LAST TIME OUT

MOOSIC, PA (April 1, 2023) - The Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders and the Buffalo Bisons were caught in a rain storm on Saturday evening. After an hour and forty-one minute delay, the teams wrapped up the contest with a 6-4 Buffalo victory. Jesus Bastidas and Jamie Westbrook each launched their first home runs of the season.

Otto Lopez, the first batter of the game, received a walk to start things off. With a 1-0 count, Addison Barger blasted his first home of the season for a two-run lead.

First pitching swinging in the second, Bastidas slammed a home run straight to center field. It cut the Bisons lead in half, 2-1.

Buffalo was back at it again batting through the order in the third. Barger started it off with a base hit and Vinny Capra walked to reach. A double from Rafael Lantigua drove in Barger and Rob Brantly knocked in two more with his RBI single making it 5-1. After Cameron Eden recorded a base hit to keep the line moving, Tanner Morris sent home Brantly with a ground ball up the middle. Buffalo led 6-2 after a four-run frame.

The RailRiders got one back with home run in the fourth this time from Westbrook. Westbrook's bomb to chipped away at the Bisons lead slimming the deficit to three.

In the very next frame Scranton/Wilkes-Barre tacked on another. Andres Chaparro walked to reach and Jake Bauers doubled him home. SWB trailed 6-4.

After a long rain delay, both teams kept the same defensive, but swapped relievers on the mound. Despite a few baserunners here and there, no score advancements were made after play resumed.

Zach Thompson threw four innings of work getting the ball out of the gate on Saturday. He allowed three runs on six hits, including two homers. He struck out three on 64 pitches. Hayden Juenger (W, 1-0) took over in the fifth allowing an RBI double after a walk. He struck out the side in the next frame. Junior Fernandez and Matt Peacock each pitched a clean frame. Jackson Rees (S, 1) was called upon for the save and he slammed the door shut.

Ryan Weber (L, 0-1) got the start throwing just two and two thirds innings. He let up six runs on six hits including a homer in the first. Weber walked and struck out a pair each on 57 total pitches. Michael Gomez inherited a runner in the third and allowed him to cross the plate, although it tracked back to Weber's line. Gomez let runners on in the fourth but stranded them there. Deivi Garcia took over in the middle of the fifth, also inheriting a runner, but this time leaving him on second base. He got out of the sixth clean and induced a double play to escape the seventh. James Norwood took the ball after the delay and faced the minimum in his first frame. After loading the bases in the ninth, Norwood handed the ball to D.J. Snelten for the final out.

NEWS & NOTES

SNELTEN STRONG - D.J. Snelten took the mound in a professional regular season game for the first time since 2018. He was drafted in the 9th round in 2013 by the San Francisco Giants. Snelten made his Major League debut on April 28, 2018 and went on to pitch just 4.1 innings in four appearances. He was signed by the Yankees in August of 2022 after playing in multiple organizations including independent ball. Last night manager Shelley Duncan needed him in a tight situation. He was called upon in the top of the ninth inning with the bases loaded and two outs. After falling behind in the count, he unleashed a heater to strike out Blue Jays prospect Cameron Eden to end the frame. Snelten is one of just four southpaws on Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's pitching staff.

BOOSTED BY BAUERS - Jake Bauers showed off his power on Opening Night with two homers in consecutive at-bats to provide the team's only offense. This is the first time in his career that he has had two long balls in one contest. The last time a RailRider hit two home runs in a game was on September 11, 2022 at Durham by Chris Owings. On Saturday, he doubled to record his third extra base hit of the season. Bauers drove in a run with that hit, totaling a team leading three runs batted in.

BEHIND THE PLATE - Rodolfo Duran, Mickey Gasper, and Jose Godoy open the season as new manager Shelley Duncan's options behind the plate. Godoy has big league time with both Minnesota and Pittsburgh. Duran and Gasper are set to make their Scranton/Wilkes-Barre debuts. Gasper is one of just five players on the roster drafted by the New York Yankees.

SCRANTON SPEED - In two games the RailRiders have already stolen three bases. On Friday night Oswald Peraza took off to steal the first base of the season. Last night he and Elijah Dunham combined for an elite double steal. However, on his third attempt Peraza was picked off and caught stealing on first base by Zach Thompson.

RAINY RAILRIDERS - The RailRiders have played two games at PNC Field and have had two rain delays this season. The first coming pregame on Opening Night with a 39 minute delay prior to first pitch. The game moved quickly after that wrapping up the full contest in two hours and twenty minutes. Saturday afternoon the game began on time with beautiful sunny skies. Around the fourth inning rain started to come down and by half way through the sixth the staff sprinted out to pull the tarp. After an hour and forty one minutes, the storm receded and the umpires elected to continue the contest. Actual playing time only totaled two hours and thirty two minutes. The forecast for today's contest looks like clear skies and no chance of precipitation, albeit very cold.

BULLPEN MAGIC - The bullpen has kept it strong in the two opening games at PNC Field. With eight relievers having having twelve innings of work allowing just seven hits and no earned runs. Only two walks have been issued with 17 total strikeouts. The bullpen has kept the opposition to a .167 batting average while taking one win and one save.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Oswald Peraza (#3 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) alongside outfielder Elijah Dunham (#18), Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle, (#29) will both be essential parts of the pitching staff. Peraza made his big league debut at the end of last season and even aided the Yankees in their postseason race.

SHIPPED OUT, SHIPPED IN: The Yankees traded Ken Waldichuk, JP Sears and Hayden Wesneski prior to the 2022 trade deadline, all SWB pitchers. When Sears was traded he was slated to pitch on August 2 for the RailRiders. With those moves, Mitch Spence was called up from Somerset (Double-A) to make his Triple-A debut.

DAY GAME EXPERIENCE: Mitch Spence threw five games during the day last season. His record is 1-1 with a 6.49 ERA in 18.2 innings. He's allowed three home runs. In games beginning before 5PM, he has had 13 walks and 15 strikeouts.

CHANGE IT UP, LITERALLY: At USC-Aiken, Spence only threw a fastball and a slider. He now throws five pitches after spending over three years in the system (view repertoire right). He says he feels "like (he's) completely changed what kind of pitcher (he is)."

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2022: Combined with Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 6-7 with a 4.70 ERA (130.1IP, 138H, 73R/68ER, 42BB, 127K, 17HR) in 27 games (25 starts)...ranked among Yankees farmhands in games started (tied for third) and strikeouts (sixth)
- Became a starter in 2021, spending the entire season in Hudson Valley and posting a 3-4 record and 5.29 ERA over 23 appearances. His 20 starts, 105 IP and 118 K led the Renegades.
- Worked solely as a reliever in 2019 with Pulaski, making 16 appearances out of the bullpen, tying for 2nd on the team, going 3-2 with a 3.54 ERA, 4 saves and 29 K over 28.0 IP.
