PAPILLION, NEB. - The Omaha Storm Chasers scored in the first and led the rest of the way, as three home runs helped power a 13-6 win and secure a series win over the Gwinnett Stripers, Saturday afternoon at Werner Park.

- Backwards Day at the ballpark had a backwards start to the game, with the first runs of the game scoring on an errant pickoff throw and balk, for a quick 2-0 Omaha lead.
- After **Drew Waters** and **Michael Massey** scored in that first inning, **CJ Alexander** brought Massey home in the third inning with a two-run homer, his fourth of the season to tie for the team lead and move the Chasers ahead 4-0.
- The very next inning, **Nate Eaton** added his first home run of the season, a two-run shot that scored **Ryan Fitzgerald** from first base for a 6-0 Storm Chasers lead after just four innings.
- Omaha starter **William Fleming** cruised through the first 4.0 innings, as the rightly held Gwinnett to three hits and two walks, while striking out 3 on just 48 pitches ... however, the Stripers figured out Fleming the third time through the order, as he allowed hits to five of his first six batters in the top of the fifth inning and was knocked out of the game.
- Walter Pennington** followed Fleming and got the second out of the inning, but then surrendered a game-tying home run to Gwinnett's **Luke Williams**, knotting the game at 6-6 in the top of the fifth inning, with the first five runs of the frame charged to Fleming ... Pennington ended up striking out the last batter he faced in the fifth, then the lefty struck out the side in the fourth inning.
- The game did not stay tied for long as Omaha countered Gwinnett's 6-run inning with four runs in the bottom of the fifth to jump ahead and the Storm Chasers led the rest of the way ... **John Rave** and **Cam Devanney** drew bases loaded walks, then **Fitzgerald** singled in a run and **Eaton** brought another run home on a fielder's choice, with the four runs scoring on just one hit, three walks and a hit batter.
- While Omaha couldn't score in the sixth inning, **Eaton** singled home **Devanney** in the seventh for a run of insurance, then **Brian O'Keefe** connected on his second home run of the week in the eighth inning, an opposite-field two-run shot that brought the score to the 13-6 that held to be final.
- Pennington added a scoreless seventh inning to finish 2.2 innings and earn his second win of the year ... **Will Klein** followed out of the bullpen and continued his dominant stretch on the mound with 2.0 scoreless innings to finish the afternoon and keep the Stripers off the board.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

PUSHING PORTER

- Storm Chasers catcher **Logan Porter** has been one of the top performers in the International League this week, also sneaking up the league leaderboards.
- In this week's series, Porter has hit .583 (7-for-12) with a 2.355 OPS ... Porter has 2 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers and 7 runs batted in, with 4 walks as well ... he has a home run, 2+ hits and 2+ RBI in each game he's played against the Stripers.
- Porter does not .968 slugging percentage and 1.468 OPS rank 1st among qualified International League, while his .419 batting average is 3rd and a .500 on-base percentage is tied 5th ... his 30 total bases are tied 6th.
- He is tied for the Storm Chasers team lead in home runs (4), while he ranks 2nd in extra-base hits (8) and total bases (30) and is tied 2nd in runs batted in (11) ... if he had enough plate appearances to qualify, his entire .419/.500/.968 slashline would lead the team as well.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

- Infielder **CJ Alexander** has been one of Omaha's top hitters through the first 14 games of the season, leading the team in nearly every offensive category.
- Alexander leads the Storm Chasers in hits (17), doubles (6), extra-base hits (10), total bases (5), runs scored (12) and runs batted in (12) ... he is tied for the team lead in home runs (4) ... his .340 average, .600 slugging percentage and 1.077 OPS all lead qualified Omaha hitters too.
- The left-handed hitter is tied 2nd in the International League in doubles, tied 3rd in extra-base hits, 5th in total bases and tied 7th in hits.
- CJ is also responsible for 6 of the 7 hardest-hit balls by Storm Chasers players this year ... he leads Omaha with 16 batted balls at or above 100mph, twice as many as the next-closest on the team, **Drew Waters** has 8.

MASS EFFECT

- Second baseman **Michael Massey** continues his Major League rehab today, with a stellar week for the Storm Chasers.
- Massey played each of the first three games in this week's series and was back in the lineup yesterday ... he has gone 8-for-18 at the plate (.444), with 4 doubles, 5 runs scored and 5 runs batted in.
- He has 2 . hits in 3 of 4 games played, with an RBI in each of his first 3 games ... a pair of walks give him a .500 on-base percentage with a 1.167 OPS.
- Massey missed the final 7 spring games with back tightness, placed on KC's 10-Day IL on March 25 ... he only got 30 plate appearances during spring training, after getting 48 last year in the Cactus League.

- ✓ Appeared in 2 Cactus League games (0 starts) and went 2-0 with a 5.40 ERA (2 ER in 3.1 IP), with 2 strikeouts.

- ✓ After opening the year at NW Arkansas (AA), Bowlan earned a promotion to Omaha on June 20 and made 14 appearances (12 starts) for the Storm Chasers, before earning his first big league call-up on September 19.
 - ✓ Having not pitched into the 6th inning in over two years, did so in five of his final seven outings with Omaha ... three of his last four starts with the Chasers were quality starts - 8/30 vs. LOU (6.0 IP, 1 ER), 9/5 @ IOW (6.0 IP, 2 ER) & 9/16 vs. IND (6.0 IP, 2 ER).
 - ✓ 669 days after being added to the 40-man roster (on 11/19/21), was called up by the Royals for the first time on September 19 and made his Major League debut 8 days later on September 27 at DET as KC's opener, his first of two MLB outings ... struck out **Parker Meadows** to begin the game and allowed a solo home run to **Miguel Cabrera** in the 2nd inning, Miggy's final MLB homer.

- ✓ After undergoing Tommy John Surgery in 2021, returned to the mound June 17 in the Arizona Complex League and made seven starts with the ACL Royals (R), one start with Quad Cities (A+) and finished the year with NW Arkansas (AA) for his final nine starts.
 - ✓ Was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 22 to 28, after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings on August 28 vs. Springfield (STL) and allowing just two hits with two strikeouts to earn his first win of 2022 with the Naturals.
 - ✓ After allowing two home runs in each of his first two starts, allowed three homers over his last seven starts ... 10 of 33 runs (30%) allowed with NWA came on home runs.

- ✓ Began the season with NW Arkansas (AA) and started four games for the Naturals, going 2-0 with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER in 17.0 IP).
 - ✓ Left his start May 23 @ Springfield (STL) after striking out two and throwing 10 pitches ... missed the rest of the season after undergoing Tommy John surgery on June 1.
