**LASTTIME OUT:** Yulie pitched far better than his final line indicates on July 25 at Hickory, allowing five runs (four earned) on five hits, one walk and five strikeouts in 5.0-plus innings. After a nightmarish travel day on Monday that saw canceled flights, the right-hander turned in a gritty performance but was victimized by two home runs by Cameron Cauley. However, the Renegades offense picked him up and scored 16 runs in a 16-5 win.

**TURNING THE CORNER:** Beginning with his start on May 31 against the Aberdeen IronBirds, Tyrone Yulie was one of the most-dominant starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League for a month-plus stretch. Across six starts from May 31-July 4, Yulie is 3-3 with a 1.95 ERA (32.1 IP, 18 H, 12 R, 7 ER, 17 BB, 38 K, 1.08 WHIP, .157 BAA). The strech dropped his season ERA from 6.00 to 3.99, and he was named SAL Pitcher of the Week on June 26 after firing 7.0 no-hit innings against the Brooklyn Cyclones on June 20.

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp roster...placed on the 7-day Injured List on Aug. 3... Activated from the 7-day Injured List on Aug. 10.
- In the team's 12th game, became the first HV starting pitcher to factor in a decision on April 20 at Rome: W, 6.0 IP 2 H 1 R 2 RR 5 K
- Struck out season-high nine batters on 5/10 @ Aberdeen, his most strikeouts in a game since 8/21/22 (G1) vs Bradenton.
- Started the First Half Championship clinching game on June 20 @ Brooklyn: W, 7.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 7 K, helping Hudson Valley secure its first playoff spot since 2019.
- Named SAL Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 19-25, after his first half clinching start at Brooklyn.
