 41 in three games.

**Home Cooking:** The Lugnuts boast the best home offense in Minor League Baseball, leading the 119 other MiLB teams in home batting average (.323) and OBP (.434), while walking (57) more than they strike out (55).

**All Things Considered:** The Nuts' overall team batting average of .282 is 28 points higher than the Midwest League's second highest team, Cedar Rapids. Lansing also leads the league in base hits (170), total bases (247), fewest strikeouts (116), on-base percentage (.392) and OPS (.802). Only West Michigan (111-97) has scored more runs than the Nuts.

**Streiking:** **Nate Nankil** (1-for-5 yesterday) has reached base in 15 straight games; **Clark Elliott** (idle) has reached base in 13 straight; **Cole Conn** (idle) has hit safely in nine consecutive games; and **Tommy White** (2-for-5) has hit safely in nine straight games and has reached base in his last 11 games.

**Heating Up:** Speaking of **Tommy White**, the third baseman opened the season 0-for-11 at Fort Wayne and 4-for-24 vs. Great Lakes. Since then, the former LSU Tiger is batting .441 (17-for-39) with five doubles and a home run, raising his average to .284 and his OPS to .803 for the season.

**The Conn Man:** UIC Flames product **Cole Conn** has been hot all season, collecting an RBI single and a walk yesterday in five trips to place his batting average at .455, his OBP at .581 and slugging percentage at .697. Conn has reached base 25 times and scored 12 runs in nine games, thanks to 15 base hits, seven walks and three HBPs.

**The Big Club:** 2023 Lugnuts shortstop **Jacob Wilson** is in the early mix for American League Rookie of the Year, and last night won't hurt his cause. Wilson delivered a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the ninth to cap a two-run rally, lifting the A's past the Rangers 4-3.

**Soder Pop:** 2022 Lugnuts catcher **Tyler Soderstrom**, now playing 1B and LF for the A's, is tied for the Major League lead with nine home runs, ranks 5th in total bases (59), 7th in slugging percentage (.615) and tied for 8th in RBIs (21).

**Quality Performances:** Yesterday's 6-IP, 1-R performance from **Kyle Robinson** marked the Lugnuts' third quality start in a nine-game stretch, beginning with 6 2/3 IP, 2 R from **Jake Garland** on April 15 at Wisconsin and continuing with a 6-IP, 2-R CG from **Grant Judkins** on April 20. Only one other complete game has been tossed in the Minors this year, achieved by Durham's Logan Workman (also six innings).

**Prospecting:** The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 19. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 29.

### History vs. Fort Wayne

The Lugs are 222-237 vs. the TinCaps, 118-101 in Lansing, 104-136 at The Fort. Last year: 8-10, 4-5 at Fort Wayne.

2019 was the last time the Nuts opened in FW, splitting a four-game home-and-home series. Before that: 2009 to open Parkview Field, a three-game TinCaps sweep.

### APRIL 24TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** Kevin Smith laced three doubles and the Lugnuts scored at least two runs in five of the first six innings to romp past the Dayton Dragons, 13-2, on a Winning Wednesday at Cooley Law School Stadium. On the down side, center fielder Reggie Pruitt was sent to the Disabled List after being hit in the nose by a Dauri Moreta pitch.

**2019:** The Lugnuts did not fare well in their first meeting with Wander Franco, who lined out (on a diving catch by third baseman Johnny Aiello) before singling off the top of the left field wall and homering twice over the left field wall, both oppo shots, in a Bowling Green 6-5 victory. The Lugnuts had the potential tying run at third base in Reggie Pruitt with two outs in the ninth, only to see Jordan Groshans ground out to pitcher Chris Muller to end the game.

**Gage Jump** joined **Trystan Magnuson** as the only Lugnuts in franchise history to make their pro debut as the Opening Day starter. The 6-foot-7 Canadian southpaw was drafted 56th overall in 2007 from Louisville. Pitching in Fort Wayne on Opening Day, April 3, 2008, Magnuson allowed a two-run homer in the first inning to Angel Mercado, allowed three runs total in 1 2/3 innings and took the L in a 7-1 Nuts loss to the Wizards. He finished the season 0-9 with a 5.40 ERA in 81 2/3 innings, was traded by Toronto to Oakland with Danny Farquhar for Rajai Davis on November 17, 2010, and made nine appearances for the A's in the Major Leagues in 2011. According to his wikipedia page, Magnuson "now works as a mechanical engineer in the automotive industry."

**Background:** Jump starred at JSerra Catholic H.S., which also produced Royce Lewis and former TinCaps catcher Austin Hedges... he was rated California's No. 1 LHP and No. 5 prospect, the nation's No. 5 LHP, and No. 41 draft prospect... drafted in the 18th round by San Diego, but declined Padres' offer... began his college track at UCLA, making seven appearances as a freshman 2022 before he was shut down due to injury; missed all of 2023 after undergoing Tommy John surgery... transferred to LSU, saying "I just wanted to be in the SEC"... his older brother Hunter, an outfielder, had played SEC ball in 2022 for Kentucky after transferring from Arizona State... spent one season with Bayou Bengals: 6-2, 3.47, 17 G/15 GS, 83 IP, 22 BB, 101 K, .218 avg. ... No. 8 in SEC in ERA and opp. avg. ... named to SEC All-Tournament Team after shutting down Georgia on four hits and one run in seven innings, whiffing seven... 7-IP CG at Missouri, April 19: 3 H, 1 R, 14 K.
