THE BOY WHO LIVED: After winning their third game out of four this week against the Delmarva Shorebirds last night, tonight, the FredNats go for the series win on Harry Potter night at Virginia Credit Union Stadium. RHP Travis Sykora starts tonight and will look to bounce back after a rough outing last weekend in Salem. Overall, Sykora has been excellent this year in his first full season in professional baseball. In 12 starts covering 48 innings, he's struck out 68 hitters, and the opponents are hitting just .176 against him. In the 20 innings prior to his last start in Salem, he allowed just 3 earned runs.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats spun their 10th shutout of the season as a pitching staff, beating Delmarva 5-0 behind Dustin Saenz, Austin Amaral, Mason Denaburg and Bubba Hall. The Freddies scored four runs in the 6th inning, helped out by a couple Delmarva errors. Cristhian Vaquero had the big two-run single as well.

COMPLETE DOMINATION: The FredNats are 16-2 this year against Delmarva, and one game under .500 against the rest of the Carolina League. In 17 games this year against the Shorebirds, FXBG has outscored Delmarva 110-57 (17 of the 57 came in Wednesday night's game) and has swept two out of the three series the teams have played this year, including the second six-game series sweep in franchise history. FXBG has a team ERA of 2.33 against the Shorebirds, and Delmarva is hitting .199 as a team against FredNat pitching.

HOT COOP: Everett Cooper III has been the hottest bat in this FredNat order in the month of July so far. This month, Cooper is slashing .320/.393/.440 for an OPS of .833. His wOBA is .399 (.320 is average), and his wRC+ is 147 (100 is average).

DOMINANT STARTS: After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last month. Since June 11, FredNat starters have logged 163.1 innings and allowed just 33 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.86. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In the last full six-game series alone, FredNat starters pitched 16.1 scoreless innings, allowing a total of seven hits.

FORTY THREE AND ONE: Last Tuesday's loss was the first time all season that the FredNats lost a game when leading after seven innings, and both doubleheader sweeps have pushed the team's record in that scenario to 43–1. FXBG's loss in Friday night's game was the first time all season the team bas blown a lead after eight innings.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 42-7 this season when scoring first, including 35 out of the last 37 wins. FXBG was beaten for the first time in nearly a month when scoring first in Salem last weekend.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 194-160 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Travis Sykora is making his 13th professional start this evening for Fredericksburg, against the Delmarva Shorebirds.

He was taken in the third round by Washington in the 2023, who gave him double-slot money to sign him away from a commitment to pitch at the University of Texas. That, along with some command issues that popped up during his senior year at Round Rock HS, caused him to fall from a first-round projection into the third.

QUICK CLIMBER: Sykora was promoted to the FredNats during the late April series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, but did not pitch. He also did not pitch last year after being drafted, but Washington felt he was ready to jump to full-season ball and will bypass the Florida Complex League entirely.

Sykora's calling card is a big fastball that reached 101 MPH on the prep circuit, and will sit in the mid to upper 90's. He pairs the heater with a splitter and a tight slider, both in the mid 80's.

A BIG MENTOR: Sykora has been open about how much he looks up to fellow Texan Nolan Ryan. Travis sees similarities in their two deliveries, between a high leg kick and "elbows and knees flying everywhere," Sykora said in a MLB.com interview. He was able to meet Ryan this offseason.

LAST TIME OUT: Sykora allowed a season-high three earned runs last weekend at Salem. He walked four and gave up four hits as well, in a no-decision.
