INDY BITS

ABOUT GAME 1: Domingo Germán fired a quality start to propel Indianapolis to a 5-2 win over Columbus in the first game of a doubleheader on Friday night at Victory Field. The Indians never trailed in the opener and scored four runs off Triston McKenzie through the first two frames. Ji Hwan Bae was involved in the scoring in both innings, lining a leadoff single ahead of his 10th stolen base to set up an Edward Olivares sacrifice fly. In the second, Matt Fraizer brought home Malcom Nuñez with a run-scoring single, and after Andrés Alvarez walked to load the bases, Bae slashed a single into left field to plate two more. The Clippers cut their deficit in half with a run in the third and solo home run by Raynel Delgado in the fifth inning, but Jake Lamb lined a single to right to score Liover Peguero in the bottom half to keep the visitors at bay.

DOMINGO'S DAY: Domingo Germán stunned the Clippers offense in Game 1 last night, tossing 6.0 two-run innings with seven strikeouts to earn his fourth consecutive win in his last five outings since June 18. In that time, he has a 3.86 ERA (11er/25.2ip) and 25 strikeouts with two-or-less runs allowed in four of those five starts. His seven strikeouts last night was one shy of tying his season high, set on May 31 vs. Omaha.

HELLERBALL: Ben Heller earned his second save of the season with a shutout seventh frame in Game 1 last night. The outing extended his impressive stretch of dominance in the International League out of the bullpen. He has not allowed a run across his last 13 outings (13.1ip) since May 21 at lowa, recording a 0.60 WHIP and .070 batting average against (3-for-43). In addition, he hasn't allowed a hit across his last 8.2 innings (eight appearances). His 13-game shutout streak is tied for the third-longest such streak in the IL trailing Lehigh Valley's Max Lazar and Omaha's Evan Sisk (14), and is currently the longest active streak after Charlotte's Sammy Peralta's 12-game streak was snapped on July 4.

ABOUT GAME 2: The Indians went just 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position in the second leg of the twin bill to fall to the Clippers, 8-2. In the nightcap, Johnathan Rodríguez, who went 14-for-29 (.483) with four doubles, four home runs and 16 RBI in the six-game series for Columbus at Victory Field in early June, drove in four runs – two on a first-inning double and two more on an opposite-field home run during a four-run seventh. Delgado added a two-run shot of his own in the fifth, and former Indian Dom Nuñez also cleared the wall with a two-run bomb in the final frame.

DOUBLEHEADERS: The Indians played their seventh doubleheader this season last night after playing just five during the 2023 season. In those seven doubleheaders, they own a 1-3-3 record after splitting the set vs. Columbus last night. This season marks the most doubleheaders played in a single season by the Indians since they went 3-1-3 in twinbills during the 2017 season. Indianapolis still has at least two doubleheaders on the docket, on Aug. 28 vs. Louisville to make up for a postponement at Louisville Slugger Field on July 3 and one that has yet to be scheduled after Thursday night's doubleheader postponement vs. Columbus.

THE BEER KEEPS FLOWING: Seth Beer continued his hot streak last night, going 1-for-3 in Game 1 and 2-for-3 in Game 2. He has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games, hitting .298 (14-for-47) with nine runs, six extra-base hits and 11 RBI. All of but one of his hits since joining the Indians on June 18 have come off right-handed pitchers, going 1-for-10 with an RBI, walk and five strikeouts against southpaws. In addition, his success has largely come on the road. In seven road games, he is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with two doubles, two home runs and nine RBI. After this week, he is now hitting .242 (8-for-33) with two extra-base hits and two RBI at Victory Field.

THE TOUGHEST OUT IN THE IL: Ji Hwan Bae logged his eighth multi-hit performance in his last 14 games since June 22 in Game 1 last night, going 2-for-3 with a run, two RBI and a stolen base. In that stretch, he is hitting .373 (22-for-59) with eight runs, two doubles, one triple, eight RBI and three stolen bases. He went 3-for-5 on Saturday for his fourth three-hit game of this most recent hot streak and his second during the month of July. Bae continues to own International League pitching not only this year, but in his career. In 42 games with the Indians this season, he is hitting .363 (58-for-160) with 31 runs, six doubles, two triples, four home runs and 23 RBI. In 159 games of his Triple-A career, he is hitting .311 (190-for-611) with 32 doubles, eight triples and 13 home runs.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue their rain-shortened five-game series vs. the Clippers tonight at 7:05 PM at Victory Field. Columbus visited Victory Field from June 4-9 and took four of six games from the Indians for their first series win of the season. Continuing the series for Indy tonight is RHP Drake Fellows (0-1, 9.00) after being promoted from Double-A Altoona today. He made one start against the Clippers on June 8 and took a no-decision after tossing 4.0 three-run innings. Countering for Columbus is LHP Logan Allen (0-0, ---), who began the season with Cleveland. He made two starts vs. Indianapolis at Huntington Park in 2022, going 1-1 with a 2.79 ERA (3er/9.2ip) and 15 strikeouts.

WHAT A FELLOW: Drake Fellows was promoted from Double-A Altoona today ahead of his third career Triple-A start. On July 1, his penultimate Double-A start, he tossed a season-high 7.0 innings with nine punchouts. In total, he went 2-2 with a 3.35 ERA (14er/37.2ip) and 34 strikeouts in 10 games (seven starts) with the Curve.

THIS DATE IN 2013: After the Indians' July 10 game at Huntington Park was suspended, Columbus and Indy picked up where they left off three days later at Victory Field and battled out a 16-inning game that lasted 5 hours and 32 minutes. Down 4-3 entering the ninth, Jared Goedert hit a solo home run to tie the game. The teams traded runs in the 14th and 15th innings before Indy put up three runs in the 16th inning behind a two-run home run by Brian Boccock. The Indians had 19 hits to Columbus' eight with seven players recording two-plus knocks, including a game-high four by first baseman Jerry Sands.
