**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 9-8, in a game shortened to eight innings due to rain to wrap up the series in Harrisburg. The Senators took a 5-0 lead in the first two innings. **Jimmy Glowenke** started a rally with a solo homer in the third, his sixth of the season. **Andrew Kachel** hit his first Double-A homer in the fifth and **Jairo Pomares** added an RBI single to close the score to 5-3. Harrisburg's Cody Wilson brought in a run with a groundout in the sixth inning to extend the lead to 6-3. In the top of the seventh, Pomares hit a two-run homer and Kachel drove a bases-clearing, three-run double to give the Flying Squirrels an 8-6 lead. The Senators reclaimed the lead to a groundout by Jeremy De La Rosa and a two-run single by Israel Pineda. The game was called for rain heading into the top of the ninth inning.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates in the opener of a sixgame series at The Diamond. The two teams first met for a six-game series in Richmond from June 4-9 with Richmond winning the first two before Altoona won the last four. From July 30-August 4 in Altoona, the Curve won the first four games before the Flying Squirrels won the final two. The two teams will also face off to close the season at Peoples Natural Gas Field from September 10-15.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost five consecutive games since Wednesday to drop to last in the Southwest Division. They are 2-9 in their last 11 games since August 9. They have been held to two-or-less runs in six-of-their-last nine games since August 10's doubleheader. They have been held to one-or-less runs and four-or-less hits in four-of-their-last nine games.

**THE CURVE** have gone 3-11 in their last 14 games since August 3. Last week, the dropped four-of-six against the Baysox at home. Altoona's roster features four of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 7), OF Jase Bowen (No. 27) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 28). Chen is also rated by Baseball America as having the best change-up in the Pirates system. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list including two Altoona players, including Solometo (No. 7) and Cheng (No. 18).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Dylan Cumming** makes his ninth Double-A start and 14th appearance. He last pitched last Wednesday afternoon at Harrisburg and allowed two runs (one earned) over 4.1 innings while setting a career high with 11 strikeouts, the most by a Richmond pitcher this season. For the season, he ranks second in the Giants system in strikeouts (121). He also ranks first in the organization in K/9 (11.88) and second in strikeout percentage (30.3%). Cumming began the year with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.87 ERA in nine games (seven starts). He was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month in April after going 1-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER/180 IP) in five games (four starts). On April 17 against Vancouver, cumming started and three tinnings in a combined no-hitter with Nick Sinacola and Seth Corry. Cumming spent last year with Low-A San Jose in his professional debut season, going 7-3 with a 2.93 ERA in 34 games (seven starts). He worked as a reliever most of the season before making starts across July, August and September. Cumming began his collegiate career at Chicago State, where he pitched three seasons before the program was disbanded in 2020. He pitched his final two seasons at Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va., and was with the Burlington Sock Puppets in the 2022 summer, where he was selected as an Appalachian League All-Star. Cumming signed with the San Francisco Giants as a non-drafted free agent on February 25, 2023. *For more on Cumming, see page two.* 

TURN IT UP TO 11: Last Wednesday, Dylan Cumming set a new career high with 11 strikeouts over his 4.1 innings. He became the first Richmond pitcher to strike out 11 in a game since 2022. He became the 12th pitcher in Flying Squirrels franchise history to record at least 11 strikeouts in a game, a list that also includes Matt Frisbee (franchise-record 13 in 2022), Eric Surkamp, Mike Kickham, Justin Fitzgerald, Chris Heston, Clayton Blackburn, Tyler Beede, Conner Menez, Kai-Wei Teng, Bryan Brickhouse and Kyle Harrison.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander Anthony Solometo makes his 13th Double-A start of the season and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Wednesday against the Baysox and allowed three runs over 31 innings in a loss. He pitched at The Diamond on June 5 and surrendered two runs over two innings in a loss. On June 9 in Richmond, he threw two scoreless innings. Solometo was placed on the development list on June 19 and returned to Altoona on August 8. Tonight marks his third start since returning to the Curve. Solometo was selected in the second round (37th overall) by the Pirates in the 2021 MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 5 Pirates prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 80 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher John Michael Bertrand has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on Friday night with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including Daryl Maday in 2010, Clayton Blackburn twice in 2014 and Garrett Williams in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GIDPs this year are tied for the fourth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing 27 by Craig Westcott in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005), 21 by Clayton Tanner in 2010 and 20 by Mike MacDonald in 2010.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 51 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .296 (61-for-206) with four homers, 10 doubles, nine walks and 29 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 18-of-44 games dating back to June 15.

**TAKE THE JAIRO:** On Sunday, **Jairo Pomares** hit his team-leading 11th home run of the season, a 445-foot blast at FNB Field in Harrisburg. It snapped a stretch of 29 games without a home run. Last homestand, Pomares hit a walk-off double for an extra-innings win over the Yard Goats in the second game of a doubleheader on August 10. For the season, Pomares' 11 homers are tied for sixth-most in the Giants organization. He is also tied for sixth with 31 extra-base hits.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked ninth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,593), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

**BOULEVARD TO THE BAY:** This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023) and Grant McCray (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

**LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS:** The have been 59 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is one shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 30 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 11) and SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 21).


