YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 11-1. Erie took a 3-0 lead in the first on a three-run homer by Dillon Dingler. The SeaWolves padded the lead to 10-0 in the fourth inning with seven runs, including a two-run homer by Jake Holton. Colt Keith pushed the lead to 11-0 in the fifth with an RBI single. The Flying Squirrels broke the no-hitter and the shutout with a solo home run by **Carter Williams** in the bottom of the fifth, his fifth at Double-A this year. Reliever **Spencer Bivens** threw 3.0 scoreless innings, striking out an affiliated career-high six batters.

TŪDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Today is the 14th of 24 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-2 against the SeaWolves at The Diamond from April 18-23. Erie won five-of-six at UPMC Park from May 9-14. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head back to Erie for six games to close the regular season from September 12-17.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have tied their longest losing streak of the season, dropping five straight since last Thursday. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 17-of-their-last-24. Their 7-17 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 156.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 227.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.00 ERA, which is the second-lowest of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball, trailing only Low-A Columbia (2.98).

THE SEAWOLVES are in first place in the Southwest Division, two games ahead of Altoona, and have won five-of-their-last-seven games. The SeaWolves' offense leads the Eastern League in runs scored (265), total bases (652), RBIs (246), OBP (.354) and OPS (.769) while ranking second in homers (55), batting average (.251) and SLG (.415). Erie's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), RHP Ty Madden (No. 4), INF Colt Keith (No. 5), C Dillon Dingler (No. 7), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 18), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 26) and INF Gage Workman (No. 27). Andrew Magno is rated by Baseball America as having the best curveball in Detroit's system, Dingler is rated as the best defensive catcher, Perez is rated as the best hitter for average and Workman is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Keith (No. 2), Flores (No. 4), Madden (No. 5), Perez (No. 8), Dingler (No. 14), Hurter (No. 21), Workman (No. 28) and Keider Montero (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Landen Roupp makes his fifth start of the season and his third this year against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Thursday at Binghamton and worked 2.2 innings, allowing one run on a third-inning homer. He made his season debut against the SeaWolves on April 23 at The Diamond and worked three scoreless, one-hit innings, striking out six. He did not pitch again until May 14 in Erie and allowed one run in one inning of work that day, throwing 31 pitches. In his first full professional season in 2022, Roupp climbed three levels in the Giants system. He began the year working primarily as a reliever with Low-A San Jose, going 5-2 with a 2.59 ERA in 14 outings. Roupp moved to High-A Eugene in late-June for seven starts, going 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA. He was promoted to Richmond on August 18 for the remainder of the season and went 2-1 with a 3.76 ERA in five starts. Roupp made one start against the SeaWolves last year, allowing two runs over five innings in his final outing of the year on September 15 at The Diamond. Roupp was selected by the Giants in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UNC Willmington, where he was the 2021 CAA Pitcher of the Year. For more on Roupp, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Brant Hurter makes his 10th start of the year and his third against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he threw five innings and allowed one run in a no-decision against the Patriots on Thursday at UPMC Park. Hurter pitched at The Diamond on April 20 and surrendered one run in four innings. On May 13 in Erie, he worked five innings and struck out a season-high seven batters, allowing one run. Hurter is ranked second in the Eastern League in ERA (1.99), second in WHIP (1.08) and seventh in BAA (.211). He played at Georgia Tech, where he was teammates with former Flying Squirrels catcher Joey Bart for one season in 2018. Hurter was selected by the Detroit Tigers in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft. He first reached Double-A at the end of his professional debut season in 2022, making four appearances for the SeaWolves. He made his final start of the season against the Flying Squirrels in Erie on Sept. 14, throwing 4.2 scoreless innings with six strikeouts. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 26 Tigers prospect and No. 21 by MLB.com.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, they are again leading the level in average attendance (6,643) and rank second in total attendance (139,513), trailing Tulsa, who has hosted five more home dates. The Flying Squirrels are ranked ninth of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. Wednesday's game is the second official sellout of the season, joining the game on May 17 that drew 9,810 fans, an 11-4 Richmond win over Akron. In the franchise's history, the Flying Squirrels are 43-26 in sellouts at The Diamond.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY: Carter Williams has homered in back-to-back games dating back to Sunday's series finale in Binghamton. He hit a solo home run on Sunday night to help fuel the Flying Squirrels overcoming an early five-run hole before falling in extras. On Tuesday to open the series against the SeaWolves, he clubbed a solo homer to bring in Richmond's only run of the game. Williams now has five home runs at Double-A this year. Over his last three games since Saturday, Williams is batting .333 (4-for-12) with two homers, two RBIs and four runs scored. In his first full professional season in 2022, Williams hit .336 with 11 homers between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, earning a pick as an MiLB.com Giants Organization All-Star.

ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE: Carter Aldrete has driven in nine runs over his last 12 games since May 17. In his last 20 games since May 6, he is batting .279 (22-for-79) with four homers, five doubles and 11 RBIs. Aldrete had hit safely in nine straight games prior to going 0-for-3 on Tuesday, which was the third-longest active hitting streak in the Eastern League. He has reached base in 14 straight games since May 14, which is the sixth-longest current streak in the league.

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder Vaun Brown was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown has reached base in each of his seven games with Richmond.

GLOW SHOW: Infielder **Jimmy Glowenke** was assigned to Double-A Richmond on Tuesday and is slated to make his Double-A debut. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (956), sixth in batting average (313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542). He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: Richmond relievers have posted a 3.00 ERA this season, which is the second-lowest of all 120 teams in the minors. Of Eastern League pitchers who have worked at least 15 innings and have not made a start this year, four Flying Squirrels relievers are ranked in the top-14 in the Eastern League in ERA. Nick Swiney, who is now in Triple-A, is ranked second in ERA (1.15). Raymond Burgos (1.80) is seventh, Juan Sanchez (2.49) is 13th and Blake Rivera is 14th (2.50).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked fourth in batting average (.304) and 10th in OBP (.398). Ismael Munguia is seventh in batting average (.300). Carter Aldrete is tied for ninth in RBIs (25). Riley Mahan is tied for ninth in RBIs (25). Hayden Cantrelle is fifth in OBP (.410) and tied for ninth in walks (29). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for third in strikeouts (52). Evan Gates is tied for eighth in saves (4).

WHERE THE SEAWULVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Colt Keith is second in batting average (.329), sixth in homers (9), second in RBIs (38), ninth in OBP (.399), fourth in SLG (.576), third in OPS (.975), second in hits (56), tied for fourth in doubles (11), tied for third in extra-base hits (22), second in total bases (98) and tied for ninth in runs scored (29). Trei Cruz is ninth in SLG (.503) and tied for seventh in runs scored (30). Jake Holton is tied for seventh in walks (30). Wenceel Perez is tied for ninth in runs scored (29). Brant Hurter is second in ERA (1.99), seventh in BAA (.211) and second in WHIP (1.08). Angel De Jesus is tied for first in games pitched (17).

PROSPECT WATCH* The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
