Today: The Lugnuts play the second in a six-game series with the archival Whitecaps at LMCU Ballpark, coming off a loss in last night's series opener. The two ballclubs met in mid April in Lansing, where the Lugnuts dropped three straight games but recovered to win both games over the weekend to earn a six-game split.

Starting Matchup: The Nuts are expected to use a tandem today of southpaw **Brady Basso**, returning from a year and a half hiatus following Tommy John and slowly getting stretched out after throwing 1 2/3 scoreless innings last week, and right-hander **Christian Fernandez**, in his fifth appearance of the year, opposed by West Michigan right-hander **Williander Moreno**, who allowed seven runs in 2 2/3 innings in Double-A but has yet to allow a run in 10 1/3 innings in the Midwest League.

Last Night: Whitecaps 14, Lugnuts 5. The Caps collected 17 hits (including three apiece for Izaac Pacheco, Roberto Campos and Justice Bigbie) and grounded into double scored three runs in the second, one in the third, two in the fourth, two in the fifth, three in the sixth and three in the eighth. Conversely, the Nuts scored all of their runs in the eighth inning.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play West Michigan through Sunday before returning home to welcome in Lake County.

LUG•NOTES

One In, One Out: Prior to today's game, outfielder **Caeden Trenkle** was placed on the Injured List and outfielder **Clark Elliott** joined the squad from Single-A Stockton in a corresponding move. Yesterday, the Lugnuts promoted pitcher **Grant Holman** to Double-A Midland. The current roster has 27 active players and six players on the Injured List. The 22-year-old Elliott starred at the University of Michigan, where he was named All-Big Ten 1st Team and the 2022 Big Ten Tournament's Most Outstanding Player en route to becoming the Athletics' 2nd round competitive balance (Round B) selection, 69th overall, in the 2022 draft. He is the no. 4 outfielder prospect in the organization (behind **Lawrence Butler**, **Denzel Clarke** and **Henry Bolte**) and the no. 16 prospect overall according to MLB Pipeline.

Turning Two: Lansing's infield turned double plays in the fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth innings yesterday, giving the club 27 double plays turned in 27 games this year, most in the Midwest League. Reliever **Brock Whittlesey** coaxed two yesterday and now has five induced this season.

Hitting Three: 2021 Lugnuts slugger **Jordan Diaz** went 3-for-4 with a trifecta of home runs yesterday at Yankee Stadium, driving in four runs in the A's 10-5 loss to the Yanks. Only one other rookie in baseball history, Ronald Guzman on August 10, 2018, has enjoyed a three-homer game against the New York Yankees. The game ended last night with Diaz in the on-deck circle.

Double Your Fun: Infielder **Euribiel Angeles** went 2-for-4 with a double yesterday, his fifth double in his last six games. During that span, Angeles is hitting .381 (8-for-21) in raising his batting average from .189 to .243.

Streaking: Catcher **Daniel Susac** and infielder **Jack Winkler** each went 1-for-4 with a single and a walk yesterday, with Susac extending his on-base streak to 10 games and Winkler extending his own streak to 12 games. The team leader in that category is **Caeden Trenkle**, who reached in his first 18 games of the year.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

2016: After Josh Almonte was called out at the plate to end the top of the 7th inning at Bowling Green, Lugnuts manager John Schneider was ejected by home plate umpire Jose Matamoros. Schneider took his time leaving, walking across the field to the clubhouse, located beyond the left-center field wall... and then discovered that the outfield gate was locked. He was locked in. At last, the Bowling Green bullpen in left field allowed Schneider to use their exit, and the game was able to resume. David Rodriguez homered in the bottom of the 9th to force extra innings, and Zacrey Law's RBI single in the bottom of the 11th off Josh DeGraaf lifted the Hot Rods to a 4-3 win.

Personal: Brady's last name is pronounced "bass-o," with 'bass' like the fish rather than the instrument... got married during the 2020-2021 offseason after spending 2020 hiatus planning his wedding in addition to preparing for the 2021 season... made seven appearances for the Lugnuts in 2021 before suffering ACL tear... 687 days between MiLB appearances, June 15, 2021, and May 3, 2023, in returning from Tommy John.

Raising Expectations: An MLB.com from Athletics MiLB camp by Jonathan Mayo on April 28, 2021, carried a bit of surprising news on a couple of breakout pitchers, specifically, as Mayo wrote, "Brady Basso's role is changing. A lefty who signed for just \$75,000 as a 16th-round pick in the 2019 Draft out of Oklahoma State, Basso pitched almost exclusively in relief in college and threw well in that role in the Rookie-level Arizona League in 2019. Now that he's up to 95-96 mph with his fastball to go along with a curve that flashes plus and a work-in-progress changeup, he's going to get the chance to start." Melissa Lockard, writing for The Athletic on May 2, 2021, included Basso in her Lugnuts preview, writing, "Left-hander Brady Basso (2019, 16th round) opened a lot of eyes this spring with his fastball sitting at 95-97 mph."

Pro Debut: Brady pitched for Athletics Gold in the AZL after signing: 15 G, 1 GS, 1.64 ERA, 25 2/3 IP, 0 HR, 8 BB, 38 K... limited right-handed hitters to .194/.257/.313 in 74 PA, while lefties hit .250/.344/.286 in 32 PA... opposing base stealers were nabbed twice out of three attempts... made first professional start on 8/16/19, tossing three innings with 4 K's.

Draft Day: Basso was selected 494th overall in the 16th round of the 2019 draft from Oklahoma State... scout: Chris Reilly... signed for \$75,000... in the same round, two all-name players were drafted: the Tigers selected Kona Quiggles and the Blue Jays took Jackxarel Lebron... one of eight OSU Cowboys to be drafted in 2019... joins 2022 ninth-rounder Caeden Trenkle as Oklahoma State Cowboys on the current Lugnuts roster.

College Days: Brady was primarily a reliever at Oklahoma State (12 G, 2 GS as freshman; 18 G, 5 GS as sophomore; 14 G, 0 GS as a junior)... after a rough sophomore season (8.27 ERA), rebounded as a junior (1.64 ERA, 11.0 IP, 6 H, 16 K)... majored in finance in Stillwater with the intention of becoming a financial advisor after his playing career ends.

Let Your Babies Grow Up to be Cowboys: Oklahoma State players in MLB have included Allie Reynolds, Robin Ventura, Jeremy Burnitz, Pete Incaviglia, Mickey Tettleton, Mike Henneman, Doug Dascenzo, Andrew Heaney, Matt Hague and Jordy Mercer.

Baseball Runs in the Family: Brady's father, Mike, played in the minors for nine seasons in the San Diego Padres system, 1986-1994, rising as high as Triple-A... after retiring as a player, immediately began managing in 1995 at age 30, and managed in the Padres' org. from 1995-2000... joined the Toronto Blue Jays and managed in the Jays system in 2003-2006 and 2009... spent the next decade as an MLB scout before being let go by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2020.

Hometown: Hails from Pearland ("PAIR-land"), Texas, south of Houston... during senior year at Pearland H.S., posted 0.48 ERA, with 101 strikeouts in 57 innings... named All-District in football, averaging 29.9 yards per catch as a receiver with one primary route: go deep... also from Pearland H.S.: Kirk Dressendorfer, Clay Hensley and Robbie Weinhardt; Megan Thee Stallion spent her teen years living in Pearland.

Life as a Lugnut in 2022: Assigned to Lansing on July 10 after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo)... impressed with five hitless innings at Dayton, August 10th.

The Early Word: When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings and misses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury.

Home Cooking: Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include MLB ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).
