**SPRINGDALE, AR** - The Northwest Arkansas Naturals fell behind by four runs in the second inning and could not come back, dropping Wednesday's game to the Frisco RoughRiders 9-2 at Arvest Ballpark.

- Naturals starting pitcher **T.J. Sikkema** started strong, retiring the first five he faced before running into trouble with two outs in the second inning. Frisco put six straight batters on with two outs to score four runs and jumped out to a 4-0 lead. Sikkema faced the minimum over the last 10 batter he faced, as he retired the RoughRiders 1-2-3 in the third and had baserunners erased with a fourth inning pickoff and fifth inning double play.
- C.J. Eldred** followed Sikkema and surrendered three runs between the sixth and seventh innings, before handing the ball off to **Jonah Dipoto**. Dipoto allowed his first three batters to reach in the seventh, capping a four-run frame. Dipoto settled down to retire his next four batters, including striking out the side in the eighth inning.
- Walter Pennington** only needed nine pitches to get through a scoreless ninth inning, but the Naturals could not overcome the large deficit.
- The first three hits of the night for Northwest Arkansas were all doubles, from **Tyler Gentry** in the first, then back-to-back doubles from **Robbie Glendinning** and **John Rave** to plate a run in the fourth, at the time to bring the Naturals within three runs.
- A pair of walks, **Jake Means'** second single of the night and a sacrifice fly from **Tyler Cropley** added a run to the board in the bottom of the ninth, but Northwest Arkansas could not rally for any more, in the seven-run loss.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 1-0 all-time when playing on September 15 in the regular season

On September 15, 2010, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Midland RockHounds, 7-2 at Arvest Ballpark in the opening game of the Texas League Finals. After a rain-out moved Game 1 back a day, each team scored two runs in the second, with **Manny Piña** delivering a two-run homer for Northwest Arkansas.

**Anthony Seratelli** connected on a two-run homer in the fourth to give the Naturals 4-2 lead, then hit another two-run shot in the seventh to pad the lead. **Clint Robinson** added one more for good measure as the Naturals scored seven unanswered runs to take the series opener.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER**

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 15 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 3 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Jonah Dipoto**, **Jake Means** and **John Rave**.

**EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 40-11, while when scoring six runs or less, just 16-67.
- The Naturals are 38-16 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 18-51.
- The Naturals are 50-14 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 6-63 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 35-25, whereas 21-51 when the opponent scores first ... the team that scores first in through 133 Naturals games is 86-47 (.647 winning percentage).

**ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY**

The Naturals are 7-20 in one-run games this season, meaning 20 of their 77 losses (25.97%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 24 losses this season (including 15 of their one-run losses).

**Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?**

Through 133 games, the Naturals have stolen *173 bases in 216 attempts* (average 1.30 steals/game, 80.09% success rate).

- 171 steals leads the Texas League, ranks fifth in Double-A and 28th in the Minors.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 89 of 133 games this season (66.92%), including a season-high stretch of 11 straight games from August 28 to September 9 and 44 games this season with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 19 times, meaning 38 of 173 steals this year (21.97%) have come on a double-steal.
- Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 17 times, SIX of those occasions being Maikel Garcia ... **Tucker Bradley** had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.
- Maikel Garcia's** 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks sixth in the Texas League, **Nick Loftin's** 24 (in 27 attempts) ranks tied 10th in the league.

**RELIEF AID IN SEPTEMBER**

Despite struggles for the Naturals' bullpen in much of 2022, September has been much kinder to the relievers, as the bullpen has a 4.04 ERA (19 ER in 42.1 IP) this month, topping the previous best single-month ERA of 4.64 in May.

- Walter Pennington** (4.0 innings), **Stephen Woods Jr.** (3.2 innings) and **Charlie Neuweiler** (1.0 inning) have not allowed a run this month, while **Will Klein** (5.0 innings) and **Christian Chamberlain** (2.0 innings) have each allowed just one earned run.
- Woods Jr. has been dominant since the start of July, with a 1.67 ERA (5 ER in 27.0 IP) over 17 appearances, the lowest ERA in that span among Naturals pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched OR seven appearances.

**TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)**

Naturals outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals in June.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks 9TH in batting average (.327), 12TH in OPS (.974) and 12TH in on-base percentage (.425)* When you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
- He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.327), slugging percentage (.549) and OPS (.974), while he ranks second in on-base percentage (.425) behind Logan Porter's .441 ... his 84 runs batted in between the River Bandits and Naturals are the most in the system, while 127 hits, 21 home runs and 213 total bases all rank second.
- Gentry has reached base in 62 of 70 games (88.57%) ... he has hits in 48 of his 70 games with the Naturals, with already 27 multi-hit games.
- Since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .323 (84-for-260) with 15 doubles, 16 home runs and 61 runs batted in, with a .986 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 34 of 70 games, with 15 multi-RBI games.
- Since he arrived in the Texas League, Gentry has driven in the second-most runs (61) and ranks second in OPS (.986), tied second in runs scored (57) and total bases (147), ranks third in on-base percentage (.421) and slugging percentage (.565), fourth in hits (84) and home runs (16) and sixth in batting average (.323).
- Gentry has compiled the two of the longest on-base streaks among Naturals hitters this season, including a 28-game stretch that ended Sunday, the second-longest on-base streak in franchise history ... between July 30 and September 4, he hit .356 (36-for-101) with 10 extra-base hits and 20 walks, for a .485 on-base percentage over the last 28 games ... it is tied for the fifth-longest such streak in the Texas League this year ... he had hits in 21 of the 28 games.

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT**

Infielder **CJ Alexander** has quickly heated up at the plate since joining the Naturals in a trade last month from Atlanta.

- When combining his number between the Naturals and Mississippi Braves (Double-A), he has a career-best 25 home runs and 85 runs batted in ... among all Double-A hitters this year, he ranks sixth in RBI and tied seventh in homers.
- In 45 games with the Naturals, the corner infielder is hitting .274 (49-for-180) with 19 extra-base hits (10 home runs) and 42 runs batted in, with 31 runs scored as well.
- He has reached base in 34 of 45 games with the Naturals, with hits in 22 of the 45 games, 15 of which are multi-hit performances, while he's driven in runs in 17 of 45 games, including already 12 multi-RBI games.
- With four games left, Alexander is within reach of joining an exclusive group, the 20-20-20 club ... in 113 games this year, he has homered 25 times, stolen 19 bases and doubled 18 times ... one more steal and two more doubles would have him join the group of just 14 players in Minor League baseball this year with at least 20 home runs, doubles and steals ... even if he does not reach that milestone, he is currently one of just nine players with at least 25 home runs and 15 stolen bases.
- Alexander was named the Naturals' August Player of the Month ... over 21 games in the month of August, Alexander hit .297 (27-for-91) with eight home runs and 29 runs batted in ... *29 RBI led the Texas League and all Double-A hitters last month, tied second among all full-season Minor League hitters ... 8 HR were tied for the league lead and tied third in Double-A.*
- In 32 games since the start of August, Alexander is hitting .299 (38-for-127) with 34 runs batted in with a .918 OPS (.343 OBP + .575 SLG).
- C.J. began his Naturals tenure 0-for-12 over his first three games, then homered on July 16 @ Corpus Christi for his first hit with the team and went 4-for-10 in his next two games.

**Pitchers of the Month (1)**

☛ **May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

**Players of the Week (3)**

- ☛ **April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- ☛ **May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.
- ☛ **June 27 to July 3: OF Tyler Gentry** ... hit .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, four home runs and 11 runs batted in, which was tied for the most in the league. Recorded 24 total bases with a 1.043 slugging percentage 1.543 OPS.

**Pitchers of the Week (5)**

- ☛ **May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.
- ☛ **May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.
- ☛ **June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.
- ☛ **July 25 to July 31: LHP Dante Biasi** ... threw 5.0 scoreless innings on July 27 @ Wichita in an eventual 5-0 shutout win ... held the Wind Surge to just one hits and three walks while striking out five, on 79 pitches, his second straight scoreless start.

## #43 DERRICK LEWIS • PITCHING COACH

- Derrick Lewis is in his third season with the Royals' organization and second as pitching coach at Northwest Arkansas.
- He spent the previous 16 seasons in the Atlanta Braves' organization, the first 14 as a Minor League pitching coach and the last two as the Pitching Coordinator.

## #6 ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).
- Núñez played for parts of 12 seasons in the Majors with the Pirates (1997-2004), Cardinals (2005), Phillies (2006-2007) and Mets (2008). A switch-hitter, he owns a career average of .242 as a utility infielder in the big leagues, primarily playing third base, but could play all four infield positions.
- His best season came in 2005 when he batted .285 in 139 games for the National League Champion St. Louis Cardinals.
- Lifetime .346 (9-for-28) hitter in the postseason, including the 2005 National League Championship Series with St. Louis when he hit .385, though did not play in the World Series.
- Born in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, he now resides in Hudson, Massachusetts.



## #24 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



## #23 MIKE JIRSCHOLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.
- Jirschele previously managed the Triple-A Omaha franchise for 11 seasons (2003-13), leading the team to four division titles, three-straight trips to the Pacific Coast League championship round (2011-13), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and a Triple-A Championship in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field.
- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.



## DANNY ACCOLA • CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021, where he was named the High-A Central Athletic Trainer of the Year by PBATS (Professional Baseball Athletic Trainers Society).
- He was slated to serve in that role with Wilmington in 2020 and previously filled those roles with Lexington in 2019, Burlington from 2017-18 and with Surprise in 2016.
- Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.



## C.J. MIKKELSEN • STRENGTH & CONDITIONING COACH

- C.J. Mikkelsen will serve as the Northwest Arkansas Strength & Conditioning Coach for the second consecutive season, after being slated to fill that same role at Idaho Falls in 2020.
