Welcome to the Show: Six former Lugnuts have made a name for themselves in MLB this season, from first-time manager **Clayton McCullough** (2008-2009) with the Miami Marlins to debuting players **Max Muncy** (March 27), **Gunnar Hoglund** (May 2), **Denzel Clarke** (May 23), **Jack Winkler** (May 31), and, this past Sunday, **Jack Perkins** for the A's, increasing the overall total to 198 Nuts to make the Majors.

All-Star Voting Update: In the latest All-Star balloting numbers, 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** is 1st for A.L. first baseman (1,192,604 total votes), 2023 Lugnut **Jacob Wilson** leads at A.L. shortstop (1,120,791, with 2017 Lug **Bo Bichette** coming in 4th), and 2019 Lugnut **Alejandro Kirk** is second for A.L. catcher behind the Mariners' red hot Cal Raleigh.

Transactions: Today, the Lugnuts reinstated outfielder **Jonny Butler** from the Injured List, added pitchers **Wei-En Lin** and **Tzu-Chen Sha** from Stockton, and transferred pitcher **Nathan Dettmer** to Stockton. The moves leave the Nuts with 29 active players.

Prospecting: With the arrivals of Lin and Sha, both international free agents signed from Taiwan, the Lugnuts now have eight of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 6 **Tommy White**, No. 9 **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, No. 11 **Steven Echavarria**, No. 15 **Ryan Lasko**, No. 16 **Rodney Green, Jr.**, No. 26 **Nate Nankil**, No. 29 Tzu-Chen Sha and No. 30 Wei-En Lin. Sha is scheduled to start tomorrow while Lin will work out of the pen.

Noah's Career Arc: 2012 Lugnut standout **Noah Syndergaard** was signed to a minor league deal by the Chicago White Sox; he last appeared in the Majors on August 27, 2023, for the Cleveland Guardians.

Plunked: First baseman **T.J. Schofield-Sam** was hit by his 22nd pitch of the season on Sunday, his fourth straight game getting hit by a pitch. After getting plunked four times in April, he was struck seven times in May, and now has been hit 11 times in 19 games in June. In contrast, Randy Arozarena and Ty France are tied for the MLB lead with 13 HBPs. T.J.'s 22 HBPs not only lead the Midwest League, they rank 2nd in MiLB behind only Everett's Michael Arroyo.

Ladies and Gentlemen... Your American League Rookie of the Year: Athletics shortstop **Jacob Wilson**, who played 23 games for the Lugnuts in 2023, ranks 2nd in the Majors to Aaron Judge in both batting average (.349) and base hits (102).

Among the Best in the Minors: Lansing first baseman **T.J. Schofield-Sam** ranks 2nd in MiLB with a .350 batting average; closer **Mark Adamiak** is tied for 2nd in MiLB in saves (11); 2025 Opening Day starter **Gage Jump** is tied for 1st with 2021 Lugnut **Jack Cushing** in wins (8); and 2023 Lugnut **Colby Thomas** (currently with Triple-A Las Vegas) is 1st in MiLB in total bases (159) and runs batted in (66). Thomas led MiLB in extra-base hits last year with 80.

A Little More on T.J.: Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League in total bases (122) and base hits (83) and is 2nd in OBP (.431), 2nd in OPS (.950), 4th in slugging (.515) and 4th in runs scored (45).

The Men in the Pen: The Nuts have four of the most heavily used relievers in the league. **Blaze Pontes** leads the league with 24 appearances, while **Yehizon Sanchez** is tied for 2nd with 23 appearances, and **Mark Adamiak** and **Hunter Breault** are tied for 5th with 22 appearances.

JUNE 24TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: The Lugnuts opened up the second half with a walk-off, tying the Great Lakes Loons in the eighth on Matt Nuzzo's RBI double and K.C. Hobson's RBI single, and then winning it in the 11th on Hobson's two-run homer, 6-4. It was just Hobson's second home run of the year.

2012: The wild Great Lakes Loons issued seven consecutive two-out walks in the top of the fifth inning, leading to nine Lugnuts runs in the frame. Jose Dominguez gave out the first four, walking in two runs, followed by three straight walks from Juan Rodriguez. Rodriguez walked two more batters in the sixth, as the Nuts drew 10 total walks in all on their way to a 13-6 victory.

Last Time Out: On June 18 at Quad Cities, tossed five strong innings in a no-decision, allowing three hits and two runs, two walks and five strikeouts... only runs scored on a Carson Roccaforte two-run HR in the fourth inning... 70 pitches, 44 strikes... the Nuts led 2-1 going to the bottom of the 7th, but lost 8-4, after Quad Cities scored six runs off Jack Mahoney.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

19-year-old Steven Echavarria is part of an exclusive club: players who suited up for the Lugnuts as teenagers. Future Major Leaguers include 19-year-old Max Muncy, who joined the Nuts for the final 42 games of 2022; 19-year-old Gabriel Moreno, who homered in his first Lugnuts at-bat in 2019; Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. and Bo Bichette, who were 18 and 19 respectively when they dominated the 2017 Midwest League and appeared in the Futures Game; 18-year-old Carlos Beltrán, who was in the Lugnuts' very first Opening Day lineup on April 5, 1996; and the 1999 Lugnuts teenage duo of 19-year-old Corey Patterson, who was named the Midwest League Prospect of the Year, and 18-year-old Carlos Zambrano, who won 13 games and worked 153 1/3 innings. As of today, however, Echavarria is the *second-youngest* player on the team, eclipsed by new arrival Wei-En Lin, who will turn 20 on November 4th.

Path to Lansing: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... vs. right-handers: .306/.386/.387, 1 HR, 5 GiDP... vs. left-handers: .316/.431/.474, 3 HR, 1 GiDP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
