vs. the Nashville Sounds (Milwaukee Brewers). It is the 12th of 18 games between the two clubs this season, and the sixth of 12 games Gwinnett will play in Nashville.

VS. NASHVILLE: The Stripers have lost two straight games in Nashville (outscored 10-4), dropping their all-time record at First Horizon Park to 5-12 (.294) and overall record vs. the Sounds to 15-25 (.375). In six series against Nashville since 2021, Gwinnett is 1-4-1. Their only series win was 6/15-21, 2021 at Coolray Field (won 3-2).

ROSARIO ON REHAB: Atlanta Braves' OF Eddie Rosario began an injury rehab assignment with the Stripers last night, leading off as the DH (1-for-4). He is on the 10-day Injured List following a procedure to correct blurred vision and swelling in his right retina. Rosario, the 2021 NLCS Most Valuable Player (.560, 3 HR, 9 RBI, 1.647 OPS in 6G vs. the LA Dodgers), is rehabbing with Gwinnett for the second time in his career (13G from 8/11-26, 2021).

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller produced his fifth consecutive quality start last night in a tough-luck loss (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO, 1 HR, season-high 105 pitches). Over that five-start span, he is 2-1 with a 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), 0.77 WHIP, .171 BAA, and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO).

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (99) and is among the top 10 in innings (2nd, 76.0), WHIP (2nd, 1.08), ERA (3rd, 2.96), and BAA (3rd, .215).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-8 with a 3.18 ERA (55 ER in 155.2 IP), .219 BAA, and 192 strikeouts (11.10 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 30 starts.

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 726 in 71 games (10.23 SO per game). That's five more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd, 721 SO in 71G). Kyle Muller (1st, 99), Tucker Davidson (7th, 66), and Huascar Ynoa (12th, 59) all rank in the International League top 15 in strikeouts.

KRAMER SAYS "GIDDY UP": Kramer Robertson enters play with a nine-game hitting streak, batting .353 (12-for-34, 2 2B, 1 HR, 8 R, 5 RBI, 4 SB, .950 OPS) since 6/12. The streak is the second-longest on the club this year, trailing only Chadwick Tromp's 13-game streak from 4/24-5/12. Since joining Gwinnett on 6/7, he's batting .300 (15-for-50, 3 2B, 1 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI, 4 SB, .817 OPS) in 13 games.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake is riding a season-best seven-game hitting streak since 6/7, batting .385 (10-for-26, 2 2B, 1 HR, 3 R, 4 RBI, 1 SB, .991 OPS) in that stretch. In 50 games overall on his Triple-A debut with Gwinnett, he's batting .276 (51-for-185, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 26 R, 12 RBI, 5 SB, .735 OPS).

RISING WATERS: Over his last eight games, Drew Waters is batting .313 (10-for-32, 1 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 4 R, 4 RBI, 1 SB, .968 OPS) with three multi-hit efforts. In 36 games overall this season, he's batting .259 (37-for-143, 6 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, 20 R, 14 RBI, 2 SB, .735 OPS).

- · Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year (leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. CLT and 5/11 at DUR, leadoff triple on 6/11 at JAX).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .249 (163-for-654, 33 2B, 4 3B, 17 HR, 107 R, 62 RBI, 33 SB, .716 OPS) in 166 games.

TONIGHT: The Stripers play the finale of a six-game series **STIFLING STAFF:** The Stripers lead Triple-A in ERA in June with a 3.52 mark in 22 games. That's 0.13 points lower than Durham (2nd, 3.65 ERA in 22G). Starting pitchers (Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Nolan Kingham, Kyle Muller, Huascar Ynoa) have combined to post a 3.54 ERA (47 ER in 119.1 IP), 9.96 SO/9.0 IP ratio (132 SO), and 11 quality starts this month.

> **DESHIELDS STOPPED AT 11: Delino DeShields Jr.** saw his 11-game on-base streak snapped last night (0-for-3). He hit .414 (12-for-29, 1 2B, 1 HR, 10 R, 5 RBI, 5 SB, 10 BB) on the streak from 6/3-6/23. Overall with Gwinnett, DeShields has reached base safely in 41 of 49 games (83.7%), batting .275 (38-for-138, 5 2B, 1 HR, 24 R, 15 RBI).

• IL Leaderboard: DeShields ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-9th, 15) and walks (12th, 35).

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel lifted an oppositefield two-run homer (#6) to right off RHP Alec Bettinger on Thursday, snapping a 1-1 tie in the seventh. Of Casteel's 15 hits this season, 10 have gone for extra bases (3 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers). For his Gwinnett career, 48.0% of his hits have been for extra bases (24 of 50), including nine doubles, one triple, and 14 homers

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin locked down his team-leading fifth save on Thursday (5-for-6, T-13th in IL). Over seven June outings, he is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (1 R, 0 ER in 7.1 IP), .120 BAA, and two saves (2-for-2). In 21 games overall, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.57 ERA (6 ER in 21.0 IP), .190 BAA, and 14.57 SO/9.0 IP ratio (34 SO).

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .158 (6for-38, 4 R, 1 RBI, 2 SB) in 10 games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 169 of 199 games (84.9%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (191-for-689, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 15 SB, .917 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

DOMINANT NIGHT FROM DAVIDSON: Tucker Davidson logged 6.2 scoreless IP (6 H, 0 BB, 9 SO) on Wednesday, improving to 2-3 with Gwinnett this season. It was his second scoreless start this year, first since 5/17 with Atlanta at Milwaukee (5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 SO in 3-0 win). Davidson has three quality starts in four outings in June (1-2, 3.08 ERA).

• IL Leaderboard: He has fanned 32 batters over 26.1 IP (10.94 SO/9.0 IP ratio) over his last four starts, and now ranks seventh in the IL in strikeouts (66).

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) . In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

Optioned back to Gwinnett on 5/1 ... **5/18 vs. MEM:** Set new career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 IP (5 H, 3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB) for his first Triple-A victory of the season as the Stripers won 4-3 ... **5/30 vs. LOU:** Tossed a career-high 8.0 innings (2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 8 SO) and had a no-hitter through 6.1 frames in a 2-0 win on Memorial Day ... **6/16 vs. IND:** Snapped a two-start losing streak with his third win (5.0 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO in 10-5 win).

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made his MLB debut with Atlanta on 4/12 vs. Washington, earning the win (5.2 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 2 HR, 0 BB, 4 SO) in the Braves' 16-4 rout ...
