TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Tacoma Rainiers (Seattle Mariners affiliate) are scheduled for the series opener of their six-game set on Tuesday night at Dell Diamond. Express RHP Adrian Sampson is set to start against Rainiers LHP Ty Buttrey. First pitch is slated for 7:15 p.m. CT.

SNAGGING A SERIES SPLIT

The Express went on the road and earned a series split with the Baseball Club after a 3-1 win on Sunday afternoon. Round Rock put the first run on the board in the first inning. SS Jonathan Ornelas worked a leadoff walk then stole second base before a single from RF Sandro Fabian made it a 1-0 game. Texas Rangers rehabber RHP Max Scherzer tossed 4.0 innings of scoreless baseball with five strikeouts. 2B Jax Biggers singled to drive in DH Trevor Hauver in the fifth. Oklahoma City cut the lead to one in the sixth inning when 3B Andre Lipcius grounded out to score C Chris Okey. Round Rock 1B Blaine Crim kicked off the ninth with a solo homer to left field which increased the advantage over Oklahoma City to 3-1, which held final.

SAMPSON TAKES THE BALL

Round Rock RHP Adrian Sampson is scheduled to make his 12th start of the year on Tuesday. Sampson has tossed 5.0 innings or more in eight consecutive starts and has completed at least 5.0 innings in nine of his 11 outings. The E-Train offense has scored four runs or more in seven of his 11 starts this year.

A SEVEN-GAME WINNER

Express RHP Adrian Sampson is one of just two pitchers in the Pacific Coast League with seven wins this year. He is tied with Tacoma LHP Jhonathan Diaz. Sampson issues walks only 5.8 percent of the time, which is the second lowest mark in the PCL. He leads the team in starts (11) and innings (57.2) and is second on the squad in strikeouts (41).

BUCKING THE TREND

The E-Train went to Oklahoma City and collected a series split. Entering last week's series, Round Rock was 6-20 in their previous 26 games with the Baseball Club. It's the first time the Express have not lost a series to Oklahoma City since August 30-September 4, 2022.

FABIAN LEADS THE CHARGE

Express OF Sandro Fabian leads the Express in doubles (17), batting average (.319), slugging percentage (.525) and RBI (42). The right-hander owns the second-lowest strikeout rate among qualified players in the PCL (12.8%). In his last 21 games, he has struck out only seven times and has one strikeout in seven games this month.

COLE SAVE NOT COLE WINN

Round Rock RHP Cole Winn collected the first save of his professional career on Sunday in Oklahoma City. He tossed a scoreless ninth inning with two walks and two strikeouts. The right-hander has not allowed an earned run in his last 7.0 innings and four appearances on the bump.

AN EYE ON THE STANDINGS

With 12 games left in the first half of the season, Round Rock is 8.5 games back of first-place Sugar Land in the overall standings. The winner of the first half gets home-field advantage in the PCL Championship Series. Sacramento is 2.0 games back. The Space Cowboys open a six-game series with the Oklahoma City Baseball Club tonight.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
