Last Game: The Delmarva Shorebirds were defeated by the Fredericksburg Nationals on Saturday night, 9-5. The Fred Nats scored first in the second on back-to-back run-scoring hits by **Jordan Williams** and **Manuel Cabrera**, making it 2-0. Home runs became a major factor for Fredericksburg, beginning in the third when **Cristhian Vaquero** hit a solo homer. **Hunter Hines** hit a two-run shot in the fifth, and **Jordan Williams** hit a two-run homer in the sixth, putting Delmarva behind 7-0. The Shorebirds scored their first runs in the seventh on a run-scoring groundout from **DJ Layton** and an RBI single by **Stiven Martinez**, making it a 7-2 game. **Rafael Ramirez Jr.** hit Fredericksburg's fourth home run of the game in the bottom of the seventh, pushing their lead back to seven at 9-2. **Elvin Garcia** hit Delmarva's first home run of the night in the eighth, and the Shorebirds pushed two more runs home in the ninth on a single by **Stiven Martinez**, but it was not enough in a 9-5 loss to the Fred Nats.

Sizzling Sanchez: After a tough start and an unlucky run of injuries, **Jordan Sanchez** has turned it on in a major way. Since the start of June, the Orioles' No. 20 prospect has hit .297, 36 RBIs, and 15 multi-hit games in 41 starts. Sanchez has become the team leader in RBIs with 47 on the season in 65 games.

Make Way for Lo Re: **Jaiden Lo Re** has quickly made an impact at the top of Delmarva's order. In 44 games, Lo Re has 53 hits and is batting .338, with 18 multi-hit games. He has been a regular on base, with a .450 OBP, thanks to 32 walks compared to 17 strikeouts over 192 plate appearances. Since joining the Shorebirds, his .338 average is the second-best among all qualified hitters in the Carolina League, and he has a hit in 22 of 23 games, including a 13-game hitting streak that he lost on July 29 against Hickory.

Welcome the New Kids: The Shorebirds continue to bolster their roster for the final stretch of the season. After adding five FCL players last week, the Shorebirds are adding two recent trade acquisitions, OF **Jhonnardo Reyes**, acquired from the Twins, and RHP **Harrison Kreiling**, acquired from the Mariners. Three pitchers from the FCL have also joined the Shorebirds, with LHP **Holden deJong**, RHP **Connor Gehr**, and RHP **Isaac Silva** all set to make their Single-A debuts.

Play the hits, DJ: **DJ Layton** has been the Shorebirds' most productive bat in what has been a breakout campaign for the 20-year-old. Layton leads the team in several offensive categories, including walks (73), runs (64), OBP (.396), OPS (.785), doubles (19), and stolen bases (31). Layton has reached base safely in 50 of his last 55 games and earlier in the season had a 23-game on-base streak, the longest by a Shorebird since 2021.

Whit Moves Up: After four Shorebirds earned promotions to High-A Frederick last week, **Braylon Whitaker** is the latest Delmarva player to get the call-up to the next level. The former 19th-round pick from 2024 led the team in hits (75) and batting average (.270) at the time of his promotion. He also paced the Shorebirds in multi-hit games with 18 and has started to find his power swing, hitting his first two professional home runs on June 28 at Fayetteville and on July 3 at home against Charleston.

About the Nationals: The Shorebirds return to Fredericksburg for their second series at Virginia Credit Union Stadium this season. The first-half champions of the North Division finished 46-20, the second-best winning percentage (.697) in all of Minor League Baseball, behind only Bowling Green (.723). The Fred Nats are postseason-bound for the third consecutive season, and they dominated Delmarva in the first half, going 10-2 against the Shorebirds. Delmarva has not won a series in Fredericksburg since April 2023.
