INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians utilized a pair of two-out hits in the seventh and eighth innings to extend their winning streak to five games, their longest of the season, in an 8-5 win over the Iowa Cubs on Saturday night at Principal Park. The Indians and I-Cubs traded blows right out of the starting gate, with Liover Peguero plating Davis with a sacrifice fly in the top of the first before Iowa's Owen Caissie doubled home former Indian Gilberto Celestino a half-inning later. Scoring halted until the bottom of the fourth when Iowa third baseman Fabián Pertuz belted a three-run home run to left center field, but the Indians immediately responded in the top of the fifth with an RBI double from Jake Lamb and a two-run shot from Peguero. Knotted at 4-4 in the top of the seventh, the Indians jumped ahead of the I-Cubs with a two-run, two-out, two-strike line drive single to right field from Seth Beer. An inning later, Henry Davis plated two more with an opposite-field single, also coming with two men out. For Davis, his 2-for-5 day extended his hitting streak to eight games, and Saturday marked the seventh of those eight games in which he's driven in at least one run.

GONE STREAKIN': Last night's victory marked the Indians fifth in a row, setting a new season-high win streak. It is their longest since winning five straight from May 3 (2)-7 at Toledo. With a win today, the Indians would clinch their first six-game sweep since moving to the weekly-series schedule format in 2021.

SWPIERS KEEP SWIPIING: Henry Davis, Malcom Nuñez, Matt Gorski (2x) and Matt Fraizer combined for five stolen bases last night, the most by Indians baserunning since stealing six on Sept. 13, 2023, at Omaha. Coming out of the All-Star Break, the Indians have stolen 16 bases in their last eight games at Omaha and Iowa. They now have 18 total stolen bases in just 17 July games, which is their best average of stolen bases per game in a month this season (1.1) and is one base shy of tying their most stolen bases in a month (19 in 28 May games).

RAKE LAMB'S RIBBIES: Jake Lamb led the Indians offense in hits last night, going 3-for-5 with two runs, two doubles and an RBI last night. His RBI was his eighth in four games at Iowa this week, and he now has driven in at least one run in six of his last seven games since coming back from the All-Star break. His three-hit game marked his first multi-hit game since going 2-for-4 on June 30 at Rochester.

HANK ON BASE: Henry Davis tacked on a pair of insurance runs in the eighth inning, singling home two to extend the lead to four runs. In total, he went 2-for-5 with a run, double and two RBI. He has now hit safely in eight consecutive games since July 13, hitting .351 (13-for-37) with six runs, three doubles, two home runs and nine RBI. He has driven in at least one run in seven of eight games during that stretch, including each of his last four. In 36 total games with the Indians this season, he is hitting .309 (42-for-136) with 28 runs, 12 doubles, nine home runs and 28 RBI.

CAN'T WITHHOLD WILLIAMS: Alika Williams is working an incredible stretch vs. the I-Cubs this week, reaching base safely in 18 of 26 plate appearances over five games at Principal Park this week after going 1-for-4 with a walk. On Friday, he logged a career-high tying four hits for the first time since May 4, 2022, with High-A Bowling Green at Wilmington. In total, he went 4-for-6 with a double and two runs. His four-hit performance followed Thursday's game where he reached base safely in all five of his plate appearances. He has now hit safely in nine straight games since July 14 vs. Columbus. In that time, he is hitting .429 (15-for-35) with 10 runs, three doubles, 10 walks and a .556 on-base percentage.

MASHING VS. THE I-CUBS: The Indians have launched 24 of their 89 home runs in 17 total games against the Iowa Cubs, their most home runs against a single opponent this season. Fourteen of those home runs came during a six-game series at Principal Park from May 21-26, with the Indians launching a season-high six long balls on May 23. Including Tuesday night's four-homer outburst and two grand slams on Wednesday, the Indians now have launched 21 home runs in 11 games in Des Moines this season. Ten total active members of Indy's roster are hitting above .300 against Iowa this season. Below is a list of the hottest Indians hitters against the I-Cubs and their stats.

TODAY: The Indians close out a nine-game road trip with the final of six games at Iowa tonight at 2:08 PM ET. They are looking for their first six-game sweep since moving to the weekly format in 2021 with a win today. RHP Domingo Germán (5-4, 3.88) takes the mound today, looking for his sixth consecutive victory today after earning the win on Tuesday. Countering for Iowa is RHP Kyle McGowin (0-2, 6.57), who was tagged with seven runs across 5.0 innings in the series opener on Tuesday.

GERMÁN GOES FOR FIVE: Domingo Germán extended his winning streak to five games since June 18 with 5.0 innings, four runs allowed and six strikeouts to defeat the I-Cubs on Tuesday. He was backed by the Indians offensive outpouring of 13 runs on 15 hits. He has now tossed at least 5.0 innings in nine of 11 starts with Indianapolis. During his winning streak, he has a 4.40 ERA (15er/30.2ip) and 31 strikeouts with two-or-less runs allowed in four of those six starts.

THIS DATE IN 1933: The largest crowd in franchise history – 22,153 fans – came out to Bush Stadium to pay tribute to second baseman Frank Sigafos. He singled and stole a base in the contest and led the American Association that season with a .370 average. The Indians beat Louisville, 9-2.

TODAY'S PITCHER

Domingo Germán: Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his second start of the series against Iowa, this afternoon at 2:08 PM ET at Principal Park.

Last Outing: Germán toed the rubber against Iowa on 7/23 for the fourth time this season as he punched out six batters across 5.0 innings while picking up his fifth win.

Against the I-Cubs: Germán has made four starts vs. Iowa. He's pitched a combined 21.1 innings with 23 strikeouts while allowing 12 runs (11 earned).

Historic Germán: Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on 6/28 at Oakland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on 8/2 and missed the remainder of the season.

Miscellaneous: Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 16, 2024.
