TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play their second and final series of the season with the Portland Sea Dogs. Altoona is 4-5 against the Dogs this season.

Dalton Rogers was Boston's 3rd round pick in 2022 out of Southern Miss after a well-traveled collegiate career that began at Southeast Louisiana, continued at Division III Jones College and finishing at Southern Mississippi. Rogers allowed 6 runs in 1.0 inning against the Curve on May 29. Rogers works with a cutter, changeup, curveball and slider to compliment his low 90's fastball that has worked up to 96 in the past.

EZZY: Outfielder Esmerlyn Valdez has put together back-to-back strong performances to start Altoona's series at Portland. After recording a multi-RBI game in the series opener, Valdez picked up 3 hits in Altoona's 6-2 win over the Sea Dogs on July 30th. In his last 5 games, he is 5-for-18 with 4 RBI and 3 walks (.825 OPS).

OUT ON THE TOWN: Austrailian lefty Blake Townsend remains one of the team's best arms this season. Townsend is 11th in the Pirates system with 64 strikeouts in 60.0 innings and holds a 1.01 ERA on the campaign.

MY VALENTIN: Righty Valentin Linarez has turned in one of the best seasons of his professional career in 2025. In addition to holding opponents to a career-low .196 BAA this season and a 1.18 WHIP, since June 10 he's allowed just 2 runs in 17.0 IP (1.06 ERA) and a 0.82 WHIP with 18 strikeouts.

JUSTIN'S MEIS: Since recording a 4.91 ERA in the month of May, Justin Meis has gone 2-2 with a 1.93 ERA with two saves in 15 games for the Curve. In that time he's recorded a 0.86 WHIP and walked just 4 batters in 23.1 innings with 26 strikeouts.

WHERE ARE THE BATS: Altoona holds a .196 team batting average in the Second Half (Since June 23) the lowest among 120 full-season clubs, the team also ranks 117th in OPS (.595).

Pitching has been the team's savior of late. Altoona pitchers rank 3rd among 120 minor league clubs in WHIP (1.13).

KELLY K'S: Righty Antwone Kelly struck out a career-high 9 batters in 4.2 innings on July 10 at Binghamton. The 21-year-old has struck out 28 batters in 25.1 innings to start July, <u>he holds a 0.99 WHIP which ranks T-7th among qualified minor league</u> pitchers. Kelly's 101 strikeouts this season are 2nd-most in the Pirates minor league system (Bubba Chandler, 106), two ahead of teammate Wilber Dotel (90).

CLOSE WINS: 15 of Altoona's last 19 wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 48 of the team's 98 games this year (50%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

THE NEW GUYS WHO THROW HARD: Righty Ryan Harbin had the 4th-longest scoreless streak in the minors this season end on July 9 at Binghamton. From May 13 - July 9, Harbin went 2-0 in 22.1 IP, 10 H, 13 BB, 37 K (.137 BAA), before allowing a run on July 9. <u>Harbin has struck out 25 batters in 15.2 innings with Altoona. Harbin ranks 8th in the Pirates system in strikeouts</u> (71) in $46.\overline{0}$ innings, every other pitcher in the top 14 in the system in strikeouts has throwin at least $60.\overline{0}$ IP.

Righty Brandon Bidois tossed 11.1 scoreless innings to begin his Curve career before allowing two unearned runs on July 19 against Akron. The Austrailian native has been unscored upon in 21-of-25 outings this season, going 1.0+ IP in 16 of his 25 outings, totaling 41 strikeouts in 37.1 innings this year.

CY YOUNG?: Lefty Cy Nielson has struck out 49 batters this season, 6th-most by an Eastern League reliever. Nielson has collected at least one strike out in 38-of-39 career outings with the Curve, racking up 81 in 64.1 IP.

ITALIANISSIMO: Righty Alessandro Ercolani has dialed in throughout his first trip through the Eastern League. In 11 of his 19 outings this season, he's allowed 1 run or fewer. Held under an innings count this year, Ercolani is working on the best walk rate of his career, walking only 26 in 74.2 IP. His 2.83 BB/9 innings is the best mark of his career.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Bingnamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching career has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rangers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford Pitching Coach 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an instructor in the Pirates system, previously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. 
